Exorcism - Godly or Not - Acts 19C

- 2 Timothy 2:15 <u>Study</u> to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
- Acts 5 Referred to the situation of Ananias & Saphira that God dealt with immediately also.
- Acts 19:13-20 Then certain of the vagabond Jews, exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth. 14 And there were seven sons of one Sceva, a Jew, and chief of the priests, which did so. 15 And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye? 16 And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded. 17 And this was known to all the Jews and Greeks also dwelling at Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the name of the Lord Jesus was magnified. 18 And many that believed came, and confessed, and shewed their deeds. 19 Many of them also which used curious arts brought their books together, and burned them before all men: and they counted the price of them, and found it fifty thousand pieces of silver. 20 So mightily grew the word of God and prevailed.
- Acts 8 Summarized about Philip, Simon Magus & Simon Peter.
- Acts 19:13 Then certain of the <u>vagabond Jews</u>, <u>exorcists</u>, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth.
- They were doing Practical Kabalism from ungodly books supposedly of Solomon such as the Testament of Solomon. Some tactics were to use angels, to ask the demon their name, to use fetishes, to call upon the name of God, etc. for exorcisms.
- Acts 19:14,15 And there were <u>seven sons of one Sceva, a Jew, and chief of</u> <u>the priests</u>, which did so. 15 And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Acts 19:16 And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.
- Luke 8 Summarized about Jesus setting the gadarene demoniac free.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

- Acts 19:17 And this was known to all the Jews and Greeks also dwelling at Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the name of the Lord Jesus was magnified.
- Acts 5:5 And Ananias hearing these words <u>fell</u> down, and gave up the ghost: and great <u>fear</u> came on all them that heard these things.
- Acts 19:18 And many that believed came, and confessed, and shewed their deeds.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

They cleaned up & got rid of the occult objects like King Josiah did.

Acts 19:19,20 Many of them also which used curious arts brought their books together, and burned them before all men: and they counted the price of them, and found it fifty thousand pieces of silver. 20 So mightily grew the word of God and prevailed.

Exodus 32 God judged the Isrealites for the golden calf.

Matthew 12:28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.

Ezekiel 13:17-23 Likewise, thou son of man, set thy face against the daughters of thy people, which prophesy out of their own heart; and prophesy thou against them, 18 And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Woe to the women that sew pillows to all armholes, and make kerchiefs upon the head of every stature to hunt souls! Will ye hunt the souls of my people, and will ve save the souls alive that come unto you? 19 And will ye pollute me among my people for handfuls of barley and for pieces of bread, to slay the souls that should not die, and to save the souls alive that should not live, by your lying to my people that hear your lies? 20 Wherefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against your pillows, wherewith ye there hunt the souls to make them fly, and I will tear them from your arms, and will let the souls go, even the souls that ye hunt to make them fly. 21 Your kerchiefs also will I tear, and deliver my people out of your hand, and they shall be no more in your hand to be hunted; and ye shall know that I am the LORD. 22 Because with lies ye have made the heart of the righteous sad, whom I have not made sad; and strengthened the hands of the wicked, that he should not return from his wicked way, by promising him life: 23 Therefore ye shall see no more vanity, nor divine divinations: for I will deliver my people out of your

- hand: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- Deuteronomy 18:9 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt <u>not learn</u> to do after the abominations of those nations.
- Colossians 2 referred to Paul addressing this also.
- Matthew 12:28 But if I cast out devils <u>by</u> the <u>Spirit</u> of God, then the <u>kingdom</u> of God is <u>come</u> unto you.
- Eastons Sceva An implement, a Jew, chief of the priests at Ephesus #Ac 19:13-16 i.e., the head of one of the twenty-four courses of the house of Levi. He had seven sons, who "took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus," in imitation of Paul. They tried their method of exorcism on a fierce demoniac, and failed. His answer to them was to this effect #Ac 19:15 "The Jesus whom you invoke is One whose authority I acknowledge; and the Paul whom you name I recognize to be a servant or messenger of God; but what sort of men are ye who have been empowered to act as you do by neither?" (Lindsay on the Acts of the Apostles.)
- 2 Samuel 21:6 Let <u>seven</u> <u>men</u> of his sons be delivered unto us, and we will hang them up unto the LORD in Gibeah of Saul, *whom* the LORD did choose. And the king said, I will give *them*.
- Proverbs 26:16 The sluggard *is* wiser in his own conceit than <u>seven</u> <u>men</u> that can render a reason.
- Jeremiah 52:25 He took also out of the city an eunuch, which had the charge of the men of war; and <u>seven</u> <u>men</u> of them that were near the king's person, which were found in the city; and the principal scribe of the host, who mustered the people of the land; and threescore men of the people of the land, that were found in the midst of the city.
- Acts 6:3 Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you <u>seven men</u> of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business.
- 1 Samuel 16:14-23 But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him. 15 And Saul's servants said unto him, Behold now, an evil spirit from God troubleth thee. 16 Let our lord now command thy servants, which are before thee, to seek out a man, who is a cunning player on an harp: and it shall come to pass, when the evil spirit from God is upon thee, that he shall play with his hand, and thou shalt be well. 17 And Saul said unto his servants, Provide me now a man that can play well, and bring him to me. 18 Then answered one of the servants, and said, Behold, I have seen a son of Jesse the Bethlehemite, that is cunning in playing, and a mighty valiant man, and a man of war, and prudent in matters, and a comely person, and the LORD is with him. 19 Wherefore Saul sent messengers unto Jesse, and said,

Send me David thy son, which is with the sheep. 20 And Jesse took an ass laden with bread, and a bottle of wine, and a kid, and sent them by David his son unto Saul. 21 And David came to Saul, and stood before him: and he loved him greatly; and he became his armourbearer. 22 And Saul sent to Jesse, saying, Let David, I pray thee, stand before me; for he hath found favour in my sight. 23 And it came to pass, when the evil spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.

- 1 Samuel 28:7 Then said Saul unto his servants, Seek me a woman that hath a familiar spirit, that I may go to her, and enquire of her. And his servants said to him, Behold, *there is* a woman that hath a familiar spirit at Endor.
- Deuteronomy 18:11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with <u>familiar</u> <u>spirits</u>, or a wizard, or a necromancer.
- Isaiah 8:19 And when they shall say unto you, Seek unto them that have <u>familiar spirits</u>, and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter: should not a people seek unto their God? for the living to the dead?
- Matthew 12:24-29 But when the Pharisees heard it, they said, This fellow doth not cast out devils, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils. 25 And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand: 26 And if Satan cast out Satan, he is divided against himself; how shall then his kingdom stand? 27 And if I by Beelzebub cast out devils, by whom do your children cast them out? therefore they shall be your judges. 28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you. 29 Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first bind the strong man? and then he will spoil his house. 30 He that is not with me is against me; and he that gathereth not with me scattereth abroad.
- Bind the strong man first in Jesus' name & cast out the demons from Christians is like spoiling his house.
- Matthew 12:30 He that is not with me is against me; and he that gathereth not with me scattereth abroad.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Luke 10:17-21 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name. 18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. 19 Behold, <u>I give unto</u>

you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. 20 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven. 21 In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight.

- For Christians, Bind the strong man in Jesus' name. Cast out the demons in Jesus' name. We loose into them the spirits of God.
- Matthew 12:43 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through <u>dry places</u>, seeking rest, and findeth none. 44 Then he saith, I will return into my house from whence I came out; and when he is come, he findeth *it* empty, swept, and garnished. 45 Then goeth he, and taketh with himself seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter in and dwell there: and the last *state* of that man is worse than the first. Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation.
- Luke 11:24 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through <u>dry places</u>, seeking rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out. 25 And when he cometh, he findeth *it* swept and garnished. 26 Then goeth he, and taketh *to him* seven other spirits more wicked than himself; and they enter in, and dwell there: and the last *state* of that man is worse than the first.
- Acts 8, 13, & 19 has exapmles of deliverances in the New Church.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are <u>sealed</u> unto the <u>day</u> of <u>redemption</u>.
- 1 Corinthians 10:21 Ye cannot drink the cup of the <u>Lord</u>, and the cup of <u>devils</u>: ye cannot be partakers of the <u>Lord</u>'s <u>table</u>, and of the <u>table</u> of <u>devils</u>.
- Joshua 15:24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
