Start Your Work to Jesus Christ - Joshua 5C

Joshua 5:13-15 And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and, behold, there stood a man over against him with his sword drawn in his hand: and Joshua went unto him, and said unto him, Art thou for us, or for our adversaries? 14 And he said, Nay; but as Captain of the host of the LORD am I now come. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and did worship, and said unto him, What saith my Lord unto His servant? 15 And the Captain of the LORD'S host said unto Joshua, Loose thy shoe from off thy foot; for the place whereon thou standest is holy. And Joshua did so.

Jesus reveals Himself in human form to Joshua.

Summarized the situation with Isreal up to now.

Joshua was studying Jericho for his strategy when Jesus revealed himself.

A comon saying - fools rush in where angels fear to tread.

Joshua 2:9 And she said unto the men, I know that the LORD hath given you the land, and that your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you.

The Angel of the Lotd usually is Jesus pre-incarnate in the Old Testament.

Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. 12 For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD: and because of these abominations the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee. 13 Thou shalt be perfect with the LORD thy God. 14 For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so to do.

Joshua 5:13,14 And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and, behold, there stood a man over against him with his sword drawn in his hand: and Joshua went unto him, and said unto him, Art thou for us, or for our adversaries? (Whose side are you on?) 14 And he said, Nay; but as Captain of the host of the LORD am I now come. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and did worship, and said unto him, What saith my Lord unto His servant?

Sometimes God fought against a very sinful Isreal.

Revelation 19:15 And out of His mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he

should smite the nations: and He shall rule them with a rod of iron: and He treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. 16 And he hath on *his* vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

- Acts 5 Ananias & Saphira were "slain" in the spirit.
- Acts 4:3,4 And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven: 4 And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know <u>ye not</u> that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which <u>ye</u> have of God, and <u>ye</u> are <u>not</u> your <u>own</u>? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- God said often in Exodus 7 & 8 Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, <u>Go</u> unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, <u>Let</u> my people <u>go</u>, that they may <u>serve</u> me.
- Joshua 5:15 And the Captain of the LORD'S host said unto Joshua, Loose thy shoe from off thy foot; for the place whereon thou standest is holy. And Joshua did so.
- Shoes represent the filth of the world.
- 1 Corinthians 11:28-31 But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. 29 For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. 30 For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep. 31 For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged.
- Genesis 18:1-3 And the LORD appeared unto him (Abraham) in the plains of Mamre: and he sat in the tent door in the heat of the day; 2 And he lift up his eyes and looked, and, lo, three men stood by him: and when he saw *them*, he ran to meet them from the tent door, and bowed himself toward the ground, 3 And said, My Lord, if now I have found favour in thy sight, pass not away, I pray thee, from thy servant:
- 1 Samuel 3:10 And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for Thy servant heareth.
- Psalms 100:3 Know ye that the LORD he *is* God: *it is* he *that* hath made us, and not we ourselves; *we are* his people, and the sheep of his pasture.
- Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?
- Luke 14:31-32 Or what king, going to make war against another king, sitteth not down first, and consulteth whether he be able with ten

- thousand to meet him that cometh against him with twenty thousand? 32 Or else, while the other is yet a great way off, he sendeth an ambassador, and desireth conditions of peace.
- Isreal often stripped the wealth from the Temple to seek peace with enemies.
- In deliverance, we do not make leagues with the demons.
- Luke 14:33 So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple.
- Summarized situation in Gideon chapter 7.
- Revelation 1:16 And He had in his right hand seven stars: and out of His mouth went a sharp twoedged <u>sword</u>: and His countenance *was* as the sun shineth in His strength.
- 2 Kings 6:17 And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, <u>open his eyes</u>, that he may <u>see</u>. And the LORD opened the <u>eyes</u> of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain *was* full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.
- Revelation 2:12 And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write; These things saith He which hath the sharp <u>sword</u> with two edges;
- Revelation 2:16 Repent; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the <u>sword</u> of my mouth.
- Revelation 19:15 And out of His mouth goeth a sharp <u>sword</u>, that with it He should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.
- Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
- Luke 4 In the temptations Jesus replies to satan "It is written".
- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time *is come* that <u>judgment</u> must <u>begin</u> at the <u>house</u> of God: and if *it* first <u>begin</u> at us, what shall the end *be* of them that obey not the gospel of God?
- Revelation 19:21 And the remnant were slain with the <u>sword</u> of Him that sat upon the horse, which <u>sword</u> proceeded out of His mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.
- Matthew 12:30 He that is not with Me is against Me; and he that <u>gathereth</u> not with Me <u>scattereth</u> abroad.
- Mark 7:6 He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people <u>honoureth</u> me with *their* <u>lips</u>, but their <u>heart</u> is <u>far</u> from me.
- Luke 10:2 Therefore said he unto them, The <u>harvest</u> truly *is* great, but the labourers *are* few: <u>pray</u> ye therefore the Lord of the <u>harvest</u>, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest.

- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
- Luke 11:23 He that is not with Me is against Me: and he that gathereth not with Me scattereth.
- Summarized situation of Balaam in Numbers 22. V31 Then the LORD opened the eyes of Balaam, and he saw the angel of the LORD standing in the way, and his sword drawn in his hand: and he bowed down his head, and fell flat on his face.
- Daniel 3:25 He (Nebuchadnezzar) answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God.
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of <u>Balaam</u>, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- Joshua 13:22 <u>Balaam</u> also the son of Beor, the <u>soothsayer</u>, did the children of Israel slay with the sword among them that were slain by them.
- Exodus 3:1,2 Now Moses kept the flock of Jethro his father in law, the priest of Midian: and he led the flock to the backside of the desert, and came to the mountain of God, even to Horeb. 2 And the Angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed.
- In Acts 4 Jesus appeared to Saul from heaven
- Exodus 3:3-5 And Moses said, I will now turn aside, and see this great sight, why the bush is not burnt. 4 And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I. (Like young Samuel) 5 And He said, Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest is holy ground. (Like with Joshua)
- Exodus 19:23 And Moses said unto the LORD, The people cannot come up to mount Sinai: for thou chargedst us, saying, Set bounds about the mount, and sanctify it.
- Exodus 3:6 Moreover he said, I am the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God.
