The Spirit of Oppression - Acts 10:38

- Peter preaching to Cornelius & friends:
- Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and <u>healing all that were</u> oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.
- Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
- Philippians 2:12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, <u>work out</u> your own salvation with fear and trembling.
- Psalm 23:3 He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.
- Matthew 4:23-25 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and those that had the palsy; and he healed them. 25 And there followed him great multitudes of people from Galilee, and from Decapolis, and from Jerusalem, and from Judaea, and from beyond Jordan.
- John 9:2,3 And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind?
- 3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.
- Proverbs 26:2 As the bird by wandering, as the swallow by flying, so the curse causeless shall not come.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Luke 8 The account of the Sower referred to.
- The is a big difference between Acts 1&2 when they were baptised with the Holy Spirit.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- John 8:32,36 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. 36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
- 1 Corinthians 2:4 And my speech and my <u>preaching</u> was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

- Romans 12:21 Be not <u>overcome</u> of <u>evil</u>, but <u>overcome</u> <u>evil</u> with <u>good</u>.
- Strongs #1228 diabolov diabolos *dee-ab'-ol-os* from <u>1225</u>; TDNT-2:72,150; adj AV-devil 35, false accuser 2, slanderer 1; 38
- prone to slander, slanderous, accusing falsely
 a calumniator, false accuser, slanderer,
- 2) metaph. applied to a man who, by opposing the cause of God, may be said to act the part of the devil or to side with him
- satan the prince of the demons, the author of evil, persecuting good men, estranging mankind from God and enticing them to sin, afflicting them with diseases by means of demons who take possession of their bodies at his bidding.
- Acts 7:24 And seeing one [of them] suffer wrong, he defended [him], and avenged him that was oppressed, and smote the Egyptian:
- James 2:6 But ye have despised the poor. Do not rich men oppress you, and draw you before the judgment seats?
- Matthew 10:10 Nor scrip for *your* journey, neither two coats, neither shoes, nor yet staves: for the <u>workman is worthy of his meat.</u>
- Exodus 20:17A Thou shalt not covet ...
- Matthew 6:12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.
- Isaiah 58:6 *Is* not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the <u>oppressed</u> go free, and that ye break every yoke?
- Exodus 3:9 Now therefore, behold, the cry of the children of Israel is come unto me: and I have also seen the <u>oppression</u> wherewith the Egyptians <u>oppress</u> them.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, <u>Go</u> unto Pharaoh, & say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, <u>Let</u> my <u>people go</u>, that they may <u>serve</u> <u>me</u>.
- Exodus 22:21 Thou shalt neither vex a stranger, nor <u>oppress</u> him: for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.
- Isaiah 3:12 *As for* my people, children *are* their <u>oppressors</u>, and women rule over them. O my people, they which lead thee cause *thee* to err, and destroy the way of thy paths.
- Exodus 23:9 Also thou shalt not <u>oppress</u> a stranger: for ye know the heart of a stranger, seeing ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.
- Leviticus 25:14 And if thou sell ought unto thy neighbour, or buyest *ought* of thy neighbour's hand, ye shall not <u>oppress</u> one another:
- Leviticus 25:17 Ye shall not therefore <u>oppress</u> one another; but thou shalt fear thy God: for I *am* the LORD your God.
- Numbers 10:9 And if ye go to war in your land against the enemy that oppresseth you, then ye shall blow an alarm with the trumpets; and ye shall be remembered before the LORD your God, and ye shall be saved from your enemies.

- In the New Testament this was not done.
- Matthew 14:30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, <u>Lord</u>, <u>save me</u>.
- John 16:26 At that day ye shall ask <u>in my name</u>: and I say not unto you, that I will <u>pray</u> the Father for you: 27 For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God.
- Deuteronomy 23:16 He shall dwell with thee, *even* among you, in that place which he shall choose in one of thy gates, where it liketh him best: thou shalt not oppress him.
- Deuteronomy 24:14 Thou shalt not <u>oppress</u> an hired servant *that is* poor and needy, *whether he be* of thy brethren, or of thy strangers that *are* in thy land within thy gates:
- Deuteronomy 26:7 And when we cried unto the LORD God of our fathers, the LORD heard our voice, and looked on our affliction, and our labour, and our oppression:
- Deuteronomy 28 & 29 have the blessings & curses listed.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 summarized. V9 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations.
- Judges 2:18 And when the LORD raised them up judges, then the LORD was with the judge, and delivered them out of the hand of their enemies all the days of the judge: for it repented the LORD because of their groanings by reason of them that <u>oppressed</u> them and vexed them.
- Judges 4:3 And the children of Israel cried unto the LORD: for he had nine hundred chariots of iron; and twenty years he mightily <u>oppressed</u> the children of Israel.
- Judges 6:9 And I delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians, and out of the hand of <u>all that oppressed</u> you, and drave them out from before you, and gave you their land; (God reminds Isreal of His Freedom given them.)
- Judges 10:8 And that year they vexed and <u>oppressed</u> the children of Israel: eighteen years, all the children of Israel that *were* on the other side Jordan in the land of the Amorites, which *is* in Gilead.
- Through the Judges, Isreal repents & God delivers them then when they sin again, they go in bondage again, etc.
- 1 Samuel 12:3 Behold, here I am: witness against me before the LORD, and before his anointed: whose ox have I taken? or whose ass have I taken? or whom have I defrauded? whom have I oppressed? or of whose hand have I received any bribe to blind mine eyes therewith? and I will restore it you.
- 1 Samuel 8:7 And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto <u>thee</u>: for they have not <u>rejected thee</u>, but they have <u>rejected me</u>, that I should not reign over them.

- 1 Samuel 12:4 And they said, Thou hast not defrauded us, nor <u>oppressed</u> us, neither hast thou taken ought of any man's hand.
- Religious oppression with fear of excommunication curses.

More service Notes:

- Deuteronomy 28:29 And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness, and thou shalt not prosper in thy ways: and thou shalt be only <u>oppressed</u> and spoiled evermore, and no man shall save *thee*.
- Deuteronomy 28:33 The fruit of thy land, and all thy labours, shall a nation which thou knowest not eat up; and thou shalt be only <u>oppressed</u> and crushed alway:
- Judges 10:12 The Zidonians also, & the Amalekites, & the Maonites, did oppress you; and ye cried to me, and I delivered you out of their hand.
- 1 Samuel 10:18 And said unto the children of Israel, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, I brought up Israel out of Egypt, and delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians, and out of the hand of all kingdoms, *and* of them that <u>oppressed</u> you:
- 2 Kings 13:4 And Jehoahaz besought the LORD, and the LORD hearkened unto him: for he saw the <u>oppression</u> of Israel, because the king of Syria <u>oppressed</u> them.
- 2 Kings 13:22 But Hazael king of Syria <u>oppressed</u> Israel all the days of Jehoahaz.
- 2 Chronicles 16:10 Then Asa was wroth with the seer, and put him in a prison house; for *he was* in a rage with him because of this *thing*. And Asa <u>oppressed</u> some of the people the same time.
- Job 3:18 *There* the prisoners rest together; they hear not the voice of the <u>oppressor</u>.
- Job 10:3 *Is it* good unto thee that thou shouldest <u>oppress</u>, that thou shouldest despise the work of thine hands, and shine upon the counsel of the wicked?
- Job 15:20 The wicked man travaileth with pain all *his* days, and the number of years is hidden to the <u>oppressor</u>.
- Job 20:19 Because he hath <u>oppressed</u> and hath forsaken the poor; because he hath violently taken away an house which he builded not;
- Job 27:13 This *is* the portion of a wicked man with God, and the heritage of <u>oppressors</u>, *which* they shall receive of the Almighty.
- Job 35:9 By reason of the multitude of <u>oppressions</u> they make *the* <u>oppressed</u> to cry: they cry out by reason of the arm of the mighty.
- Job 36:15 He delivereth the poor in his affliction, and openeth their ears in oppression.
- Psalms 9:9 The LORD also will be a refuge for the <u>oppressed</u>, a refuge in times of trouble.
- Psalms 10:18 To judge the fatherless and the oppressed, that the man of

- the earth may no more oppress.
- Psalms 12:5 For the <u>oppression</u> of the poor, for the sighing of the needy, now will I arise, saith the LORD; I will set *him* in safety *from him that* puffeth at him.
- Psalms 17:9 From the wicked that <u>oppress</u> me, *from* my deadly enemies, *who* compass me about.
- Psalms 42:9 I will say unto God my rock, Why hast thou forgotten me? why go I mourning because of the <u>oppression</u> of the enemy?
- Psalms 43:2 For thou *art* the God of my strength: why dost thou cast me off? why go I mourning because of the <u>oppression</u> of the enemy?
- Psalms 44:24 Wherefore hidest thou thy face, *and* forgettest our affliction and our oppression?
- Psalms 54:3 For strangers are risen up against me, and <u>oppressors</u> seek after my soul: they have not set God before them. Selah.
- Psalms 55:3 Because of the voice of the enemy, because of the <u>oppression</u> of the wicked: for they cast iniquity upon me, and in wrath they hate me.
- Psalms 56:1 To the chief Musician upon Jonathelemrechokim, Michtam of David, when the Philistines took him in Gath. Be merciful unto me, O God: for man would swallow me up; he fighting daily oppresseth me.
- Psalms 62:10 Trust not in <u>oppression</u>, and become not vain in robbery: if riches increase, set not your heart *upon them*.
- Psalms 72:4 He shall judge the poor of the people, he shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the <u>oppressor</u>.
- Psalms 73:8 They are corrupt, and speak wickedly *concerning* <u>oppression</u>: they speak loftily.
- Psalms 74:21 O let not the <u>oppressed</u> return ashamed: let the poor and needy praise thy name.
- Psalms 103:6 The LORD executeth righteousness and judgment for all that are oppressed.
- Psalms 106:42 Their enemies also <u>oppressed</u> them, and they were brought into subjection under their hand.
- Psalms 107:39 Again, they are minished and brought low through oppression, affliction, and sorrow.
- Psalms 119:121,122 AIN. I have done judgment and justice: leave me not to mine <u>oppressors</u>. 122 Be surety for thy servant for good: let not the proud <u>oppress</u> me.
- Psalms 119:134 Deliver me from the <u>oppression</u> of man: so will I keep thy precepts.
- Psalms 146:7 Which executeth judgment for the <u>oppressed</u>: which giveth food to the hungry. The LORD looseth the prisoners:
- Proverbs 3:31 Envy thou not the oppressor, and choose none of his ways.
- Proverbs 14:31 He that oppresseth the poor reproacheth his Maker: but he

- that honoureth him hath mercy on the poor.
- Proverbs 22:16 He that <u>oppresseth</u> the poor to increase his *riches, and* he that giveth to the rich, *shall* surely *come* to want.
- Proverbs 22:22 Rob not the poor, because he *is* poor: neither <u>oppress</u> the afflicted in the gate:
- Proverbs 28:3 A poor man that <u>oppresseth</u> the poor *is like* a sweeping rain which leaveth no food.
- Proverbs 28:16 The prince that wanteth understanding *is* also a great oppressor: *but* he that hateth covetousness shall prolong *his* days.
- Ecclesiastes 4:1 So I returned, and considered all the <u>oppressions</u> that are done under the sun: and behold the tears of <u>such as were oppressed</u>, and they had no comforter; and on the side of their <u>oppressors</u> there was power; but they had no comforter.
- Ecclesiastes 5:8 If thou seest the <u>oppression</u> of the poor, and violent perverting of judgment and justice in a province, marvel not at the matter: for *he that is* higher than the highest regardeth; and *there be* higher than they.
- Ecclesiastes 7:7 Surely <u>oppression</u> maketh a wise man mad; and a gift destroyeth the heart.
- Isaiah 1:17 Learn to do well; seek judgment, relieve the <u>oppressed</u>, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow.
- Isaiah 3:5 And the people shall be <u>oppressed</u>, every one by another, and every one by his neighbour: the child shall behave himself proudly against the ancient, and the base against the honourable.
- Isaiah 5:7 For the vineyard of the LORD of hosts *is* the house of Israel, and the men of Judah his pleasant plant: and he looked for judgment, but behold <u>oppression</u>; for righteousness, but behold a cry.
- Isaiah 9:4 For thou hast broken the yoke of his burden, and the staff of his shoulder, the rod of his oppressor, as in the day of Midian.
- Isaiah 14:2,4 And the people shall take them, and bring them to their place: and the house of Israel shall possess them in the land of the LORD for servants and handmaids: and they shall take them captives, whose captives they were; and they shall rule over their oppressors. 4 That thou shalt take up this proverb against the king of Babylon, and say, How hath the oppressor ceased! the golden city ceased!
- Isaiah 16:4 Let mine outcasts dwell with thee, Moab; be thou a covert to them from the face of the spoiler: for the extortioner is at an end, the spoiler ceaseth, the <u>oppressors</u> are consumed out of the land.
- Isaiah 19:20 And it shall be for a sign and for a witness unto the LORD of hosts in the land of Egypt: for they shall cry unto the LORD because of the <u>oppressors</u>, and he shall send them a saviour, and a great one, and he shall deliver them.

- Isaiah 23:12 And he said, Thou shalt no more rejoice, O thou <u>oppressed</u> virgin, daughter of Zidon: arise, pass over to Chittim; there also shalt thou have no rest.
- Isaiah 30:12 Wherefore thus saith the Holy One of Israel, Because ye despise this word, and trust in <u>oppression</u> and perverseness, and stay thereon:
- Isaiah 33:15 He that walketh righteously, and speaketh uprightly; he that despiseth the gain of <u>oppressions</u>, that shaketh his hands from holding of bribes, that stoppeth his ears from hearing of blood, and shutteth his eyes from seeing evil;
- Isaiah 38:14 Like a crane *or* a swallow, so did I chatter: I did mourn as a dove: mine eyes fail *with looking* upward: O LORD, I am <u>oppressed</u>; undertake for me.
- Isaiah 49:26 And I will feed them that <u>oppress</u> thee with their own flesh; and they shall be drunken with their own blood, as with sweet wine: and all flesh shall know that I the LORD *am* thy Saviour and thy Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob.
- Isaiah 51:13 And forgettest the LORD thy maker, that hath stretched forth the heavens, and laid the foundations of the earth; and hast feared continually every day because of the fury of the <u>oppressor</u>, as if he were ready to destroy? and where *is* the fury of the <u>oppressor</u>?
- Isaiah 52:4 For thus saith the Lord GOD, My people went down aforetime into Egypt to sojourn there; and the Assyrian <u>oppressed</u> them without cause.
- Isaiah 53:7 He was <u>oppressed</u>, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.
- Isaiah 54:14 In righteousness shalt thou be established: thou shalt be far from <u>oppression</u>; for thou shalt not fear: and from terror; for it shall not come near thee.
- Isaiah 59:13 In transgressing and lying against the LORD, and departing away from our God, speaking <u>oppression</u> and revolt, conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood.
- Jeremiah 6:6 For thus hath the LORD of hosts said, Hew ye down trees, and cast a mount against Jerusalem: this *is* the city to be visited; she *is* wholly oppression in the midst of her.
- Jeremiah 7:6 *If* ye <u>oppress</u> not the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, and shed not innocent blood in this place, neither walk after other gods to your hurt:
- Jeremiah 21:12 O house of David, thus saith the LORD; Execute judgment in the morning, and deliver *him that is* spoiled out of the hand of the <u>oppressor</u>, lest my fury go out like fire, and burn that none can quench *it*,

- because of the evil of your doings.
- Jeremiah 22:3 Thus saith the LORD; Execute ye judgment and righteousness, and deliver the spoiled out of the hand of the <u>oppressor</u>: and do no wrong, do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, nor the widow, neither shed innocent blood in this place.
- Jeremiah 22:17 But thine eyes and thine heart *are* not but for thy covetousness, and for to shed innocent blood, and for <u>oppression</u>, and for violence, to do *it*.
- Jeremiah 25:38 He hath forsaken his covert, as the lion: for their land is desolate because of the fierceness of the <u>oppressor</u>, and because of his fierce anger.
- Jeremiah 30:20 Their children also shall be as aforetime, and their congregation shall be established before me, and I will punish all that oppress them.
- Jeremiah 46:16 He made many to fall, yea, one fell upon another: and they said, Arise, and let us go again to our own people, and to the land of our nativity, from the oppressing sword.
- Jeremiah 50:16 Cut off the sower from Babylon, and him that handleth the sickle in the time of harvest: for fear of the <u>oppressing</u> sword they shall turn every one to his people, and they shall flee every one to his own land.
- Jeremiah 50:33 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The children of Israel and the children of Judah were <u>oppressed</u> together: and all that took them captives held them fast; they refused to let them go.
- Ezekiel 18:7 And hath not <u>oppressed</u> any, *but* hath restored to the debtor his pledge, hath spoiled none by violence, hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment;
- Ezekiel 18:12 Hath <u>oppressed</u> the poor and needy, hath spoiled by violence, hath not restored the pledge, and hath lifted up his eyes to the idols, hath committed abomination,
- Ezekiel 18:16,18 Neither hath <u>oppressed</u> any, hath not withholden the pledge, neither hath spoiled by violence, *but* hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment, 18 *As for* his father, because he cruelly <u>oppressed</u>, spoiled his brother by violence, and did *that* which *is* not good among his people, lo, even he shall die in his iniquity.
- Ezekiel 22:7 In thee have they set light by father and mother: in the midst of thee have they dealt by <u>oppression</u> with the stranger: in thee have they vexed the fatherless and the widow.
- Ezekiel 22:29 The people of the land have used <u>oppression</u>, and exercised robbery, and have vexed the poor and needy: yea, they have <u>oppressed</u> the stranger wrongfully.

- Ezekiel 45:8 In the land shall be his possession in Israel: and my princes shall no more <u>oppress</u> my people; and *the rest of* the land shall they give to the house of Israel according to their tribes.
- Ezekiel 46:18 Moreover the prince shall not take of the people's inheritance by <u>oppression</u>, to thrust them out of their possession; *but* he shall give his sons inheritance out of his own possession: that my people be not scattered every man from his possession.
- Hosea 5:11 Ephraim *is* <u>oppressed</u> *and* broken in judgment, because he willingly walked after the commandment.
- Hosea 12:7 *He is* a merchant, the balances of deceit *are* in his hand: he loveth to <u>oppress</u>.
- Amos 3:9 Publish in the palaces at Ashdod, and in the palaces in the land of Egypt, and say, Assemble yourselves upon the mountains of Samaria, and behold the great tumults in the midst thereof, and the <u>oppressed</u> in the midst thereof.
- Amos 4:1 Hear this word, ye kine of Bashan, that *are* in the mountain of Samaria, which <u>oppress</u> the poor, which crush the needy, which say to their masters, Bring, and let us drink.
- Micah 2:2 And they covet fields, and take *them* by violence; and houses, and take *them* away: so they <u>oppress</u> a man and his house, even a man and his heritage.
- Zephaniah 3:1 Woe to her that is filthy and polluted, to the <u>oppressing</u> city! Zechariah 7:10 And <u>oppress</u> not the widow, nor the fatherless, the stranger, nor the poor; and let none of you imagine evil against his brother in your heart.
- Zechariah 9:8 And I will encamp about mine house because of the army, because of him that passeth by, and because of him that returneth: and no <u>oppressor</u> shall pass through them any more: for now have I seen with mine eyes.
- Zechariah 10:4 Out of him came forth the corner, out of him the nail, out of him the battle bow, out of him every <u>oppressor</u> together.
- Malachi 3:5 And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against false swearers, and against those that <u>oppress</u> the hireling in *his* wages, the widow, and the fatherless, and that turn aside the stranger *from his right*, and fear not me, saith the LORD of hosts.
