- Joshua 6:6-16 And Joshua the son of Nun called the priests, and said unto them, Take up the ark of the covenant, and let seven priests bear seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the LORD. 7 And he said unto the people, Pass on, and compass the city, and let him that is armed pass on before the ark of the LORD. 8 And it came to pass, when Joshua had spoken unto the people, that the seven priests bearing the seven trumpets of rams' horns passed on before the LORD, and blew with the trumpets: and the ark of the covenant of the LORD followed them. 9 And the armed men went before the priests that blew with the trumpets, and the rereward came after the ark, the priests going on, and blowing with the trumpets. 10 And Joshua had commanded the people, saying, Ye shall not shout, nor make any noise with your voice, neither shall any word proceed out of your mouth, until the day I bid you shout; then shall ye shout. 11 So the ark of the LORD compassed the city, going about it once: and they came into the camp, and lodged in the camp. 12 And Joshua rose early in the morning, and the priests took up the ark of the LORD. 13 And seven priests bearing seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the LORD went on continually, and blew with the trumpets: and the armed men went before them; but the rereward came after the ark of the LORD, the priests going on, and blowing with the trumpets. 14 And the second day they compassed the city once, and returned into the camp: so they did six days. 15 And it came to pass on the seventh day, that they rose early about the dawning of the day, and compassed the city after the same manner seven times: only on that day they compassed the city seven times. 16 And it came to pass at the seventh time, when the priests blew with the trumpets, Joshua said unto the people, Shout; for the LORD hath given you the city.
- Summarized the journey out of Egypt, the 40 years journey in the wilderness, crossing the Jordan, & getting right with the Lord in Gilgal.
- Deuteronomy 17:18,19 And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites: 19 And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them:
- 1 Samuel 4:4 So the people sent to Shiloh, that they might bring from thence the ark of the covenant of the LORD of hosts, which dwelleth

- between the cherubims: and the two sons of Eli, <u>Hophni</u> and Phinehas, were there with the ark of the covenant of God. (used as a talisman)
- Ephesians 6:11,13 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
- 1 Samuel 17:38,39 And Saul armed David with his armour, and he put an helmet of brass upon his head; also he armed him with a coat of mail. 39 And David girded his sword upon his armour, and he assayed to go; for he had not proved *it*. And David said unto Saul, I cannot go with these; for I have not proved *them*. And David put them off him.
- Acts 15:1,2A And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them,
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 (For the <u>weapons</u> of our warfare <u>are not carnal</u>, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)
- Joshua 6:6-8 And Joshua the son of Nun called the priests, and said unto them, Take up the ark of the covenant, and let seven priests bear seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the LORD. 7 And he said unto the people, Pass on, and compass the city, and let him that is armed pass on before the ark of the LORD. 8 And it came to pass, when Joshua had spoken unto the people, that the seven priests bearing the seven trumpets of rams' horns passed on before the LORD, and blew with the trumpets: and the ark of the covenant of the LORD followed them.
- Joshua 6:9 And the armed men went before the priests that blew with the trumpets, and the rereward came after the ark, the priests going on, and blowing with the trumpets.
- Ephesians 6:14-17 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; 15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:
- Joshua 6:10 And Joshua had commanded the people, saying, Ye shall not shout, nor make any noise with your voice, neither shall any word proceed out of your mouth, until the day I bid you shout; then shall ye shout.
- Genesis 11: 9 Therefore is the name of it called Babel; because the LORD did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did the LORD scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth.

- Joshua 6:11-13 So the ark of the LORD compassed the city, going about it once: and they came into the camp, and lodged in the camp. 12 And Joshua rose early in the morning, and the priests took up the ark of the LORD. 13 And seven priests bearing seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark of the LORD went on continually, and blew with the trumpets: and the armed men went before them; but the rereward came after the ark of the LORD, the priests going on, and blowing with the trumpets.
- Joshua 2:9 And she said unto the men, I know that the LORD hath given you the land, and that your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you.

The situation here at Jericho is representative of a New Believer.

Jesus is coming back soon with a shout.

- Joshua 6:14-1 And the second day they compassed the city once, and returned into the camp: so they did six days. 15 And it came to pass on the seventh day, that they rose early about the dawning of the day, and compassed the city after the same manner seven times: only on that day they compassed the city seven times.
- Daniel 5 Belshazzar's warning from God. V25 And this *is* the writing that was written, MENE, MENE, TEKEL, UPHARSIN.
- Joshua 6:16 And it came to pass at the seventh time, when the priests blew with the trumpets, Joshua said unto the people, <u>Shout; for the LORD hath given you the city</u>.
- Judges 7:19,20 So Gideon, and the hundred men that were with him, came unto the outside of the camp in the beginning of the middle watch; and they had but newly set the watch: and they blew the trumpets, and brake the pitchers that were in their hands. 20 And the three companies blew the trumpets, and brake the pitchers, and held the lamps in their left hands, and the trumpets in their right hands to blow withal: and they cried, The sword of the LORD, and of Gideon.
- 2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye not <u>unequally yoked</u> together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?
- Exodus 32:15-17 And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the two tables of the testimony were in his hand: the tables were written on both their sides; on the one side and on the other were they written. 16 And the tables were the work of God, and the writing was the writing of God, graven upon the tables. 17 And when Joshua heard the noise of the people as they shouted, he said unto Moses, There is a noise of war in the camp.

Summarized the situation here.

- Exodus 32:18,19 And he said, It is not the voice of them that shout for mastery, neither is it the voice of them that cry for being overcome: but the noise of them that sing do I hear. 19 And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: and Moses' anger waxed hot, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and brake them beneath the mount.
- Exodus 12:12 For I will pass through the land of <u>Egypt</u> this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of <u>Egypt</u>, both man and beast; and <u>against</u> all the <u>gods</u> of <u>Egypt</u> I will execute judgment: I *am* the LORD.
- Exodus 32:20 And he took the calf which they had made, and burnt it in the fire, and ground it to powder, and strawed it upon the water, and made the children of Israel drink of it.
- John 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, <u>It is finished</u>: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.
- Mark 16:9 Now when *Jesus* was risen early the <u>first</u> <u>day</u> of the <u>week</u>, he appeared <u>first</u> to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils.
- Matthew 12:40 For as <u>Jonas</u> was <u>three days</u> and <u>three nights</u> in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be <u>three days</u> and <u>three nights</u> in the heart of the earth.
- Acts 20:7 And upon the <u>first</u> <u>day</u> of the <u>week</u>, when the disciples came together to break bread, Paul preached unto them, ready to depart on the morrow; and continued his speech until midnight.
- Matthew 27:50 Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost.
- Mark 15:37 And Jesus cried with a loud voice, and gave up the ghost.
- Luke 23:46 And when Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, <u>Father</u>, <u>into thy hands I commend my spirit</u>: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost.
- Matthew 27:46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, Iama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?
- Mark 15:39 And when the centurion, which stood over against him, saw that he so cried out, and gave up the ghost, he said, Truly this man was the Son of God.
- John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.
- Summarized some great works of Jesus.
- Psalm 19:1 The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.

- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Luke 15:7 I say unto you, that likewise <u>joy</u> shall be in <u>heaven</u> over one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance.
- 2 Kings 6:17 And Elisha prayed, and said, <u>LORD</u>, I pray thee, <u>open</u> his <u>eyes</u>, that he may <u>see</u>. And the <u>LORD</u> opened the <u>eyes</u> of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain *was* full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.
- Revelation 5:2 And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a <u>loud</u> voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof?
- Revelation 5:12 Saying with a <u>loud</u> voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.
- John 8:32,36 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
- Galatians 4:9 But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in <u>bondage</u>?
- Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of <u>bondage</u>.
- Revelation 6:10 And they cried with a <u>loud</u> voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?
- Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.
- Genesis 4:10 And he said, What hast thou done? the voice of thy brother's blood crieth unto me from the ground.
- Revelation 7:2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a <u>loud</u> voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,
- Amos interceded 4 times for God to withhold judgment & God delayed it 3 times.
- Summarized Abraham bargaining with the Lord to 10 righteous people in Genesis 18.
- 1 Chronicles 21:13 And David said unto Gad, I am in a great strait: let me fall now into the hand of the LORD; for very great *are* his mercies: but let me not fall into the hand of man.
- Revelation 7:10 And cried with a <u>loud</u> voice, saying, Salvation to our God

which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.

Matthew 21:9 And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed *is* he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest.

Jesus will return soon & Christians will shout for joy.

More Service Notes:

- Revelation 8:13 And I beheld, and heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a <u>loud</u> voice, Woe, woe, woe, to the inhabiters of the earth by reason of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound!
- Revelation 10:3 And cried with a <u>loud</u> voice, as *when* a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices.
- Revelation 12:10 And I heard a <u>loud</u> voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.
- Revelation 14:7 Saying with a <u>loud</u> voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.
- Revelation 14:9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a <u>loud</u> voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive *his* mark in his forehead, or in his hand,
- Revelation 14:15 And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a <u>loud</u> voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe.
- Revelation 14:18 And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a <u>loud</u> cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.
- Revelation 19:17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a <u>loud</u> voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;
