The Spirit of Corruption - Galatians 6'8

- Leviticus 11:45 For I *am* the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be holy, for I *am* holy.
- Ephesians 4:28 <u>Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour,</u> working with *his* hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.
- 1 Corinthians 10:13 There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God *is* faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear *it*.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. <u>Resist</u> the <u>devil</u>, and he will <u>flee</u> from you.
- Galatians 6:8 For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, <u>Go</u> unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, <u>Let</u> my people <u>go</u>, that they may <u>serve</u> me.

- Genesis 6:11 The earth also was <u>corrupt</u> before God, and the earth was filled with violence.
- Genesis 6:5 And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the

- earth, and *that* every imagination of the <u>thoughts</u> of his heart *was* <u>only</u> <u>evil continually</u>.
- Genesis 6:12 And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was <u>corrupt;</u> for all flesh had <u>corrupted</u> his way upon the earth.
- Exodus 8:24 And the LORD did so; and there came a grievous swarm *of flies* into the house of Pharaoh, and *into* his servants' houses, and into all the land of Egypt: the land was <u>corrupted</u> by reason of the swarm *of flies*.
- Exodus 32:7 And the LORD said unto Moses, Go, get thee down; for thy people, which thou broughtest out of the land of Egypt, have <u>corrupted</u> themselves:
- Summarized the situation there at Mount Zion where idolatry corrupted the isrealites before God.
- Leviticus 22:25 Neither from a stranger's hand shall ye offer the bread of your God of any of these; because their <u>corruption</u> is in them, and blemishes be in them: they shall not be accepted for you.
- Deuteronomy 4:16 Lest ye <u>corrupt yourselves</u>, and make you a graven image, the similitude of any figure, the likeness of male or female,
- Exodus 20:5 Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy <u>God</u> am a <u>jealous God</u>, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation* of them that hate me;
- Deuteronomy 4:25 When thou shalt beget children, and children's children, and ye shall have remained long in the land, and shall <u>corrupt</u> yourselves, and make a graven image, or the likeness of any thing, and shall do evil in the sight of the LORD thy God, to provoke him to anger:
- Deuteronomy 9:12 And the LORD said unto me, Arise, get thee down quickly from hence; for thy people which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt have <u>corrupted themselves</u>; they are quickly turned aside out of the way which I commanded them; they have made them a molten image.
- Deuteronomy 31:29 For I know that after my death ye will <u>utterly corrupt</u> <u>yourselves</u>, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you; and evil will befall you in the latter days; because <u>ye will do evil</u> in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger through the work of your hands.
- Deuteronomy 32:5 They have <u>corrupted themselves</u>, their spot *is* not *the spot* of his children: *they are* a <u>perverse and crooked generation</u>.
- Judges 2:19 And it came to pass, when the judge was dead, *that* they returned, and <u>corrupted *themselves* more</u> than their fathers, in following other gods to serve them, and to bow down unto them; they ceased not

- from their own doings, nor from their stubborn way.
- Ezekiel 14:3 Son of man, these men have set up their <u>idols</u> in their <u>heart</u>, and put the stumblingblock of their iniquity before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them?
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- 2 Kings 23:13 And the high places that were before Jerusalem, which were on the right hand of the mount of corruption, (on the Mount of Olives) which Solomon the king of Israel had builded for Ashtoreth the abomination of the Zidonians, and for Chemosh the abomination of the Moabites, and for Milcom the abomination of the children of Ammon, did the king defile.
- 2 Chronicles 27:2 And he did *that which was* right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father Uzziah did: howbeit he entered not into the temple of the LORD. And the <u>people did yet corruptly</u>.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 1 Chronicles 21:1 And <u>Satan</u> stood up against Israel, and provoked <u>David</u> to number Israel. Summarized of the people judged when David sinned & numbered Israel.
- Nehemiah 1:7 We have dealt very <u>corruptly</u> against thee, and have not kept the commandments, nor the statutes, nor the judgments, which thou commandedst thy servant Moses.
- Ezra, Nehemiah, & Daniel 9 all have good prayers confessing the sins of the fathers.
- Psalms 14:1 To the chief Musician, *A Psalm* of David. The fool hath said in his heart, *There is* no God. They are <u>corrupt</u>, they have done abominable works, *there is* none that doeth good.
- Psalms 53:1 To the chief Musician upon Mahalath, Maschil, *A Psalm* of David. The fool hath said in his heart, *There is* no God. <u>Corrupt</u> are they, and have done abominable iniquity: <u>there is</u> none that doeth good.
- Isaiah 1:4 Ah <u>sinful nation</u>, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have provoked the Holy One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward.
- Isaiah 3:12 *As for* my people, <u>children</u> *are* their <u>oppressors</u>, and women rule over them. O my people, they which lead thee cause *thee* to err, and destroy the way of thy paths.
- Jeremiah 6:28 They *are* all grievous revolters, walking with slanders: *they* are brass and iron; they are all corrupters.

- Ezekiel 16:47 Yet hast thou not walked after their ways, nor done after their abominations: but, as *if that were* a very little *thing*, thou wast <u>corrupted</u> more than they in all thy ways.
- Ezekiel 28:17 Thine heart was lifted up because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee. (the devil, satan)
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Daniel 2:9 But if ye will not make known unto me the dream, there is but one decree for you: for ye have prepared lying and corrupt words to speak before me, till the time be changed: therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that ye can shew me the interpretation thereof.
- Summarized of the corruptness against Daniel.
- Hosea 9:9 They have deeply <u>corrupted</u> themselves, as in the days of Gibeah: therefore he will remember their iniquity, he will visit their sins.
- Strongs #853 aphanizo *af-an-id'-zo* AV-corrupt 2, disfigure 1, perish 1, vanish away 1; 5 1) to snatch out of sight, to put out of view, to make unseen 2) to cause to vanish away, to destroy, consume 3) to deprive of lustre, render unsightly 3a) to disfigure
- Strongs #1312 diaphthora *dee-af-thor-ah'* AV-corruption 6; 6 1) corruption, destruction 2) in the NT that destruction which is effected by the decay of the body after death
- Matthew 6:19-21 Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth <u>corrupt</u>, and where thieves break through and steal: 20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth <u>corrupt</u>, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: 21 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.
- 1 Timothy 6:10 For the <u>love of money is the root of all evil</u>: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- Matthew 7:17,18,20 Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a <u>corrupt</u> tree bringeth forth evil fruit. 18 A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither *can* a <u>corrupt</u> tree bring forth good fruit. 20 Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.
- Matthew 12:33 Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by *his* fruit.
- Acts 2:27 Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see <u>corruption</u>.

- Acts 2:31 He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption.
- Acts 13:34 And as concerning that he raised him up from the dead, *now* no more to return to <u>corruption</u>, he said on this wise, I will give you the sure mercies of David.
- Proverbs 16:31 The <u>hoary head</u> is a crown of glory, if it be found in the way of righteousness.
- Romans 1:23 And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to <u>corruptible</u> man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.
- Romans 8:21 Because the creature itself also shall be <u>delivered from the</u> <u>bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty</u> of the children of God.
- 1 Corinthians 9:25 And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they *do it* to obtain a <u>corruptible</u> crown; but we an incorruptible (rewards from God).
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 <u>Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good</u> manners.
- 1 Corinthians 15:42 So also *is* the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in <u>corruption</u>; it is raised in <u>incorruption</u>: (our new body)
- 1 Corinthians 15:53 For this <u>corruptible</u> must put on incorruption, and this mortal *must* put on immortality.
- 2 Corinthians 2:17 For we are not as <u>many</u>, <u>which corrupt the word of God</u>: but as of <u>sincerity</u>, but as of God, in the sight of God speak we in Christ.
- Many time Jesus correctly interpreted the Scriptures which had been misinterpreted.
- 2 Corinthians 7:2 Receive us; we have wronged no man, we have <u>corrupted</u> no man, we have defrauded no man.
- 2 Corinthians 11:3 But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent <u>beguiled</u>

 <u>Eve through his subtilty</u>, so <u>your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ</u>.
- Ephesians 4:22 That ye <u>put off concerning the former conversation the old</u>
 man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;
- Ephesians 4:29 Let no <u>corrupt communication</u> proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.
- James 3:5 Even so the <u>tongue</u> is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little <u>fire</u> kindleth!
- James 3:6 And the <u>tongue</u> *is* a <u>fire</u>, a world of iniquity: so is the <u>tongue</u> among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on <u>fire</u> the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.

- 1 Corinthians 16:15 I beseech you, brethren, (ye know the house of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and *that* they have <u>addicted</u> themselves to the <u>ministry</u> of the <u>saints</u>,)
- Romans 12:14 Bless them which persecute you: bless, and curse not.
- 1 Timothy 6:5 <u>Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute</u> of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in <u>sheep</u>'s clothing, but inwardly they are ravening <u>wolves</u>.
- Acts 13:10 And said, O <u>full of all subtilty and all mischief</u>, <u>thou child of the</u> <u>devil</u>, <u>thou enemy of all righteousness</u>, <u>wilt thou not cease to pervert the</u> <u>right ways of the Lord?</u>
- 2 Timothy 3:8 Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also <u>resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith</u>. (not saved)
- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- James 5:2 Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are motheaten.
- 1 Peter 1:18 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were <u>not redeemed with</u> <u>corruptible things</u>, *as* silver and gold, from your vain conversation *received* by tradition from your fathers;
- 1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.
- 1 Peter 1:23 Being born again, not of <u>corruptible</u> seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.
- 1 Peter 3:4 But *let it be* the <u>hidden man of the heart</u> (a changed life), in that which is <u>not corruptible</u>, *even the ornament* of a <u>meek and quiet spirit</u>, which is in the sight of God of great price.
- 2 Peter 1:4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the <u>corruption that is in the world through lust</u>.
- 2 Peter 2:12 But these, as <u>natural brute beasts</u>, made to be taken and destroyed, <u>speak evil</u> of the things that they understand not; and shall <u>utterly perish in their own corruption</u>;
- Jude 1:10 But these <u>speak evil</u> of those things which they know not: but what they know naturally, as <u>brute beasts</u>, in those things they <u>corrupt</u> themselves.

- Revelation 19:2 For true and righteous *are* his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did <u>corrupt</u> the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand.
- Christians can get free by Confessing own sins, & of fathers, and breaking off evil soul ties in Jesus' name.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

More Service Notes:

- Job 17:1 My breath is <u>corrupt</u>, my days are extinct, the graves *are ready* for me.
- Job 17:14 I have said to <u>corruption</u>, Thou *art* my father: to the worm, *Thou art* my mother, and my sister.
- Psalms 16:10 For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.
- Psalms 38:5 My wounds stink and are corrupt because of my foolishness.
- Psalms 49:9 That he should still live for ever, and not see corruption.
- Psalms 73:8 They are <u>corrupt</u>, and speak wickedly *concerning* oppression: they speak loftily.
- Proverbs 25:26 A righteous man falling down before the wicked *is as* a troubled fountain, and a corrupt spring.
- Isaiah 38:17 Behold, for peace I had great bitterness: but thou hast in love to my soul *delivered it* from the pit of <u>corruption</u>: for thou hast cast all my sins behind thy back.
- Ezekiel 20:44 And ye shall know that I *am* the LORD, when I have wrought with you for my name's sake, not according to your wicked ways, nor according to your <u>corrupt</u> doings, O ye house of Israel, saith the Lord GOD.
- Ezekiel 23:11 And when her sister Aholibah saw *this*, she was more <u>corrupt</u> in her inordinate love than she, and in her whoredoms more than her sister in *her* whoredoms.
- Daniel 10:8 Therefore I was left alone, and saw this great vision, and there remained no strength in me: for my comeliness was turned in me into <u>corruption</u>, and I retained no strength.
- Daniel 11:17 He shall also set his face to enter with the strength of his whole kingdom, and upright ones with him; thus shall he do: and he shall give him the daughter of women, <u>corrupting</u> her: but she shall not stand on his side, neither be for him.
- Daniel 11:32 And such as do wickedly against the covenant shall he <u>corrupt</u> by flatteries: but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do *exploits*.

- Jonah 2:6 I went down to the bottoms of the mountains; the earth with her bars was about me for ever: yet hast thou brought up my life from corruption, O LORD my God.
- Zephaniah 3:7 I said, Surely thou wilt fear me, thou wilt receive instruction; so their dwelling should not be cut off, howsoever I punished them: but they rose early, and <u>corrupted</u> all their doings.
- Malachi 1:14 But cursed *be* the deceiver, which hath in his flock a male, and voweth, and sacrificeth unto the Lord a <u>corrupt</u> thing: for I *am* a great King, saith the LORD of hosts, and my name *is* dreadful among the heathen.
- Malachi 2:3 Behold, I will <u>corrupt</u> your seed, and spread dung upon your faces, *even* the dung of your solemn feasts; and *one* shall take you away with it.
- Malachi 2:8 But ye are departed out of the way; ye have caused many to stumble at the law; ye have <u>corrupted</u> the covenant of Levi, saith the LORD of hosts.
- Luke 6:43 For a good tree bringeth not forth <u>corrupt</u> fruit; neither doth a <u>corrupt</u> tree bring forth good fruit.
- Luke 12:33 Sell that ye have, and give alms; provide yourselves bags which wax not old, a treasure in the heavens that faileth not, where no thief approacheth, neither moth <u>corrupteth</u>.
- Acts 13:35-37 Wherefore he saith also in another *psalm*, Thou shalt not suffer thine Holy One to see <u>corruption</u>. 36 For David, after he had served his own generation by the will of God, fell on sleep, and was laid unto his fathers, and saw <u>corruption</u>: 37 But he, whom God raised again, saw no <u>corruption</u>.
- 1 Corinthians 15:50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth <u>corruption</u> inherit incorruption.
- 1 Corinthians 15:54 So when this <u>corruptible</u> shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.
- 2 Peter 2:19 While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of <u>corruption</u>: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage.
