Tools of the devil - Zodiac and Tattoos - Acts 28B

Summarized Paul going through the storm.

- Acts 27:23,24 For there stood by me this night the angel of God, whose I am, and whom I serve, 24 Saying, Fear not, Paul; thou must be brought before Caesar: and, Io, God hath given thee all them that sail with thee.
- Acts 28:11-16 And after three months we departed in a ship of Alexandria, which had wintered in the isle, whose sign was Castor and Pollux. 12 And landing at Syracuse, we tarried there three days. 13 And from thence we fetched a compass, and came to Rhegium: and after one day the south wind blew, and we came the next day to Puteoli: 14 Where we found brethren, and were desired to tarry with them seven days: and so we went toward Rome. 15 And from thence, when the brethren heard of us, they came to meet us as far as Appii forum, and The three taverns: whom when Paul saw, he thanked God, and took courage. 16 And when we came to Rome, the centurion delivered the prisoners to the captain of the guard: but Paul was suffered to dwell by himself with a soldier that kept him.
- Acts 28:11-16 (NKJV) After three months we sailed in an Alexandrian ship whose figurehead was the Twin Brothers, (Gemini) which had wintered at the island. 12 And landing at Syracuse, we stayed three days. 13 From there we circled round and reached Rhegium. And after one day the south wind blew; and the next day we came to Puteoli, 14 where we found brethren, and were invited to stay with them seven days. And so we went toward Rome. 15 And from there, when the brethren heard about us, they came to meet us as far as Appii Forum (or Way) and Three Inns. When Paul saw them, he thanked God and took courage.
- Job 2:3 And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant <u>Job</u>, that *there is* none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his <u>integrity</u>, although thou movedst

- me against him, to destroy him without cause.
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an <u>advocate</u> with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
- Ecclesiastes 1:1-10 The words of the Preacher, the son of David, king in Jerusalem. 2 Vanity of vanities, saith the Preacher, vanity of vanities; all is vanity. 3 What profit hath a man of all his labour which he taketh under the sun? 4 *One* generation passeth away, and *another* generation cometh: but the earth abideth for ever. 5 The sun also ariseth, and the sun goeth down, and hasteth to his place where he arose. 6 The wind goeth toward the south, and turneth about unto the north; it whirleth about continually, and the wind returneth again according to his circuits. 7 All the rivers run into the sea; yet the sea is not full; unto the place from whence the rivers come, thither they return again. 8 All things are full of labour; man cannot utter it: the eye is not satisfied with seeing, nor the ear filled with hearing. 9 The thing that hath been, it is that which shall be; and that which is done is that which shall be done: and *there is* no new *thing* under the sun. 10 Is there any thing whereof it may be said, See, this is new? it hath been already of old time, which was before us.
- Ecclesiastes 3:1 To <u>every thing</u> there is a <u>season</u>, and a time to every purpose under the heaven: ...
- Acts 16:6,7 Now when they had gone throughout Phrygia and the region of Galatia, and were forbidden of the Holy Ghost to preach the word in Asia, 7 After they were come to Mysia, they assayed to go into Bithynia: but the Spirit suffered them not.
- Acts 16:9 And a vision appeared to Paul in the night; There stood a man of <u>Macedonia</u>, and prayed him, saying, <u>Come</u> over into <u>Macedonia</u>, and help us.
- Easton's Revised Bible Dictionary Castor and Pollux The "Dioscuri," two heroes of Greek and Roman mythology. Their figures were probably painted or sculptured on the prow of the ship which Luke refers to #Acts 28:11 They were regarded as the tutelary divinities of sailors. They appeared in the heavens as the constellation Gemini.

- Leviticus 19:28 Ye shall not make any <u>cuttings</u> in your <u>flesh</u> for the dead, nor print any marks upon you: I *am* the LORD.
- Leviticus 21:5 They shall not make baldness upon their head, neither shall they shave off the corner of their beard, nor make any <u>cuttings</u> in their <u>flesh</u>.
- Leviticus 11:45 For I *am* the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be holy, for I *am* holy.

- Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that

- ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?
- Acts 15:1,2 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.
- Galatians 3:11 But that no man is justified <u>by</u> the law in the sight of God, *it is* evident: for, The just shall live by faith.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
