Beware of the Con Artists - Joshua 9B

The Proverbs are full of warnings that are helpful.

- Joshua 9:3-14 And when the inhabitants of Gibeon heard what Joshua had done unto Jericho and to Ai, 4 They did work wilily, and went and made as if they had been ambassadors, and took old sacks upon their asses, and wine bottles, old, and rent, and bound up; 5 And old shoes and clouted upon their feet, and old garments upon them; and all the bread of their provision was dry and mouldy. 6 And they went to Joshua unto the camp at Gilgal, and said unto him, and to the men of Israel, We be come from a far country: now therefore make ye a league with us. 7 And the men of Israel said unto the Hivites. Peradventure ve dwell among us: and how shall we make a league with you? 8 And they said unto Joshua, We are thy servants. And Joshua said unto them, Who are ye? and from whence come ye? 9 And they said unto him, From a very far country thy servants are come because of the name of the LORD thy God: for we have heard the fame of Him, and all that He did in Egypt, 10 And all that He did to the two kings of the Amorites, that were beyond Jordan, to Sihon king of Heshbon, and to Og king of Bashan, which was at Ashtaroth. 11 Wherefore our elders and all the inhabitants of our country spake to us, saying, Take victuals with you for the journey, and go to meet them, and say unto them, We are your servants: therefore now make ye a league with us. 12 This our bread we took hot for our provision out of our houses on the day we came forth to go unto you; but now, behold, it is dry, and it is mouldy: 13 And these bottles of wine, which we filled, were new; and, behold, they be rent: and these our garments and our shoes are become old by reason of the very long journey. 14 And the men took of their victuals, and asked not counsel at the mouth of the LORD.

- Acts 5 Summarized of the Holy Spirit revealing to Peter that the heart of Ananias Sapphira was not right.

- Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a <u>discerner</u> of the thoughts

- and intents of the heart.
- Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, *even* those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to <u>discern</u> both good and evil.

- Joshua 9:5-7 And old shoes and clouted upon their feet, and old garments upon them; and all the bread of their provision was dry and mouldy. 6 And they went to Joshua unto the camp at Gilgal, and said unto him, and to the men of Israel, We be come from a far country: now therefore make ye a league with us. 7 And the men of Israel said unto the Hivites, Peradventure ye dwell among us; and how shall we make a league with you?

- 1 King 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

- Proverbs 1:4 To give subtilty <06195> to the simple, to the young man knowledge and discretion.
- Proverbs 8:5 O ye simple, understand wisdom <06195>: and, ye fools, be ye of an understanding heart.
- Proverbs 8:12 I wisdom dwell with prudence <06195>, and find out knowledge of witty inventions.
- Luke 16:1-8 And he said also unto his disciples, There was a certain rich man, which had a steward; and the same was accused unto him that he had wasted his goods. 2 And he called him, and said unto him, How is it that I hear this of thee? give an account of thy stewardship; for thou

mayest be no longer steward. 3 Then the steward said within himself, What shall I do? for my lord taketh away from me the stewardship: I cannot dig; to beg I am ashamed. 4 I am resolved what to do, that, when I am put out of the stewardship, they may receive me into their houses. 5 So he called every one of his lord's debtors *unto him*, and said unto the first, How much owest thou unto my lord? 6 And he said, An hundred measures of oil. And he said unto him, Take thy bill, and sit down quickly, and write fifty. 7 Then said he to another, And how much owest thou? And he said, An hundred measures of wheat. And he said unto him, Take thy bill, and write fourscore. 8 And the lord commended the unjust steward, because he had done wisely: for the <u>children of this world are in their generation wiser than the children of light</u>.

Exodus 7:8-13 And the LORD spake unto Moses and unto Aaron, saying, 9
When Pharaoh shall speak unto you, saying, Shew a miracle for you: then
thou shalt say unto Aaron, Take thy rod, and cast it before Pharaoh, and
it shall become a serpent. 10 And Moses and Aaron went in unto
Pharaoh, and they did so as the LORD had commanded: and Aaron cast
down his rod before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became a
serpent. 11 Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers:
now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their
enchantments. 12 For they cast down every man his rod, and they
became serpents: but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods. 13 And he
hardened Pharaoh's heart, that he hearkened not unto them; as the
LORD had said.

Lying signs and wonders from the devil.

- Genesis 3:1 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD <u>God</u> had made. And he <u>said</u> unto the woman, <u>Yea</u>, <u>hath</u> <u>God</u> <u>said</u>, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?
- Matthew 24:4,5 And Jesus answered and said unto them, <u>Take heed that no man deceive you</u>. 5 For many shall come in my name, saying, <u>I am Christ;</u> and shall deceive many.
- Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise <u>false Christs</u>, and <u>false prophets</u>, and <u>shall shew great signs and wonders</u>; insomuch that, <u>if *it were* possible</u>, <u>they shall deceive the very elect</u>.
- 1 Samuel 14:37 And Saul asked counsel of God, Shall I go down after the Philistines? wilt thou deliver them into the hand of Israel? But he answered him not that day. (Saul did not ask God's way.)
- 1 Chronicles 10:13,14 So Saul died for his transgression which he committed against the LORD, *even* against the word of the LORD, which he kept not, and also for asking *counsel* of *one that had* a familiar spirit,

to enquire *of it*; 14 And enquired not of the LORD: therefore he slew him, and turned the kingdom unto David the son of Jesse.

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a <u>discerner</u> of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

More Service Notes:

Isaiah 30:1,2 Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; and that cover with a covering, but not of my spirit, that they may add sin to sin: 2 That walk to go down into Egypt, and have not asked at my mouth; to strengthen themselves in the strength of Pharaoh, and to trust in the shadow of Egypt!

Luke 7:30 But the Pharisees and lawyers rejected the counsel of God against themselves, being not baptized of him.

Acts 20:27 For I have not shunned to declare unto you all the counsel of God.
