<u>Miraculas Victories For Godly People - Joshua 10B</u>

Joshua 10:7-14 So Joshua ascended from Gilgal, he, and all the people of war with him, and all the mighty men of valour. 8 And the LORD said unto Joshua, Fear them not: for I have delivered them into thine hand; there shall not a man of them stand before thee. 9 Joshua therefore came unto them suddenly, and went up from Gilgal all night. 10 And the LORD discomfited them before Israel, and slew them with a great slaughter at Gibeon, and chased them along the way that goeth up to Bethhoron, and smote them to Azekah, and unto Makkedah. 11 And it came to pass, as they fled from before Israel, and were in the going down to Bethhoron, that the LORD cast down great stones from heaven upon them unto Azekah, and they died: they were more which died with hailstones than they whom the children of Israel slew with the sword. 12 Then spake Joshua to the LORD in the day when the LORD delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand thou still upon Gibeon; and thou, Moon, in the valley of Ajalon. 13 And the sun stood still, and the moon stayed, until the people had avenged themselves upon their enemies. Is not this written in the book of Jasher? So the sun stood still in the midst of heaven, and hasted not to go down about a whole day. 14 And there was no day like that before it or after it, that the LORD hearkened unto the voice of a man: for the LORD fought for Israel.

Summarized the Lord's victories in the Promised Land thus far.

- Joshua 10:6 And the men of Gibeon sent unto Joshua to the camp to Gilgal, saying, Slack not thy hand from thy servants; come up to us quickly, and save us, and help us: for all the kings of the Amorites that dwell in the mountains are gathered together against us.
- Joshua 10:7 So Joshua ascended from Gilgal, he, and all the people of war with him, and <u>all the mighty men of valour</u>.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.
- Joshua 10:8 And the LORD said unto Joshua, <u>Fear them not: for I have</u> delivered them into your hand; there shall not a man of them stand before thee.
- 1 Samuel 17:48 And it came to pass, when the Philistine arose, and came and drew nigh to meet David, that <u>David hasted</u>, and ran toward the army to meet the Philistine.
- Joshua 10:9,10 Joshua therefore came unto them suddenly, and went up

from Gilgal all night. 10 And the <u>LORD discomfited them before Israel</u>, and slew them with a great slaughter at Gibeon, and chased them along the way that goeth up to Bethhoron, and smote them to Azekah, and unto Makkedah.

Judges 7 Summarized God's victory with Gideon's army.

Joshua 10:11 And it came to pass, as they fled from before Israel, and were in the going down to Bethhoron, that the <u>LORD cast down great stones</u> from heaven upon them unto Azekah, and they died: they were more which died with hailstones than they whom the children of Israel slew with the sword.

Exodus 9 Summarized of the plague of hail & fire in Egypt.

Joshua 10:12-14 Then spake Joshua to the LORD in the day when the LORD delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand thou still upon Gibeon; and thou, Moon, in the valley of Ajalon. 13 And the sun stood still, and the moon stayed, until the people had avenged themselves upon their enemies. Is not this written in the book of Jasher? So the sun stood still in the midst of heaven, and hasted not to go down about a whole day. 14 And there was no day like that before it or after it, that the LORD hearkened unto the voice of a man: for the LORD fought for Israel.

Joshua 10:14 (NKJV) there has been no day like that, before it or after it, that the <u>LORD heeded the voice of a man;</u> for the <u>LORD fought for Israel</u>.

Romans 8:31 What shall we then say to these things? If <u>God</u> be <u>for</u> us, <u>who</u> can be <u>against</u> us?

John 10;10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly.

Matthew 4:23-25 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick (mental illnesses), and those that had the palsy (paralysis); and He healed them. 25 And there followed Him great multitudes of people from Galilee, and from Decapolis, and from Jerusalem, and from Judaea, and from beyond Jordan.

Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me, all *ye* that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For My yoke *is* easy, and My burden is light.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and

- scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 16:17,18 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- 2 Samuel 23:8-12 These be the names of the mighty men whom David had:
 The Tachmonite that sat in the seat, chief among the captains; the same was Adino the Eznite: he lift up his spear against eight hundred, whom he slew at one time. 9 And after him was Eleazar the son of Dodo the Ahohite, one of the three mighty men with David, when they defied the Philistines that were there gathered together to battle, and the men of Israel were gone away: 10 He arose, and smote the Philistines until his hand was weary, and his hand clave unto the sword: and the LORD wrought a great victory that day; and the people returned after him only to spoil. 11 And after him was Shammah the son of Agee the Hararite. And the Philistines were gathered together into a troop, where was a piece of ground full of lentiles: and the people fled from the Philistines. 12 But he stood in the midst of the ground, and defended it, and slew the Philistines: and the LORD wrought a great victory.
- Judges 7:1-8 Then Jerubbaal, who is Gideon, and all the people that were with him, rose up early, and pitched beside the well of Harod: so that the host of the Midianites were on the north side of them, by the hill of Moreh, in the valley. 2 And the LORD said unto Gideon, The people that are with thee are too many for me to give the Midianites into their hands, lest Israel vaunt themselves against me, saying, Mine own hand hath saved me. 3 Now therefore go to, proclaim in the ears of the people, saying, Whosoever *is* fearful and afraid, let him return and depart early from mount Gilead. And there returned of the people twenty and two thousand; and there remained ten thousand. 4 And the LORD said unto Gideon, The people are yet too many; bring them down unto the water, and I will try them for thee there: and it shall be, that of whom I say unto thee, This shall go with thee, the same shall go with thee; and of whomsoever I say unto thee, This shall not go with thee, the same shall not go. 5 So he brought down the people unto the water: and the LORD said unto Gideon, Every one that lappeth of the water with his tongue, as a dog lappeth, him shalt thou set by himself; likewise every one that boweth down upon his knees to drink. 6 And the number of them that lapped, putting their hand to their mouth, were three hundred men: but all the rest of the people bowed down upon their knees to drink water. 7 And the LORD said unto Gideon, By the three hundred men that lapped will I save you, and deliver the Midianites into thine hand: and let all the

- other people go every man unto his place. 8 So the people took victuals in their hand, and their trumpets: and he sent all the rest of Israel every man unto his tent, and retained those three hundred men: and the host of Midian was beneath him in the valley.
- God's Word says 365 times do not fear, be not afraid, etc.
- 2 Timothy 1:7 For <u>God hath not given us the spirit of fear</u>; but <u>of power</u>, <u>and of love</u>, <u>and of a sound mind</u>.
- Acts 9:31 Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.
- Romans 15:19 Through mighty signs and wonders, by the <u>power</u> of the <u>Spirit</u> of God; so that from Jerusalem, and round about unto Illyricum, I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.
- Acts 16 Summarized the account of Paul casting out the spirit of divination from the girl that followed him.
- Luke 10:17-19 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name. 18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. 19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Joshua 10:10 And the <u>LORD discomfited them</u> before Israel, and slew them with a great slaughter at Gibeon, and chased them along the way that goeth up to Bethhoron, and smote them to Azekah, and unto Makkedah.
- Judges 4:15 And the <u>LORD discomfited Sisera</u>, and all *his* chariots, and all *his* host, with the edge of the sword before Barak; so that Sisera lighted down off *his* chariot, and fled away on his feet.
- 1 Samuel 7:10 And as Samuel was offering up the burnt offering, the Philistines drew near to battle against Israel: but the <u>LORD</u> thundered with a great thunder on that day upon the Philistines, and <u>discomfited them</u>; and they were smitten before Israel.
- Exodus 17:13 And <u>Joshua discomfited Amalek</u> and his people with the edge of the sword.
- Numbers 14:45 Then the Amalekites came down, and the Canaanites which dwelt in that hill, and smote them, and <u>discomfited them (Israelites)</u>, *even* unto Hormah.
- Numbers 14:1,2 And all the congregation lifted up their voice, and <u>cried</u>; and the people wept that <u>night</u>. 2 And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron: and the whole congregation said unto them, Would God that we had died in the land of Egypt! or would God we had died in this wilderness!
- Judges 8:12 And when Zebah and Zalmunna fled, he pursued after them, and took the two kings of Midian, Zebah and Zalmunna, and (Joshua)

discomfited all the host.

- 1 Samuel 7:10 And as Samuel was offering up the burnt offering, the Philistines drew near to battle against Israel: but the LORD thundered with a great thunder on that day upon the Philistines, and <u>discomfited</u> them; and they were smitten before Israel.
- 2 Samuel 22:15 And He sent out arrows, and scattered them; lightning, and discomfited them.
- Psalms 18:14 Yea, He sent out his arrows, and scattered them; and he shot out lightnings, and <u>discomfited them</u>.
- Isaiah 31:8 Then shall the Assyrian fall with the sword, not of a mighty man; and the sword, not of a mean man, shall devour him: but he shall flee from the sword, and his <u>young men shall be discomfited</u>.
- 2 Kings 20:11 And Isaiah the prophet cried unto the LORD: and he brought the shadow ten <u>degrees</u> backward, by which it had gone down in the <u>dial</u> of Ahaz.
- Isaiah 38:8 Behold, I will bring again the shadow of the <u>degrees</u>, which is gone down in the sun <u>dial</u> of Ahaz, ten <u>degrees</u> backward. So the sun returned ten <u>degrees</u>, by which <u>degrees</u> it was gone down.
- Summarized the account of Hezekiah sick & God healed him.
- 2 Kings 6 Summarized the account of the Serians coming for Isaiah Mark 16:15-18 And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Acts 26:18 To open their eyes, and to turn *them* from darkness to light, and *from* the power of <u>Satan</u> unto <u>God</u>, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, & inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.
- Romans 8:38,39 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
