How God Squashes the devils deputees - Joshua 10C

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

Summarized the situation here now.

- Joshua 10:11 And it came to pass, as they fled from before Israel, and were in the going down to Bethhoron, that the LORD cast down great stones from heaven upon them unto Azekah, and they died: they were more which died with hailstones than they whom the children of Israel slew with the sword.
- 1 Samuel 15 Summarized King Saul keeping some Amalakites alive. Hamon was a descendant of Agites to afflict the Jews with Queen Esther. Joshua 10:15 And Joshua returned, and all Israel with him, unto the camp to Gilgal.
- 16 But these five kings fled, and hid themselves in a cave at Makkedah.
- 17 And it was told Joshua, saying, The five kings are found hid in a cave at Makkedah.
- 18 And Joshua said, Roll great stones upon the mouth of the cave, and set men by it for to keep them:
- 19 And stay ye not, *but* pursue after your enemies, and smite the hindmost of them; suffer them not to enter into their cities: for the LORD your God hath delivered them into your hand.
- 20 And it came to pass, when Joshua and the children of Israel had made an end of slaying them with a very great slaughter, till they were consumed, that the rest *which* remained of them entered into fenced cities.
- 21 And all the people returned to the camp to Joshua at Makkedah in peace: none moved his tongue against any of the children of Israel.
- 22 Then said Joshua, Open the mouth of the cave, and bring out those five kings unto me out of the cave.
- 23 And they did so, and brought forth those five kings unto him out of the cave, the king of Jerusalem, the king of Hebron, the king of Jarmuth, the king of Lachish, *and* the king of Eglon.
- 24 And it came to pass, when they brought out those kings unto Joshua, that Joshua called for all the men of Israel, and said unto the captains of the men of war which went with him, Come near, put your feet upon the necks of these kings. And they came near, and put their feet upon the necks of them.
- 25 And Joshua said unto them, Fear not, nor be dismayed, be strong and of

- good courage: for thus shall the LORD do to all your enemies against whom ye fight.
- 26 And afterward Joshua smote them, and slew them, and hanged them on five trees: and they were hanging upon the trees until the evening.
- 27 And it came to pass at the time of the going down of the sun, *that*Joshua commanded, and they took them down off the trees, and cast them into the cave wherein they had been hid, and laid great stones in the cave's mouth, *which remain* until this very day.
- Joshua 10:15 And Joshua returned, and all Israel with him, unto the camp to Gilgal.
- 16 But these five kings fled, and hid themselves in a cave at Makkedah.
- 17 And it was told Joshua, saying, The five kings are found hid in a cave at Makkedah.
- In Deliverance, this is when we Bind the Strongman & spoil his house.
- 18 And Joshua said, Roll great stones upon the mouth of the cave, and set men by it for to keep them:
- Turn the demons' strength into their weekness, & let that which they fear come upon them.
- Ask for God's angels to aid in deliverance.
- 19 And stay ye not, *but* pursue after your enemies, and smite the hindmost of them; suffer them not to enter into their cities: for the LORD your God hath delivered them into your hand.
- Don't give the demons rest, keep them under pressure.
- 1 Corinthians 14:40 Let all things be done decently and in order.
- Luke 8 Summarized the account of the Gadarene demoniac set free by Jesus.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, <u>Go</u> unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, <u>Let</u> my people <u>go</u>, that they may <u>serve</u> me.
- Joshua 10:20 And it came to pass, when Joshua and the children of Israel had made an end of slaying them with a very great slaughter, till they were consumed, that the rest *which* remained of them entered into fenced cities.
- 21 And all the people returned to the camp to Joshua at Makkedah in peace: none moved his tongue against any of the children of Israel.
- Isaiah 37:33 Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning the king of Assyria, He shall <u>not</u> come into this city, nor <u>shoot</u> an <u>arrow</u> there, nor come before it with shields, nor cast a bank against it.
- David Berated while fleeing from Absalom.
- Joshua 10:22 Then said Joshua, Open the mouth of the cave, and bring out those five kings unto me out of the cave.
- 23 And they did so, and brought forth those five kings unto him out of the

- cave, the king of Jerusalem, the king of Hebron, the king of Jarmuth, the king of Lachish, *and* the king of Eglon.
- 24 And it came to pass, when they brought out those kings unto Joshua, that Joshua called for all the men of Israel, and said unto the <u>captains of the men of war which went with him, Come near, put your feet upon the necks of these kings</u>. And they came near, and put their feet upon the necks of them.
- 25 And Joshua said unto them, <u>Fear not</u>, <u>nor be dismayed</u>, <u>be strong and of good courage</u>: <u>for thus shall the LORD do to all your enemies against</u> whom ye fight.
- Do not fear the demons. They are the defeated foe.
- Mark 1:25 And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him.
- Luke 4:35 And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him. And when the devil had thrown him in the midst, he came out of him, and hurt him not.
- Joshua 10:26 And afterward Joshua smote them, and slew them, and hanged them on five trees: and they were hanging upon the trees until the evening.
- Like Samuel killed Agag since Saul feared the people.
- 27 And it came to pass at the time of the going down of the sun, *that*Joshua commanded, and they took them down off the trees, and cast them into the cave wherein they had been hid, and laid great stones in the cave's mouth, *which remain* until this very day.
- Strongs #04719 Maqqedah *mak-kay-daw'* AV-Makkedah 9; Makkedah =" place of shepherds"
- 1) the location of a cave in Judah where Joshua captured and executed five Canaanite kings during the conquest; located near Bethhoron and Libnah
- 1 Samuel 24 Summarized that David hid in a cave fleeing Saul.
- Joshua 10:16 But these five kings fled, and <u>hid</u> themselves in a <u>cave</u> at Makkedah.
- 17 And it was told Joshua, saying, The five kings are found <u>hid</u> in a <u>cave</u> at Makkedah.
- 27 And it came to pass at the time of the going down of the sun, *that*Joshua commanded, and they took them down off the trees, and cast
 them into the <u>cave</u> wherein they had been <u>hid</u>, and laid great stones in
 the <u>cave</u>'s mouth, *which remain* until this very day.
- 1 Samuel 13:6 When the men of Israel saw that they were in a strait, (for the people were distressed,) then the people did <u>hide</u> themselves in <u>caves</u>, and in thickets, and in rocks, and in high places, and in pits.
- Ask for God's angels to route out the demons hiding & send them to Tartarus, in Jesus' name.

- 1 Kings 18:4 For it was *so*, when Jezebel cut off the prophets of the LORD, that Obadiah took an hundred prophets, and <u>hid</u> them by fifty in a <u>cave</u>, and fed them with bread and water.)
- 13 Was it not told my lord what I did when Jezebel slew the prophets of the LORD, how I <u>hid</u> an hundred men of the LORD'S prophets by fifty in a <u>cave</u>, and fed them with bread and water?
- Matthew 26:52,53 Then said Jesus unto him, <u>Put up</u> again <u>thy sword</u> into his place: for all they that take the <u>sword</u> shall perish with the <u>sword</u>. 53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.
- Luke 10:17 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, <u>Lord, even the</u> <u>devils are subject unto us through thy name</u>.
- 1 Samuel 16:23 And it came to pass, when the *evil* spirit from God was upon <u>Saul</u>, that <u>David</u> took an harp, and <u>played</u> with his hand: so <u>Saul</u> was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; <u>In my name shall</u> they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Acts 8; 16; & 19 have demons cast out after Jesus' ascention.
- Luke 10:18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your <u>body</u> is the <u>temple</u> of the Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power (Authority) to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Ask the Lord to remove the demons power & authority, etc.
- Ask the Lord for your protection.
- Luke 8:28 When he (Legion of demons) saw Jesus, he cried out, and fell down before him, and with a loud voice said, What have I to do with thee, Jesus, *thou* Son of God most high? I beseech thee, torment me not.
- Matthew 12:22 Then was brought unto him one possessed with a devil, blind, and dumb: and he healed him, insomuch that the blind and dumb both spake and saw.
- 23 And all the people were amazed, and said, Is not this the son of David?
- 24 But when the Pharisees heard *it*, they said, This *fellow* doth not cast out devils, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils.
- 25 And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them, Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house

- divided against itself shall not stand:
- 26 And if Satan cast out Satan, he is divided against himself; how shall then his kingdom stand?
- 27 And if I by Beelzebub cast out devils, by whom do your children cast *them* out? therefore they shall be your judges.
- 28 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.
- 29 Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first <u>bind the strong man</u>? and <u>then he will spoil his</u> house.
- 30 He that is not with me is against me; and he that gathereth not with me scattereth abroad.
- Mark 3:22 And the scribes which came down from Jerusalem said, He hath Beelzebub, and by the prince of the devils casteth he out devils.
- 23 And he called them *unto him*, and said unto them in parables, How can Satan cast out Satan?
- 24 And if a kingdom be divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand.
- 25 And if a house be divided against itself, that house cannot stand.
- 26 And if Satan rise up against himself, and be divided, he cannot stand, but hath an end.
- 27 No man can enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he will <u>first bind the strong man; and then he will spoil his house</u>.
- Bind the strong man in Jesus' name then cast the other demons out in Jesus' name.
- 28 Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be forgiven unto the sons of men, and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall blaspheme:
- 29 But he that shall <u>blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never</u> <u>forgiveness</u>, but is in danger of eternal damnation:
- 30 Because they said, He hath an unclean spirit.
- Bind the strong man in Jesus' name for unbelievers, then cast down their demons & familiar spirits in Jesus' name.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
