## Mission Accomplished - Joshua 11B

- Summarized the battles Joshua won with God's help.
- Joshua 11:10-12 And Joshua at that time turned back, and took Hazor, and smote the king thereof with the sword: for Hazor beforetime was the head of all those kingdoms. 11 And they smote all the souls that were therein with the edge of the sword, <u>utterly destroying them: there was not any left to breathe</u>: and he burnt Hazor with fire. 12 And all the cities of those kings, and all the kings of them, did Joshua take, and smote them with the edge of the sword, and <u>he utterly destroyed them</u>, as Moses the servant of the LORD commanded.
- Job 38:4 Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding.
- Joshua 11:13 But as for the cities that stood still in their strength, Israel burned none of them, save Hazor only; that did Joshua burn. (NKJV) But as for the cities that stood on their mounds, Israel burned none of them, except Hazor only, which Joshua burned.
- God provided the crops for Isreal entering promised land.
- Exodus 23 & Deuteronomy 11 God tells the Israelites to clean out evil in the Promised Land.
- Numbers 33:55 But if ye will not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you; then it shall come to pass, that those which ye let remain of them *shall be* <u>pricks</u> in your <u>eyes</u>, and thorns in your sides, and shall vex you in the land wherein ye dwell.
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of <u>Balaam</u>, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- 2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye <u>not unequally yoked together with unbelievers</u>: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?
- 1 Samuel 15:22 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD *as great* delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey *is* better than sacrifice, *and* to hearken than the fat of rams.
- Joshua 11:14,15 And all the spoil of these cities, and the cattle, the children of Israel took for a prey unto themselves; but every man they smote with the edge of the sword, until they had <u>destroyed them, neither left they any to breathe</u>. 15 As the LORD commanded Moses his servant, so did Moses command Joshua, and so did Joshua; he left nothing undone of all that the LORD commanded Moses.
- 2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for

- what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?
- Joshua 11:16,17 So Joshua took all that land, the hills, and all the south country, and all the land of Goshen, and the valley, and the plain, and the mountain of Israel, and the valley of the same; 17 Even from the mount Halak, that goeth up to Seir, even unto Baalgad in the valley of Lebanon under mount Hermon: and all their kings he took, and smote them, and slew them.
- Zechariah 13:7 Awake, O sword, against my <u>shepherd</u>, and against the man *that is* my fellow, saith the LORD of hosts: <u>smite</u> the <u>shepherd</u>, and the sheep shall be scattered: and I will turn mine hand upon the little ones.
- Matthew 26:31 Then saith Jesus unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will <u>smite</u> the <u>shepherd</u>, and the sheep of the flock shall be scattered abroad.
- Mark 14:27 And Jesus saith unto them, All ye shall be offended because of me this night: for it is written, I will <u>smite</u> the <u>shepherd</u>, and the <u>sheep</u> shall be scattered.
- Luke 4:13 And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him <u>for</u> a <u>season</u>.
- Joshua 11:18 Joshua made war a long time with all those kings.
- Numbers 14:2 And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron: and the whole congregation said unto them, Would God that we had died in the land of Egypt! or would God we had died in this wilderness!
- Numbers 14:29 Your carcases shall fall in this wilderness; and all that were numbered of you, according to your whole number, from twenty years old and upward, which have murmured against me,
- Joshua 11:19 There was not a city that made peace with the children of Israel, save the Hivites the inhabitants of Gibeon: all other they took in battle.
- Ephesians 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;
- Luke 18 Summarized the parable of the persistant widow.
- Matthew 26:41 <u>Watch</u> and <u>pray</u>, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed *is* willing, but the flesh *is* weak.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

- Joshua 11:20 For it was of the <u>LORD to harden their hearts</u>, that they should come against Israel in battle, that he might <u>destroy them utterly</u>, and that they might have no favour, but that he might destroy them, as the LORD commanded Moses.
- Joshua 10:11 And it came to pass, as they fled from before Israel, and were in the going down to Bethhoron, that the LORD cast down great stones from heaven upon them unto Azekah, and they died: they were more which died with hailstones than they whom the children of Israel slew with the sword.
- Numbers 16 Summarized of Korah & the rebels & God's judgements.
- Deuteronomy 9:27 Remember thy servants, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; look not unto the <u>stubbornness</u> of this people, nor to their wickedness, nor to their sin: (Moses interceding for Israel)
- Summarized of Moses interceding 40 days for Israel after the golden calk incident.
- Deuteronomy 21:18,20 If a man have a <u>stubborn and rebellious son</u>, which will not obey the voice of his father, or the voice of his mother, and *that*, when they have chastened him, will not hearken unto them: 20 And they shall say unto the elders of his city, This our son *is* <u>stubborn and</u> <u>rebellious</u>, he will not obey our voice; *he is* a glutton, and a drunkard.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Luke 15:21 And the son said unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and in thy sight, and am no more worthy to be called thy son.
- Psalm 51:4 Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done *this* evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, *and* be clear when thou judgest.
- Judges 2:19 And it came to pass, when the judge was dead, *that* they returned, and corrupted *themselves* more than their fathers, in following other gods to serve them, and to bow down unto them; they <u>ceased not from their own doings</u>, nor from their stubborn way.
- **Exodus 20:3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me.**
- 1 Samuel 15:23 For <u>rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness</u>
  <u>is as iniquity and idolatry</u>. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, He hath also rejected thee from *being* king.
- Psalms 78:8 And might not be as their fathers, a <u>stubborn</u> and rebellious generation; a generation *that* set not their heart aright, and whose spirit was not stedfast with God.
- Proverbs 7:11 (She *is* loud and <u>stubborn</u>; her feet abide not in her house: Joshua 11:21 And at that time came Joshua, and cut off the Anakims (giants) from the mountains, from Hebron, from Debir, from Anab, and from all the mountains of Judah, and from all the mountains of Israel:

- Joshua destroyed them utterly with their cities.
- Jeremiah 17:5 Thus saith the LORD; Cursed *be* the man that trusteth in man, and maketh <u>flesh</u> his <u>arm</u>, and whose heart departeth from the LORD.
- 1 Samuel 17:45 Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied.
- Joshua 11:22,23 There was none of the Anakims left in the land of the children of Israel: only in Gaza, in Gath, and in Ashdod, there remained. (The Philistine cities) 23 So Joshua took the whole land, according to all that the LORD said unto Moses; and Joshua gave it for an inheritance unto Israel according to their divisions by their tribes. And the land rested from war.
- Joshua 14:11 As yet I *am as* strong this day as *I was* in the day that Moses sent me: as my strength *was* then, even so *is* my <u>strength</u> now, for war, both to go out, and to come in.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye <u>do</u>, <u>do</u> *it* heartily, as to the <u>Lord</u>, and not <u>unto</u> men;
- Matthew 13:53 And it came to pass, *that* when Jesus had <u>finished</u> these parables, he departed thence.
- Matthew 19:1 And it came to pass, *that* when Jesus had <u>finished</u> these sayings, he departed from Galilee, and came into the coasts of Judaea beyond Jordan;
- Matthew 26:1 And it came to pass, when Jesus had <u>finished</u> all these sayings, he said unto his disciples,
- Luke 14:28-30 For which of you, intending to build a tower, sitteth not down first, and counteth the cost, whether he have *sufficient* to <u>finish</u> *it*? 29 Lest haply, after he hath laid the foundation, and is not able to <u>finish</u> *it*, all that behold *it* begin to mock him, 30 Saying, This man began to build, and was not able to finish.
- John 4:34 Jesus saith unto them, <u>My meat is to do the will of him that sent</u> me, and to finish his work.
- John 5:36 But I have greater witness than *that* of John: for the works which the <u>Father hath given me to finish</u>, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me.
- John 17:4 I have glorified Thee on the earth: <u>I have finished the work which</u> <u>Thou gavest me to do</u>.
- John 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, <u>It is finished</u>: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.
- Jesus shed His blood to pay for our sins. He finished the work God had for Him to do.

- Acts 20:24 But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God.
- Acts 21:7 And when we had finished *our* course from Tyre, we came to Ptolemais, and saluted the brethren, and abode with them one day.
- Romans 9:28 For he will <u>finish</u> the work, and cut *it* short in righteousness: because a short work will the Lord make upon the earth.
- 2 Corinthians 8:6 Insomuch that we desired Titus, that as he had begun, so he would also finish in you the same grace also.
- 2 Timothy 4:7 <u>I have fought a good fight, I have finished *my* course, I have kept the faith:</u>
- Hebrews 4:3 For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.
- Hebrews 12:2 <u>Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of *our* faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.</u>
- Revelation 1:8 I am <u>Alpha</u> and <u>Omega</u>, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.
- Romans 8:34 Who *is* he that condemneth? *It is* Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.
- Matthew 14:30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.
- Exodus 23:30 <u>By little</u> and <u>little</u> I will drive them out from before thee, until thou be increased, and inherit the land.

More service Notes.

- James 1:15 Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is <u>finished</u>, bringeth forth death.
- Revelation 10:7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be <u>finished</u>, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.
- Revelation 11:7 And when they shall have <u>finished</u> their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.
- Revelation 20:5 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were <u>finished</u>. This *is* the first resurrection.
