Remembering Godly Blessings - Joshua 12

Summarized Joshua 10&11 - Joshua cleaning out the ungodly.

Its a good idea to thank the Lord often for the blessings God has given us.

Joshua 12:1-6 Now these are the kings of the land, which the children of Israel smote, and possessed their land on the other side Jordan toward

Israel smote, and possessed their land on the other side Jordan toward the rising of the sun, from the river Arnon unto mount Hermon, and all the plain on the east: 2 Sihon king of the Amorites, who dwelt in Heshbon, and ruled from Aroer, which is upon the bank of the river Arnon, and from the middle of the river, and from half Gilead, even unto the river Jabbok, which is the border of the children of Ammon; 3 And from the plain to the sea of Chinneroth on the east, and unto the sea of the plain, even the salt sea on the east, the way to Bethjeshimoth; and from the south, under Ashdothpisgah: 4 And the coast of Og king of Bashan, which was of the remnant of the giants, that dwelt at Ashtaroth and at Edrei, 5 And reigned in mount Hermon, and in Salcah, and in all Bashan, unto the border of the Geshurites and the Maachathites, and half Gilead, the border of Sihon king of Heshbon. 6 Them did Moses the servant of the LORD and the children of Israel smite: and Moses the servant of the LORD gave it for a possession unto the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh.

Recounting the taking of the land East of the Jordan River.

V5 The Maachathites were not all conquered.

Matthew 4 Summarized the parable of a demon returning with 7 more if person not saved.

Joshua 12:7--24 And these are the kings of the country which Joshua and the children of Israel smote on this side Jordan on the west, from Baalgad in the valley of Lebanon even unto the mount Halak, that goeth up to Seir; which Joshua gave unto the tribes of Israel for a possession according to their divisions; 8 In the mountains, and in the valleys, and in the plains, and in the springs, and in the wilderness, and in the south country; the Hittites, the Amorites, and the Canaanites, the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites: 9 The king of Jericho, one; the king of Ai, which is beside Bethel, one; 10 The king of Jerusalem, one; the king of Hebron, one; 11 The king of Jarmuth, one; the king of Lachish, one; 12 The king of Eglon, one; the king of Gezer, one; 13 The king of Debir, one; the king of Geder, one; 14 The king of Hormah, one; the king of Arad, one; 15 The king of Libnah, one; the king of Adullam, one; 16 The king of

Makkedah, one; the king of Bethel, one; 17 The king of Tappuah, one; the king of Hepher, one; 18 The king of Aphek, one; the king of Lasharon, one; 19 The king of Madon, one; the king of Hazor, one; 20 The king of Shimronmeron, one; the king of Achshaph, one; 21 The king of Taanach, one; the king of Megiddo, one; 22 The king of Kedesh, one; the king of Jokneam of Carmel, one; 23 The king of Dor in the coast of Dor, one; the king of the nations of Gilgal, one; 24 The king of Tirzah, one: all the kings thirty and one.

Joshua 4 Summarized thecrossing over Jordan on dry ground.

Joshua 5 God put the fear of the Lord on the enemy when the Israelite men were circumcised at Gilgal.

God blessed & provided for them in the wilderness 40 years.

Summarized the rebellion of the Israelrites in the wilderness & God's judgements.

John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

Matthew 3:2 And (John the Baptist) saying, <u>Repent</u> ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, <u>Repent</u>: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

Acts 2:1-4 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. 2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. 3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

John 11 Summarized the raising from the dead of Lazarus.

John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send Him unto you.

Luke 10:17-19 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils (demons) are subject unto us through Thy name. 18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. 19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Luke 10:19 (NKJV) <u>Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy</u>, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

- 1 John 4:3 And every <u>spirit</u> that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that <u>spirit</u> of <u>antichrist</u>, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Matthew 12:45 Then goeth he, and taketh with himself <u>seven</u> other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter in and dwell there: and the last *state* of that man is <u>worse</u> than the first. Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation. (For unbelievers who do not have God's Holy Spirit.)
- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

 Acts 8 Summarized of Simon Magus.

Fighting satan is every Christian's job to bind & loose every day.

Mark 16:15-17 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Acts 28 Summarized of Paul bit by serpent on Malta.

- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.
- Revelation 22:20 He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.
- 1 Corinthians 6:9-11 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, 10 Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. 11 And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

- Job 38:4 Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding. (universe)
- 1 Corinthians 6:11 And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

- Acts 9 Summarized of when Saul saw Jesus on the road to Damascus.
- Revelation is a book of visions from heaven that John saw & wrote.
- Revelation 6:16 And said to the mountains and <u>rocks</u>, <u>Fall</u> on <u>us</u>, and hide <u>us</u> from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:
- Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
- Romans 10:17 So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
