<u> Hindrances In Enjoying Divine Blessings - Joshua 18B</u>

- John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the <u>Comforter</u> will not come unto you; but if I depart, <u>I will send him unto you</u>.
- Joshua 18:2 And there remained among the children of Israel seven tribes, which had not yet received their inheritance. 3 And Joshua said unto the children of Israel, How long are ye slack to go to possess the land, which the LORD God of your fathers hath given you? 4 Give out from among you three men for each tribe: and I will send them, and they shall rise, and go through the land, and describe it according to the inheritance of them; and they shall come again to me. 5 And they shall divide it into seven parts: Judah shall abide in their coast on the south, and the house of Joseph shall abide in their coasts on the north. 6 Ye shall therefore describe the land into seven parts, and bring the description hither to me, that I may cast lots for you here before the LORD our God. 7 But the Levites have no part among you; for the priesthood of the LORD is their inheritance: and Gad, and Reuben, and half the tribe of Manasseh, have received their inheritance beyond Jordan on the east, which Moses the servant of the LORD gave them. 8 And the men arose, and went away: and Joshua charged them that went to describe the land, saying, Go and walk through the land, and describe it, and come again to me, that I may here cast lots for you before the LORD in Shiloh. 9 And the men went and passed through the land, and described it by cities into seven parts in a book, and came again to Joshua to the host at Shiloh. 10 And Joshua cast lots for them in Shiloh. before the LORD: and there Joshua divided the land unto the children of Israel according to their divisions.
- Joshua 17:12 Yet the children of Manasseh could not drive out *the inhabitants of* those cities; but the Canaanites would dwell in that land.
- Numbers 33:55 But if ye will not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you; then it shall come to pass, that those which ye let remain of them shall be pricks in your eyes, and thorns in your sides, and shall vex you in the land wherein ye dwell.
- Joshua 3:15 And as they that bare the ark were come unto Jordan, and the feet of the priests that bare the ark were dipped in the brim of the water,

- (for Jordan overfloweth all his banks all the time of harvest,)
- 2 Thessalonians 3:10 For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would <u>not work</u>, neither should he <u>eat</u>.
- Joshua 18:2,3 But there remained among the children of Israel seven tribes which had not yet received their inheritance. 3 And Joshua said unto the children of Israel, How long *are* ye slack to (neglect to) go to possess the land, which the LORD God of your fathers hath given you?
- Genesis 42 to 47 Summarized how the Egyptians sold all & themselves for food in the famine.
- Joshua 18:4-6 Give out from among you three men for *each* tribe: and I will send them, and they shall rise, and go through the land, and describe it according to the inheritance of them; and they shall come *again* to me. 5 And they shall divide it into seven parts: Judah shall abide in their coast on the south, and the house of Joseph shall abide in their coasts on the north. 6 Ye shall therefore describe the land *into* seven parts, and bring *the description* hither to me, that I may cast lots for you here before the LORD our God.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:22 Abstain from all appearance of evil.
- Joshua 18:7 But the Levites have no part among you; for the priesthood of the LORD is their inheritance: and Gad, and Reuben, and half the tribe of Manasseh, have received their inheritance beyond Jordan on the east, which Moses the servant of the LORD gave them. 8 And the men arose, and went away: and Joshua charged them that went to describe the land, saying, Go and walk through the land, and describe it, and come again to me, that I may here cast lots for you before the LORD in Shiloh. 9 And the men went and passed through the land, and described it by cities into seven parts in a book, and came again to Joshua to the host at Shiloh. 10 And Joshua cast lots for them in Shiloh before the LORD: and there Joshua divided the land unto the children of Israel according to their divisions.
- Numbers 34:14,15 For the tribe of the children of Reuben according to the house of their fathers, and the tribe of the children of Gad according to the house of their fathers, have <u>received</u> their <u>inheritance</u>; and half the tribe of Manasseh have <u>received</u> their <u>inheritance</u>: 15 The two tribes and the half tribe have <u>received</u> their <u>inheritance</u> on this side Jordan *near* Jericho eastward, toward the sunrising.
- 36:3,4,6 And if they be married to any of the sons of the *other* tribes of the children of Israel, then shall their <u>inheritance</u> be taken from the

inheritance of our fathers, and shall be put to the inheritance of the tribe whereunto they are received: so shall it be taken from the lot of our inheritance. 4 And when the jubile of the children of Israel shall be, then shall their inheritance be put unto the inheritance of the tribe whereunto they are received: so shall their inheritance be taken away from the inheritance of the tribe of our fathers. 6 This is the thing which the LORD doth command concerning the daughters of Zelophehad, saying, Let them marry to whom they think best; only to the family of the tribe of their father shall they marry.

- Joshua 13:8 With whom the Reubenites and the Gadites have <u>received</u> their <u>inheritance</u>, which Moses gave them, beyond Jordan eastward, *even* as Moses the servant of the LORD gave them;
- Joshua 18:2,7 And there remained among the children of Israel seven tribes, which had not yet <u>received</u> their <u>inheritance</u>. 7 But the Levites have no part among you; for the priesthood of the LORD *is* their <u>inheritance</u>: and Gad, and Reuben, and half the tribe of Manasseh, have <u>received</u> their <u>inheritance</u> beyond Jordan on the east, which Moses the servant of the LORD gave them.
- Matthew 19:29 And every one that hath <u>forsaken</u> houses, or brethren, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands, <u>for my name's sake</u>, <u>shall receive an hundredfold</u>, <u>and shall inherit everlasting life</u>.
- Acts 26:18 To open their eyes, *and* to turn *them* from darkness to light, and *from* the power of Satan unto God, that they may <u>receive forgiveness of sins</u>, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in Me.
- 1 Corinthians 2:4 And my speech and my preaching *was* not <u>with</u> enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the <u>Spirit</u> and of <u>power</u>: Acts 16 Summarized of the girl with diivination spirit.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 16:14 Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.
- Colossians 3:24 Knowing that of the Lord ye shall <u>receive</u> the reward of the <u>inheritance</u>: for ye serve the Lord Christ.
- Hebrews 9:15 And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament (covenant), that by means of death, for the redemption of the

- transgressions *that were* under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are <u>sealed</u> unto the <u>day</u> of <u>redemption</u>.
- Hebrews 11:8 By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after <u>receive</u> for an <u>inheritance</u>, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went.
- 3 John 1:2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest <u>prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth</u>.
- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just healing.
- John 11 Summarized the raising of Lazarus.
- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- Isaiah 6 Godly fear of the Lord when isaiah saw the Throne of God in Heaven.
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Ephesians 6:10-18 V12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.
- Psalms 23:3A He restoreth my soul:
- Judges 16:16 And it came to pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, so that his soul was vexed unto death;
- Proverbs 12:24 The hand of the diligent shall bear rule: but the <u>slothful</u> shall be under tribute.
- John 8:32,36 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. 36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
- Proverbs 12:27 The <u>slothful</u> *man* roasteth not that which he took in hunting: but the substance of a diligent man *is* precious.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the <u>nurture</u> and <u>admonition</u> of the Lord.
- Proverbs 15:19 The way of the <u>slothful</u> *man is* as an hedge of thorns: but the way of the righteous *is* made plain.
- 18:9 He also that is <u>slothful</u> in his work is brother to him that is a <u>great</u> waster.

- 19:15 <u>Slothfulness</u> casteth into a <u>deep sleep;</u> and an <u>idle soul shall suffer</u> <u>hunger</u>.
- Ecclesiastes 3:1 To <u>every</u> thing there is a <u>season</u>, and a time to <u>every</u> purpose under the heaven:
- Proverbs 19:24 A <u>slothful</u> *man* hideth his hand in *his* bosom, and will not so much as bring it to his mouth again.
- 21:25 The desire of the slothful killeth him; for his hands refuse to labour.
- 22:13 The <u>slothful</u> *man* saith, *There is* a lion without, I shall be slain in the streets.
- 24:30 I went by the field of the <u>slothful</u>, and by the vineyard of the man void of understanding;
- 26:13-15 The <u>slothful</u> man saith, *There is* a lion in the way; a lion *is* in the streets. 14 *As* the door turneth upon his hinges, so *doth* the <u>slothful</u> upon his bed. 15 The <u>slothful</u> hideth his hand in *his* bosom; it grieveth him to bring it again to his mouth.
- Strongs #07423 r@miyah rem-ee-yaw' AV-deceitful 4, deceitfully 3, deceit 2, slothful 2, false 1, guile 1, idle 1, slack 1; 15 1) laxness, slackness, slackening, deceit, treachery
- Joshua 18:3 Then Joshua said to the children of Israel: "How long will you neglect to go and possess the land which the LORD God of your fathers has given you?
- Matthew 25 Summarized the Parable of the talents. V28 Take therefore the talent from him, and give *it* unto him which hath ten talents.
