How Thankful Are You - Psalms 66

- Romans 1:21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified *him* not as God, neither were <u>thankful</u>; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.
- Psalms 66:1-20 1 To the chief Musician, A Song or Psalm. Make a joyful noise (shout) unto God, all ye lands:
- Matthew 21 Summarized of the Triumphal entry of Jesus to Jerusalem.
- Psalms 66:2,3 Sing forth the honour of His name: make His praise glorious. 3 Say unto God, How terrible (awesome) art Thou in Thy works! through the greatness of Thy power shall Thine enemies submit themselves unto Thee.
- Philippians 2:10,11 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of *things* in heaven, and *things* in earth, and *things* under the earth; 11 And *that* every <u>tongue</u> should <u>confess</u> that <u>Jesus</u> Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
- Psalms 66:4,5 All the earth shall worship Thee, and shall sing unto Thee; they shall sing to Thy name. Selah. 5 Come and see the works of God: He is terrible (awesome) in His doing toward the children of men.
- Matthew 5:45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth <u>rain</u> on the <u>just</u> and on the unjust.
- Psalms 66:6 He turned the sea into dry land: they went through the flood on foot: there did we rejoice in Him.
- Summarized God making a dry path through the Red Sea for Moses & The Israelites to cross, & through the Jordan river for Joshua & the Israelites.
- Psalms 66:7 He ruleth by His power for ever; His eyes behold the nations: let not the rebellious exalt themselves. Selah.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Psalms 66:8 O bless our God, ye people, and make the voice of His praise to be heard:
- Mark 8:38 Whosoever therefore shall be <u>ashamed</u> of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the glory of his <u>Father</u> with the holy angels.
- Psalms 66:9 Which holdeth our soul in life, and suffereth not our feet to be moved.
- Ezekiel 13:17-23 Summarized V23 Therefore ye shall see no more vanity, nor divine divinations: for <u>I will deliver my people out of your hand</u>: and ye shall know that I *am* the LORD.
- Psalms 23:3 He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

- Isaiah 35:8 And an <u>highway</u> shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of <u>holiness</u>; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it *shall be* for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err *therein*.
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of <u>Balaam</u>, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- Psalms 66:10 For Thou, O God, hast proved (tested) us: Thou hast tried (refined) us, as silver is tried (refined).
- Acts 13:22 And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also He gave testimony, and said, I have found David the *son* of Jesse, a <u>man after Mine own heart</u>, which shall fulfil all My will.
- 1 Samuel 15 Summarized
- Psalms 66:11 Thou broughtest us into the net; Thou laidst affliction upon our loins.
- Psalms 78 Summarized God judging the Israelites in the wilderness.
- Leviticus 26 referred to God increasing punishment 7 times.
- Summarized the accounts in the Judges when Israelites rejected God & He punished them often.
- Psalms 66:12 Thou hast caused men to ride over our heads; we went through fire and through water: but Thou broughtest us out into a wealthy place.
- Isaiah 43:2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; And through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, Nor shall the flame scorch you.
- Daniel 3 Summarized the account of the 3 men going in the fiery furnace Psalms 66:13 I will go into Thy house with burnt offerings: I will pay thee my vows,
- Genesis 4 Summarized of the sacrifices of Cain & Able.
- Psalms 66:14 Which my lips have uttered, and my mouth hath spoken, when I was in trouble.
- Jonah Summarized.
- Luke 15:7 I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance.
- Psalms 66:15,16 I will offer unto thee burnt sacrifices of fatlings, with the incense of rams; I will offer bullocks with goats. Selah. 16 Come and hear, all ye that fear God, and I will declare what he hath done for my soul.
- Matthew 21:13 And said unto them, It is written, My <u>house</u> shall be called the <u>house</u> of <u>prayer</u>; but ye have made it a den of thieves.

- Psalms 66:17 I cried unto Him with my mouth, and He was extolled with my tongue.
- 1 Samuel 24 Summarized of David & Saul in the same cave.
- Psalms 66:18 If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me:
- 1 Samuel 28 Summarized of God not answer sinful Saul so Saul went to the witch at Endor.
- The accounts of the Kings & Chronicles, Man did right own sight but it was evil in the sight of the Lord.
- Psalms 66:19 But verily God hath heard me; he hath attended to the voice of my prayer.
- Psalm 51:1,4 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet came unto him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba. Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions. 4 Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done *this* evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, *and* be clear when thou judgest.
- Psalms 66:20 Blessed be God, which hath not turned away my prayer, nor his mercy from me.
- Ephesians 1:14 Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.
- Mark 5 Summarized of the Gadarene demoniac set free by Jesus. More Service Notes:
- 2 Samuel 22:50 Therefore I will give thanks to You, O LORD, among the Gentiles, And sing praises to Your name.
- 1 Chronicles 16:8 Oh, give thanks to the LORD! Call upon His name; Make known His deeds among the peoples!
- 1 Chronicles 16:34,35 Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for *He is* good! For His mercy *endures* forever.
- 1 Chronicles 16:35 And say, "Save us, O God of our salvation; Gather us together, and deliver us from the Gentiles, To give thanks to Your holy name, To triumph in Your praise."
- 1 Chronicles 16:41 and with them Heman and Jeduthun and the rest who were chosen, who were designated by name, to give thanks to the LORD, because His mercy *endures* forever;
- 1 Chronicles 25:3 Of Jeduthun, the sons of Jeduthun: Gedaliah, Zeri, Jeshaiah, *Shimei,* Hashabiah, and Mattithiah, six, under the direction of their father Jeduthun, who prophesied with a harp to give thanks and to praise the LORD.

- 2 Chronicles 31:2 And Hezekiah appointed the divisions of the priests and the Levites according to their divisions, each man according to his service, the priests and Levites for burnt offerings and peace offerings, to serve, to give thanks, and to praise in the gates of the camp of the LORD.
- Nehemiah 12:24 And the heads of the Levites *were* Hashabiah, Sherebiah, and Jeshua the son of Kadmiel, with their brothers across from them, to praise *and* give thanks, group alternating with group, according to the command of David the man of God.
- Psalms 18:49 Therefore I will give thanks to You, O LORD, among the Gentiles, And sing praises to Your name.
- Psalms 30:4 Sing praise to the LORD, You saints of His, And give thanks at the remembrance of His holy name.
- Psalms 30:12 To the end that *my* glory may sing praise to You and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks to You forever.
- Psalms 75:1 To the Chief Musician. Set to "Do Not Destroy." A Psalm of Asaph. A Song. We give thanks to You, O God, we give thanks! For Your wondrous works declare that Your name is near.
- Psalms 92:1 A Psalm. A Song for the Sabbath day. *It is* good to give thanks to the LORD, And to sing praises to Your name, O Most High;
- Psalms 97:12 Rejoice in the LORD, you righteous, And give thanks at the remembrance of His holy name.
- Psalms 105:1 Oh, give thanks to the LORD! Call upon His name; Make known His deeds among the peoples!
- Psalms 106:1 Praise the LORD! Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for *He is* good! For His mercy *endures* forever.
- Psalms 106:47 Save us, O LORD our God, And gather us from among the Gentiles, To give thanks to Your holy name, To triumph in Your praise.
- Psalms 107:1 Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for *He is* good! For His mercy endures forever.
- Psalms 107:8 Oh, that *men* would give thanks to the LORD for His goodness, And for His wonderful works to the children of men!
- Psalms 107:15 Oh, that *men* would <u>give</u> <u>thanks</u> to the LORD *for* His goodness, And *for* His wonderful works to the children of men!
- Psalms 107:21 Oh, that *men* would give thanks to the LORD for His goodness, And for His wonderful works to the children of men!
- Psalms 107:31 Oh, that *men* would give thanks to the LORD for His goodness, And for His wonderful works to the children of men!
- Psalms 118:1 Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for *He is* good! For His mercy endures forever.
- Psalms 118:29 Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for *He is* good! For His mercy endures forever.
- Psalms 119:62 At midnight I will rise to give thanks to You, Because of Your

- righteous judgments.
- Psalms 122:4 Where the tribes go up, The tribes of the LORD, To the Testimony of Israel, To give thanks to the name of the LORD.
- Psalms 136:1-3 Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for *He is* good! For His mercy endures forever. 2 Oh, give thanks to the God of gods! For His mercy endures forever. 3 Oh, give thanks to the Lord of lords! For His mercy endures forever:
- Psalms 136:26 Oh, give thanks to the God of heaven! For His mercy endures forever.
- Psalms 140:13 Surely the righteous shall give thanks to Your name; The upright shall dwell in Your presence.
- Mark 14:23 Then He took the cup, and when He had given thanks He gave it to them, and they all drank from it.
- John 6:11 And Jesus took the loaves, and when He had given thanks He distributed *them* to the disciples, and the disciples to those sitting down; and likewise of the fish, as much as they wanted.
- John 6:23 however, other boats came from Tiberias, near the place where they ate bread after the Lord had given thanks-
- Romans 16:4 who risked their own necks for my life, to whom not only I give thanks, but also all the churches of the Gentiles.
- 1 Corinthians 10:30 But if I partake with thanks, why am I evil spoken of for *the food* over which I give thanks?
- 1 Corinthians 11:24 and when He had given thanks, He broke *it* and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me."
- 1 Corinthians 14:17 For you indeed give thanks well, but the other is not edified.
- Ephesians 1:16 do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers:
- Colossians 1:3 We give thanks to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you,
- 1 Thessalonians 1:2 We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers,
- 2 Thessalonians 2:13 But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth,
