Samson - A Godly Beginning - Judges 13

- Mark 4:19 And the <u>cares</u> of this <u>world</u>, and the deceitfulness of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.
- 1 John 2:16 16 For all that *is* in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.
- Strongs #08123 Shimshown *shim-shone'* AV-Samson 38; Samson =" like the sun" 1) a Danite, son of Manoah, a Nazarite for life, and a judge of Israel for 20 years.
- Judges 13:1-25 1 And the children of Israel did evil again in the sight of the LORD; and the LORD delivered them into the hand of the Philistines forty years.
- Summarized of in the Judges when Israelites rejected God & He punished them often.
- Deuteronomy 13:2 And the sign or the wonder come to pass, whereof he spake unto thee, saying, Let us go after other gods, which thou hast not known, and let us serve them;
- Psalm 66:10 For You, O God, have tested us; You have refined us as silver is refined.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening woolves.
- 1 Samuel 12:12 And when ye saw that Nahash the king of the children of Ammon came against you, ye said unto me, Nay; but a king shall reign over us: when the LORD your God *was* your king.
- Summarized of many special people chosen by God Moses, David, Jeremiah, Samuel, Samson, John the Baptist, etc.
- Judges 13:2,3 And there was a certain man of Zorah, of the family of the Danites, whose name was Manoah; and his wife was barren, and bare not. 3 And the Angel of the LORD appeared unto the woman, and said unto her, Behold now, thou art barren, and bearest not: but thou shalt conceive, and bear a son.
- Genesis 17 Summarized of the Angel of the Lord visiting Abraham.
- Judges 13:4 Now therefore beware, I pray thee, and drink not wine nor strong drink, and eat not any unclean thing:
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the

- Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- Judges 13:5 For, lo, thou shalt conceive, and bear a son; and no razor shall come on his head: for the child shall be a <u>Nazarite unto God from the womb</u>: and he shall begin to deliver Israel out of the hand of the Philistines.
- John the Baptist was the forerunner of our Lord Jesus.
- Samuel was the last Judge going into the kings.
- Judges 13:6 Then the woman came and told her husband, saying, A man of God came unto me, and his countenance was like the countenance of an Angel of God, very terrible (aweful): but I asked him not whence he was, neither told he me his name:
- Hebrews 13:2 Be not forgetful to <u>entertain</u> strangers: for thereby some have entertained <u>angels</u> unawares.
- Judges 13:7 But he said unto me, Behold, thou shalt conceive, and bear a son; and now drink no wine nor strong drink, neither eat any unclean thing: for the child shall be a Nazarite to God from the womb to the day of his death.
- Matthew 15:20 These are *the things* which <u>defile</u> a <u>man</u>: but to eat with unwashen hands defileth not a man.
- Acts 10 Summarized of Peter's vision. V15 And the voice *spake* unto him again the second time, What God hath cleansed, *that* call not thou common.
- Judges 13:8 Then Manoah intreated the LORD, and said, O my Lord, let the man of God which thou didst send come again unto us, and teach us what we shall do unto the child that shall be born.
- Judges 6 Summarized of Gideon testing if it was God.
- Hebrews 10:20 By a <u>new</u> and <u>living way</u>, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;
- Isaiah 55:9 For *as* the heavens are <u>higher</u> than the earth, so are my <u>ways</u> <u>higher</u> than your <u>ways</u>, and my <u>thoughts</u> than your <u>thoughts</u>.
- Judges 13:9 And God hearkened to the voice of Manoah; and the angel of God came again unto the woman as she sat in the field: but Manoah her husband was not with her.
- Deborah was stronger with God than Barak, so she encouraged him to Do God's will.
- Judges 13:10 And the woman made haste, and ran, and shewed her husband, and said unto him, Behold, the man hath appeared unto me,

- that came unto me the other day. 11 And Manoah arose, and went after his wife, and came to the man, and said unto Him, Art thou the man that spakest unto the woman? And He said, "I am".
- 1 Peter 3:4 But *let it be* the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, *even the ornament* of a <u>meek</u> and <u>quiet</u> spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.
- Mark 14:62 And Jesus said, <u>I</u> <u>am</u>: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Esther 4:14 For if thou altogether holdest thy peace at this time, *then* shall there enlargement and <u>deliverance</u> arise to the Jews from another place; but thou and thy father's house shall be destroyed: and who knoweth whether thou art <u>come</u> to the kingdom for *such* a time as this?
- Judges 13:12,13 And Manoah said, Now let thy words come to pass. How shall we order the child, and how shall we do unto him? 13 And the angel of the LORD said unto Manoah, Of all that I said unto the woman let her beware. 14 She may not eat of any thing that cometh of the vine, neither let her drink wine or strong drink, nor eat any unclean thing: all that I commanded her let her observe.
- John 8:11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, <u>Neither</u> do I <u>condemn</u> thee: go, and sin no more.
- John 5:14 Afterward Jesus findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, thou art made whole: <u>sin no more</u>, lest a worse thing come unto thee.
- John 9:1,2 And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind? 3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.
- Judges 13:15 And Manoah said unto the Angel of the LORD, I pray thee, let us detain thee, until we shall have made ready a kid for thee.
- 1 Kings 13 Summarized of the prophet to Jeroboam & the false prophet deceiving him.
- Judges 13:16 And the Angel of the LORD said unto Manoah, Though thou detain me, I will not eat of thy bread: and if thou wilt offer a burnt offering, thou must offer it unto the LORD. For Manoah knew not that He was an Angel of the LORD.
- Colossians 2:18 Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary humility and worshipping of angels, intruding into those things which he

- hath not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind, Summarized of the angels appearing to Joseph & Mary.
- Deuteronomy 18:10,11 There shall not be found among you *any one* that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, *or* that useth divination, *or* an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a <u>consulter</u> with <u>familiar</u> spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer.
- Isaiah 8:19 And when they shall say unto you, Seek unto them that have familiar spirits, and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter: should not a people seek unto their God? for the living to the dead?
- Judges 13:17 And Manoah said unto the angel of the LORD, What is thy name, that when thy sayings come to pass we may do thee honour? Deuteronomy 18:9-14 referred to.
- Judges 13:18 And the angel of the LORD said unto him, Why askest thou thus after My name, seeing it is secret (Wonderful)?
- Strongs #06383 pil'iy *pil-ee'* or paliy' *paw-lee'* from <u>06381</u>; adj; AV-secret 1, wonderful 1, variant 2; 4 1) wonderful, incomprehensible, extraordinary
- Judges 13:19 So Manoah took a kid with a meat offering, and offered it upon a rock unto the LORD: and the angel did wondrously; and Manoah and his wife looked on.
- Judges 13:20 For it came to pass, when the flame went up toward heaven from off the altar, that the Angel of the LORD ascended in the flame of the altar. And Manoah and his wife looked on it, and fell on their faces to the ground.
- 2 Kings 2 Summarized of Elijah going up in the chariot of fire.
- Judges 13:21,22 But the Angel of the LORD did no more appear to Manoah and to his wife. Then Manoah knew that he was an angel of the LORD. 22 And Manoah said unto his wife, We shall surely die, because we have seen God.
- Acts 17:22 Then Paul stood in the midst of Mars' hill, and said, *Ye* men of Athens, I perceive that in all things ye are too <u>superstitious</u>.
- Judges 13:23 But his wife said unto him, If the LORD were pleased to kill us, he would not have received a burnt offering and a meat offering at our hands, neither would he have shewed us all these things, nor would as at this time have told us such things as these. 24 And the woman bare a son(a miracle), and called his name Samson: and the child grew, and the LORD blessed him.
- Luke 1 Summarized of naming John the baptist

- Luke 2:40 And the <u>child</u> (Jesus) <u>grew</u>, and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom: and the grace of God was upon him.
- Judges 13:25 And the Spirit of the LORD began to move him at times in the camp of Dan between Zorah and Eshtaol.
- Exodus 2:12 And he looked this way and that way, and when he saw that *there was* no man, he <u>slew</u> the <u>Egyptian</u>, and hid him in the sand.
- Isaiah 55:8 For <u>my</u> thoughts *are* <u>not</u> your thoughts, neither *are* your <u>ways</u> my ways, saith the LORD.

Isaiah 58 - God's chosen fast referred to.

More service Notes:

Numbers 6:1-27 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When either man or woman shall separate themselves to vow a vow of a Nazarite, to separate themselves unto the LORD: 3 He shall separate himself from wine and strong drink, and shall drink no vinegar of wine, or vinegar of strong drink, neither shall he drink any liquor of grapes, nor eat moist grapes, or dried. 4 All the days of his separation shall he eat nothing that is made of the vine tree, from the kernels even to the husk. 5 All the days of the vow of his separation there shall no razor come upon his head: until the days be fulfilled, in the which he separateth himself unto the LORD, he shall be holy, and shall let the locks of the hair of his head grow. 6 All the days that he separateth himself unto the LORD he shall come at no dead body. 7 He shall not make himself unclean for his father, or for his mother, for his brother, or for his sister, when they die: because the consecration of his God is upon his head. 8 All the days of his separation he is holy unto the LORD. 9 And if any man die very suddenly by him, and he hath defiled the head of his consecration; then he shall shave his head in the day of his cleansing, on the seventh day shall he shave it. 10 And on the eighth day he shall bring two turtles, or two young pigeons, to the priest, to the door of the tabernacle of the congregation: 11 And the priest shall offer the one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering, and make an atonement for him, for that he sinned by the dead, and shall hallow his head that same day. 12 And he shall consecrate unto the LORD the days of his separation, and shall bring a lamb of the first year for a trespass offering: but the days that were before shall be lost, because his separation was defiled. 13 And this is the law of the Nazarite, when the days of his separation are fulfilled: he shall be brought unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation: 14 And he

shall offer his offering unto the LORD, one he lamb of the first year without blemish for a burnt offering, and one ewe lamb of the first year without blemish for a sin offering, and one ram without blemish for peace offerings, 15 And a basket of unleavened bread, cakes of fine flour mingled with oil, and wafers of unleavened bread anointed with oil, and their meat offering, and their drink offerings. 16 And the priest shall bring them before the LORD, and shall offer his sin offering, and his burnt offering: 17 And he shall offer the ram for a sacrifice of peace offerings unto the LORD, with the basket of unleavened bread: the priest shall offer also his meat offering, and his drink offering. 18 And the Nazarite shall shave the head of his separation at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and shall take the hair of the head of his separation, and put it in the fire which is under the sacrifice of the peace offerings. 19 And the priest shall take the sodden shoulder of the ram, and one unleavened cake out of the basket, and one unleavened wafer, and shall put them upon the hands of the Nazarite, after the hair of his separation is shaven: 20 And the priest shall wave them for a wave offering before the LORD: this is holy for the priest, with the wave breast and heave shoulder: and after that the Nazarite may drink wine. 21 This is the law of the Nazarite who hath vowed, and of his offering unto the LORD for his separation, beside that that his hand shall get: according to the vow which he vowed, so he must do after the law of his separation. 22 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, 23 Speak unto Aaron and unto his sons, saying, On this wise ye shall bless the children of Israel, saying unto them, 24 The LORD bless thee, and keep thee: 25 The LORD make his face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee: 26 The LORD lift up his countenance upon thee, and give thee peace. 27 And they shall put my name upon the children of Israel; and I will bless them.
