Samson - An Occasion Against Godly Enemies - Judges 14

- Summarized of the many different ways God deals with His enemies through His Leaders.
- Summarized of our Lord Jesus coming down to tell of Samson's birth.
- There were 3 main Godly Leaders that were Nazerites from birth Samson, Samuel, & John the Baptist.
- Judges 13:25-14:20 25 And the Spirit of the LORD began to move him at times in the camp of Dan between Zorah and Eshtaol.
- Summarized of Danites getting more land then getting away from God to idolatry.
- 1 Samuel 16:14 But the <u>Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul</u>, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him.
- 2 Corinthians 1:22 Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.
- Judges 14:1 And Samson went down to Timnath, and saw a woman in Timnath of the daughters of the Philistines.
- Summarized of the Judges. When Israel was obedient, God blessed them. When they went after other gods, God punished them into slavery. When they turned back to God, God sent a judge to free them.
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of <u>Balaam</u>, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- Judges 14:2 And he came up, and told his father and his mother, and said, I have seen a woman in Timnath of the daughters of the Philistines: now therefore get her for me to wife.
- 2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye not <u>unequally yoked</u> together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?
- Judges 14:3 Then his father and his mother said unto him, Is

there never a woman among the daughters of thy brethren, or among all my people, that thou goest to take a wife of the <u>uncircumcised Philistines</u>? And Samson said unto his father, Get her for me; for she pleaseth me well.

- Genesis 34 Summarized of Simeon, Levi & Dinah.
- Judges 14:4 But his father and his mother <u>knew not that it was of</u> the <u>LORD</u>, that he sought an occasion against the Philistines: for at that time the Philistines had dominion over Israel.
- Judges 7 Summarized of Gideon's army.
- Judges 4 Summarized of Barak & Deborah.
- Judges 14:5 Then went Samson down, and his father and his mother, to Timnath, and came to the vineyards of Timnath: and, behold, a young lion roared against him.
- Psalms 80:8 Thou hast brought a vine out of Egypt: thou hast cast out the heathen, and planted it.
- John 15:5 I <u>am</u> the <u>vine</u>, ye *are* the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.
- 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a <u>roaring lion</u>, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:
- James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- Judges 14:6 And the Spirit of the LORD came mightily upon him, and he rent him as he would have rent a kid, and he had nothing in his hand: but he told not his father or his mother what he had done.
- 1 Kings 18:46 And the hand of the LORD was on Elijah; and he girded up his loins, and ran before Ahab to the entrance of Jezreel.
- Luke 4 Referred to Jesus reading Isaiah 61.
- Isaiah 11:2 And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;
- Acts 13:22 And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them <u>David</u> to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found <u>David</u> the *son* of Jesse, a <u>man</u> after mine own <u>heart</u>, which shall fulfil all my will.

- Judges 14:7 And he went down, and talked with the woman; and she pleased Samson well.
- Compared the Philistine religion versus the Israelites worship of God.
- Judges 14:8-14 And after a time (about a year) he returned to take her, and he turned aside to see the carcase of the lion: and, behold, there was a swarm of bees and honey in the carcase of the lion. 9 And he took thereof in his hands, and went on eating, and came to his father and mother, and he gave them, and they did eat: but he told not them that he had taken the honey out of the carcase of the lion. 10 So his father went down unto the woman: and Samson made there a feast; for so used the young men to do. 11 And it came to pass, when they saw him, that they brought thirty companions to be with him. 12 And Samson said unto them, I will now put forth a riddle unto you: if ye can certainly declare it me within the seven days of the feast, and find it out, then I will give you thirty sheets and thirty change of garments: 13 But if ye cannot declare it me, then shall ve give me thirty sheets and thirty change of garments. And they said unto him, Put forth thy riddle, that we may hear it. 14 And he said unto them, Out of the eater came forth meat, and out of the strong came forth sweetness. And they could not in three days expound the riddle.
- Daniel 1:17 As for these four children, God gave them knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom: and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams.
- Judges 14:15 And it came to pass on the seventh day (Sabbath), that they said unto Samson's wife, Entice (deceive) thy husband, that he may declare unto us the riddle, (threat) lest we burn thee and thy father's house with fire: have ye called us to take that we have? is it not so?
- 1 Samuel 5:3 And when they of Ashdod arose early on the morrow, behold, <u>Dagon was fallen upon his face to the earth before the ark of the LORD</u>. And they took Dagon, and set him in his place again.
- Judges 14:16 And Samson's wife wept before him (female wiles), and said, Thou dost but hate me, and lovest me not: (a control

- tactic) thou hast put forth a riddle unto the children of my people, and hast not told it me. And he said unto her, Behold, I have not told it my father nor my mother, and shall I tell it thee?
- Genesis 2:24 & Matthew 19:5 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.
- Judges 14:17,18 And she wept before him the seven days, while their feast lasted: and it came to pass on the seventh day, that he told her, because she lay sore upon him: and she told the riddle to the children of her people. 18 And the men of the city said unto him on the seventh day before the sun went down, What is sweeter than honey? and what is stronger than a lion? And he said unto them, If ye had not plowed with my heifer, ye had not found out my riddle.
- 1 Timothy 5:13 And withal they (younger widows) learn *to be* idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and <u>busybodies</u>, speaking things which they ought not.
- Judges 14:19,20 And the Spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he went down to Ashkelon, and slew thirty men of them, and took their spoil, and gave change of garments unto them which expounded the riddle. And his anger was kindled (against his wife), and he went up to his father's house. 20 But Samson's wife was given to his companion, whom he had used as his friend.
