## **Re-Visiting The Mighty Works of God - Joshua 24A**

- Summarized of the previous chapter of Joshua's final instructions similar to what Moses & Paul did.
- Ephesians 6:13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
- Joshua 24:1-14 V1 And Joshua gathered all the tribes of Israel to Shechem, & called for the elders of Israel, & for their heads, & for their judges, & for their officers; & they presented themselves before God.
- Deuteronomy 27 & 28 Blessings & Curses. Shechem was he valley between the 2 mountains Ebal & Gerizim.
- Joshua 24:2 And Joshua said unto all the people, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Your fathers dwelt on the other side of the flood in old time, even Terah, the father of Abraham, and the father of Nachor: and they served other gods.
- 1 John 2:23 Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.
- Joshua 24:3 And I took your father Abraham from the other side of the flood, and led him throughout all the land of Canaan, and multiplied his seed, and gave him Isaac.
- Summarized of Abraham's travels & of his family.
- Joshua 24:4 And I gave unto Isaac Jacob and Esau: and I gave unto Esau mount Seir, to possess it; but Jacob and his children went down into Egypt. (Summarized of Isaac's family.)
- Joshua 24:5 I sent Moses also and Aaron, and I plagued Egypt, according to that which I did among them: and afterward I brought you out.
- Acts 7:35 This Moses whom they refused, saying, Who made thee a ruler and a judge? the same did God send *to be* a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the angel which appeared to him in the bush.
- Exodus 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.
- Joshua 24:6 And I brought your fathers out of Egypt: and ye came unto the sea; and the Egyptians pursued after your fathers with chariots and horsemen unto the Red sea. (Summarized)
- Exodus 14:13 And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, <u>stand still</u>, <u>and</u> <u>see the salvation of the LORD</u>, which he will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever.
- Psalms 68:1 Let God arise, let his enemies be scattered: let them also that

hate him flee before him.

Joshua 24:7 And when they cried unto the LORD, he put darkness between you and the Egyptians, and brought the sea upon them, and covered them; and your eyes have seen what I have done in Egypt: and ye dwelt in the wilderness a long season.

John 11 Summarized of Lazarus raised.

John 12:10 But the chief priests consulted that they might put <u>Lazarus</u> also to death;

2 Kings 6 Summarized Elisha & the enemy army temporarily blinded.

Joshua 24:8 And I brought you into the land of the Amorites, which dwelt on the other side Jordan; and they fought with you: and I gave them into your hand, that ye might possess their land; and I destroyed them from before you.

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

Joshua 24:9 Then Balak the son of Zippor, king of Moab, arose and warred against Israel, and sent and called Balaam the son of Beor to curse you: Acts 8 Summarized of Simon Magus.

Joshua 24:10 <u>But I would not hearken unto Balaam</u>; therefore he blessed you still: so <u>I delivered you</u> out of his hand.

Numbers 22-24 Summarized of Balaam.

Numbers 22:12 And God said unto Balaam, Thou shalt not go with them; thou shalt not curse the people: for they are blessed.

Revelation 3:7 And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, & no man shutteth; & shutteth, & no man openeth;

Joshua 24:11 And ye went over Jordan, and came unto Jericho: and the men of Jericho fought against you, the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Girgashites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites; and I delivered them into your hand. (Summarized)

Joshua 2:9 And she said unto the men, I know that the LORD hath given you the land, and that your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you.

Exodus 22:18 Thou shalt not suffer a witch to live.

John 8:11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, <u>Neither</u> do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.

John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

Joshua 24:12 And I sent the hornet before you, which drave them out from before you, even the two kings of the Amorites; but not with thy sword, nor with thy bow.

1 Samuel 5 Summarized of God's plagues on the Philistines.

- Joshua 24:13 And I have given you a land for which ye did not labour, and cities which ye built not, and ye dwell in them; of the vineyards and oliveyards which ye planted not do ye eat.
- Joshua 3:15 And as they that bare the ark were come unto Jordan, and the feet of the priests that bare the ark were dipped in the brim of the water, (for Jordan overfloweth all his banks all the <u>time of harvest</u>,)
- Joshua 24:14 Now therefore <u>fear the LORD</u>, and <u>serve Him in sincerity and</u> <u>in truth</u>: and <u>put away the gods</u> which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve ye the LORD.
- Acts 9:31 Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.
- Acts 7:56 And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God.
- Isaiah 6 Summarized when he Sees the Throne of God in Heaven.
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, <u>Go</u> unto Pharaoh, & say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, <u>Let</u> my people <u>go</u>, that they may <u>serve</u> me.
- Mark 10:15 Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the kingdom of God <u>as</u> <u>a</u> little <u>child</u>, he shall not enter therein.
- Mark 2:17 When Jesus heard *it*, he saith unto them, They that are whole have no need of the <u>physician</u>, but they that are sick: I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.
- Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto me, all *ye* that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For my yoke *is* easy, and my burden is light.
- 1 John 5:21 Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen.
- Deuteronomy 18:10,11 There shall not be found among you *any one* that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, *or* that useth divination, *or* an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a <u>consulter with familiar spirits</u>, or a wizard, or a necromancer.
- Isaiah 8:19 And when they shall say unto you, Seek unto them that have familiar spirits, and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter: should not a people seek unto their God? for the living to the dead?
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know <u>ye not</u> that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which <u>ye</u> have of God, and <u>ye are not your own</u>? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- Matthew 16:24 Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any *man* will come after me, let him <u>deny himself</u>, and take up his cross, and follow me.
- Mark 8:34 And when he had called the people *unto him* with his disciples

- also, he said unto them, Whosoever will come after me, let him <u>deny</u> himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.
- Luke 9:23 And he said to *them* all, If any *man* will come after me, let him <u>deny himself</u>, and take up his cross <u>daily</u>, and follow me.
- Galatians 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, 23 Meekness, temperance (self-control): against such there is no law.
- Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.
- Colossians 3:23 And whatsoever ye do, do *it* heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- Romans 12:21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good. More Service Notes:
- Deuteronomy 10:12 And now, Israel, what doth the LORD thy God require of thee, but to fear the LORD thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, & to serve the LORD thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul,
- 1 Samuel 12:24 Only fear the LORD, and serve him in truth with all your heart: for consider how great *things* he hath done for you.
- Job 1:1 There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name was Job; and that man was perfect and upright, & one that feared God, and eschewed evil.
- Job 28:28 And unto man he said, Behold, the fear of the Lord, that *is* wisdom; and to depart from evil *is* understanding.
- Psalms 111:10 The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do *his commandments*: his praise endureth for ever.
- Psalms 130:4 But *there is* forgiveness with thee, that thou mayest be feared.
- Hosea 3:5 Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the LORD their God, and David their king; and shall fear the LORD and his goodness in the latter days.
- Acts 9:31 Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.
