<u>Un-Resolved Issues Cause Trouble - Judges 16A</u>

- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also *that is* born unto thee shall surely die.
- Numbers 22-24 Summarized of Balaam.
- Judges 16:1-3 Then went Samson to Gaza, and saw there an harlot, and went in unto her. 2 And it was told the Gazites, saying, Samson is come hither. And they compassed him in, and laid wait for him all night in the gate of the city, and were quiet all the night, saying, In the morning, when it is day, we shall kill him. 3 And Samson lay till midnight, and arose at midnight, and took the doors of the gate of the city, and the two posts, and went away with them, bar and all, and put them upon his shoulders, and carried them up to the top of an hill that is before Hebron.
- Judges 16:1 Samson went to Gaza & saw a harlot there, & went in to her.
- 2 Samuel 11 Summarized of David & Bathsheba.
- Proverbs 31:10 Who can find a <u>virtuous</u> <u>woman</u>? for her price *is* far above rubies.
- 1 Peter 3:4 But *let it be* the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, *even the ornament* of a <u>meek</u> and <u>quiet</u> <u>spirit</u>, which is in the sight of God of great price.
- James 1:25 But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth *therein*, he being not a forgetful <u>hearer</u>, but a <u>doer</u> of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.
- Summarized previous chapter.
- Judges 16:2 *When* the Gazites *were told*, "Samson has come here!" they surrounded *the place* and lay in wait for him all night at the gate of the city. They were quiet all night, saying, "In the morning, when it is daylight, we will kill him."
- Joshua 2 Summarized of Rahab hiding the spies.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- 1 samuel 4 Summarized of Hophni & Phinehas taking the Ark to battle.
- Luke 4:13 And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season.
- Acts 9:24,25 But their laying await was known of Saul. And they watched the

- gates day and night to kill him. 25 Then the disciples took him by night, and let *him* down by the wall in a basket.
- Judges 16:3 And Samson lay *low* till midnight; then he arose at midnight, took hold of the doors of the gate of the city and the two gateposts, pulled them up, bar and all, put *them* on his shoulders, and carried them to the top of the hill that faces Hebron.

Explained the "eye of a needle".

- 2 Corinthians 11:14 And no marvel; for <u>Satan himself is transformed into an</u> angel of light.
- 2 Samuel 12:7 And Nathan said to David, <u>Thou art</u> the <u>man</u>. Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, I anointed thee king over Israel, and I delivered thee out of the hand of Saul;
- Psalm 51 referred to David repenting.
- Revelation 2:14 But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly.
- Luke 10:3 Go your ways: behold, I send you forth as lambs among wolves.
- Proverbs 7:6,7 For at the window of my house I looked through my casement, 7 And beheld among the simple ones, I discerned among the youths, a young man void of understanding.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:6 Therefore let us not sleep, as *do* others; but let us watch and be sober.
- James 1:5 If any of you lack <u>wisdom</u>, let him <u>ask</u> of God, that giveth to all *men* liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.
- Proverbs 7:8-11 Passing through the street near her corner; and he went the way to her house, 9 In the twilight, in the evening, in the black and dark night: 10 And, behold, there met him a woman with the attire (dress) of an harlot, and subtil (crafty) of heart. 11 (She is loud and stubborn; her feet abide not in her house:
- Proverbs 31:10-31 Summarized of the good attributes of the Virtuous woman.
- Proverbs 7:12-1 Now is she without, now in the streets, and lieth in wait at every corner.) 13 So she caught him, and kissed him, and with an impudent face said unto him, 14 I have peace offerings with me; this day have I payed my vows. 15 Therefore came I forth to meet thee, diligently to seek thy face, and I have found thee. (lying tongue & deceitful heart) 16 I have decked my bed with coverings of tapestry, with carved works, with

fine linen of Egypt.

Genesis 39 Summarized of Poitpher's wife wanting Joseph.

- Proverbs 7:17,18 I have perfumed my bed with myrrh, aloes, and cinnamon. 18 Come, let us take our fill of love until the morning: let us solace ourselves with loves.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all *ye* that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Leviticus 18 & 20 has God's laws against Immorality.
- Proverbs 7:19 For the (husband) is not at home, he is gone a long journey:
- Genesis 39:13 And it came to pass, when she saw that he had left his garment in her hand, and was fled forth,
- 2 Timothy 2:22 <u>Flee</u> also <u>youthful</u> <u>lusts</u>: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

And he said unto her, Behold, I have not told *it* my father nor my mother, and shall I tell *it* thee? 17 And she wept before him (Samson) the seven days, while their feast lasted: and it came to pass on the seventh day, that he told her, because she lay sore upon him: and she told the riddle to the children of her people.
- Matthew 4 & Luke 4 Jesus replied to the devil "It is Written".
- James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- Proverbs 7:22 He goeth after her straightway (immediately), as an ox goeth to the slaughter, or as a fool to the correction of the stocks; 23 Till a <u>dart (arrow) strike through his liver</u>; as a bird hasteth to the snare, and knoweth not that it is for (costs) his life.
- Romans 12:21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.
- 3 John 1:2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest <u>prosper</u> and be in health, even as thy <u>soul prospereth</u>.
