Jesus Christ - Superior To The Angels - Hebrews 1

- 2 Corinthians 11:3 But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.
- Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.
- Acts 15:1,2 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 2 When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas, and certain other of them, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.
- Luke 9:35 And there came a voice out of the cloud, saying, <u>This is my</u> beloved Son: hear him.
- Mark 7:13 Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- Hebrews 1:1-14 V1 God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets,
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.
- John 1:1-4 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 The same was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made by Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made. 4 In Him was life; and the life was the light of men.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, <u>Father</u>, <u>forgive</u> them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
- Hebrews 1:2 (God) has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds;
- Summarized briefly the life & works of Jesus.
- John 21:25 And there are also many other things which Jesus did, the which, if they should be written every one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that should be written. Amen.
- Hebrews 1:3 who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the

Majesty on high,

- Mark 9:2-9 And after six days Jesus taketh with him Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into an high mountain apart by themselves: and he was transfigured before them. 3 And his raiment became shining, exceeding white as snow; so as no fuller on earth can white them. 4 And there appeared unto them Elijah with Moses: and they were talking with Jesus. 5 And Peter answered and said to Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: and let us make three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elijah. 6 For he wist not what to say; for they were sore afraid. 7 And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear Him. 8 And suddenly, when they had looked round about, they saw no man any more, save Jesus only with themselves. 9 And as they came down from the mountain, he charged them that they should tell no man what things they had seen, till the Son of man were risen from the dead.
- John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.

Summarized of many miraculous works of Jesus.

Revelation 19 Summarized of Jesus' last coming.

Pray to God in Jesus' name for God's angels to help us.

- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- Matthew 26:53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?
- Matthew 17:5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, <u>This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye Him</u>.
- John 2:5 His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do *it*.
- John 6:29 Jesus answered and said unto them, <u>This is the work of God,</u> that ye believe on <u>Him whom He hath sent</u>.
- Hebrews 1:4 having become so much better than the angels, as He has by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or *if* ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with *him*.
- Hebrews 1:5,6 For to which of the angels did He ever say: "You are My Son, Today I have begotten You"? And again: "I will be to Him a Father, And He shall be to Me a Son"? 6 But when He again brings the firstborn into

- the world, He says: "Let all the angels of God worship Him."
- Luke 2:14 Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.
- Matthew 2:16 Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the wise men, was exceeding wroth, and sent forth, and slew all the children that were in Bethlehem, and in all the coasts thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had diligently enquired of the wise men.
- Summarized the Triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem.
- Luke 19:40 And he answered and said unto them, I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out.
- Hebrews 1:7 And of the angels He says: "Who makes His angels spirits And His ministers a flame of fire."
- 2 Kings 6:17 And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.
- 2 Kings 2:11 And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, *there appeared* a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.
- Daniel 10 Summarized of the angles fighting in the heavens.
- Hebrews 1:8 But to the Son He says: "Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your Kingdom.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Hebrews 1:9 You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness;

 Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You With the oil of gladness more than Your companions."
- Acts 15:1 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, *and said*, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.
- Acts 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.
- Hebrews 1:10 And: "You, LORD, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, And the heavens are the work of Your hands.
- Psalms 19:1 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto me, all *ye* that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30

- For my yoke *is* easy, and my burden is light.
- Hebrews 1:11 They will perish, but You remain; And they will all grow old like a garment;
- Revelation 6:14 And the heaven departed as a <u>scroll</u> when it is <u>rolled</u> together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.
- Exodus 10:22.23 And Moses stretched forth his hand toward heaven; and there was a thick <u>darkness</u> in all the land of <u>Egypt</u> three days: 23 They saw not one another, neither rose any from his place for three days: but all the children of Israel had light in their dwellings.
- Summarized of Jesus' end time return & the 1000 year rule.
- Hebrews 1:12,13 Like a cloak You will fold them up, And they will be changed. But You are the same, And Your years will not fail." 13 But to which of the angels has He ever said: "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool"?
- Psalm 110:1 A Psalm of David. The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.
- 1 Corinthians 15:25 For He must reign, till He hath put all enemies under his feet.
- Luke 15 Summarized the parable of the Vineyard & killing the Son.
- Hebrews 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?
- Hebrews 13:2 Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.
- Revelation 19:10 And I fell at his feet to <u>worship</u> him. And he said unto me, See *thou do it* not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.
- Revelation 22:8,9 And I John saw these things, and heard *them*. And when I had heard and seen, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel which shewed me these things. 9 Then saith he unto me, See *thou do it* not: for I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: worship God.
