## **Jesus Christ - In Authority Over Creation - Hebrews 2**

- 2 Corinthians 11:3 But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.
- Acts 17:11 These (Bereans) were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.
- 2 Corinthians 11:14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.
- Hebrews 2:1-18 V1-5 Therefore we must give the <u>more earnest heed</u> to the things we have heard, lest we drift away. 2 For if the word spoken through angels proved steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just reward, 3 how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him, 4 God also bearing witness both with signs and wonders, with various miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit, according to His own will?

Hebrews 1 Showed Jesus Christ was greater than the angels.

Genesis 19 Summarized of angels to get Lot out of Sodom etc.

Hebrews 2:3 how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be <u>spoken by the Lord</u>, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him,

Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

Revelation 2 & 3 Summarized of the churches.

Hebrews 2:4 God also bearing witness both with signs and wonders, with various miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit, according to His own will?

Mark 16:20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with *them*, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

Acts 16 Summarized of Paul & the girl with divination spirit.

Hebrews 2:5 For He has <u>not</u> put the world to come, of which we speak, in subjection to angels.

Hebrews 1:7 And of the angels He saith, "Who maketh his angels spirits, and his ministers a flame of fire."

Hebrews 1:14 Are they (angels) not all ministering spirits, sent forth to

## minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?

- Hebrews 2:6-8 But one testified in a certain place, saying: "What is man that You are mindful of him, Or the son of man that You take care of him? 7 You have made him a little lower than the angels; You have crowned him with glory and honor, And set him over the works of Your hands. 8 You have put all things in subjection under his feet." For in that He put all in subjection under him, He left nothing that is not put under him. But now we do not yet see all things put under him.
- Mark 8:38 Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the glory of his Father with the holy angels.
- 1 Corinthians 6:3 Know ye not that we shall judge angels? how much more things that pertain to this life?
- Matthew 26:53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than <u>twelve</u> legions of <u>angels</u>?
- Hebrews 2:8 You have put all things in subjection under his feet." For in that He put all in subjection under him, He left nothing that is not put under him. But now we do not yet see all things put under him.
- Psalms 110:1 A Psalm of David. The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.
- Mark 5:7 And cried with a loud voice, and said, What have I to do with thee, Jesus, *thou* Son of the most high God? I adjure thee by God, that thou torment me not.
- Matthew 8:29 And, behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with thee, Jesus, thou Son of God? art thou come hither to torment us before the time?
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Hebrews 2:9 But we see Jesus, who <u>was made a little lower than the</u>
  <u>angels</u>, for the <u>suffering of death crowned with glory and honor</u>, that He,
  by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.
- Matthew 17 & Mark 9 Summarized of the Mount of Transfiguration.
- Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.
- Hebrews 2:10 For it was fitting for Him, <u>for whom are all things and by</u> whom are all things, (Jesus The Centre of all things) in bringing many

- sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.
- John 8:44 Ye are of *your* <u>father</u> the devil, and the lusts of your <u>father</u> ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a <u>lie</u>, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the <u>father</u> of it.
- Jude 1:9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.
- John 17:12 While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and <u>none</u> of them is <u>lost</u>, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.
- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- 1 King 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Hebrews 2:11 For both He who sanctifies (set apart for God's purpose) and those who are being sanctified are all of one, for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren,
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, Go unto Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD, <u>Let my people go, that they may serve</u> me.
- Romans Paul talks of the old man vs the new man.
- Matthew 22:14 For many are called, but few *are* chosen.
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.
- Mark 3:32-35 And the multitude sat about him, and they said unto him, Behold, thy mother and thy brethren without seek for thee. 33 And he answered them, saying, Who is my mother, or my brethren? 34 And he looked round about on them which sat about him, and said, Behold my mother and my brethren! 35 For whosoever shall do the will of God, the same is my brother, and my sister, and mother.
- Hebrews 2:12,13 saying: "I will declare Your name to My brethren; In the midst of the assembly I will sing praise to You." 13 And again: "I will put My trust in Him." And again: "Here am I and the children whom God has

- given Me."
- Galatians 3:26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now *is* the accepted time; behold, now *is* the day of salvation.)
- Acts 15:1 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, *and said*, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.
- Acts 15 Summarized V20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.
- Leviticus 18 & 20 God's laws for immorality.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 Old Testament laws for the occult.
- Acts 19:19 Many of them also which used curious arts brought their <u>books</u> together, and <u>burned</u> them before all *men*: and they counted the price of them, and found *it* fifty thousand *pieces* of silver.
- Hebrews 2:14-18 Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, 15 and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage. 16 For indeed He does not give aid to angels, but He does give aid to the seed of Abraham. 17 Therefore, in all things He had to be made like His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.
- Hebrews 4:15 For we have not an <u>high priest</u> which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in <u>all</u> points tempted like as *we are, yet* without sin.
- Galatians 4:6 And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, <u>Abba</u>, <u>Father</u>.
- Matthew 11:11 Verily I say unto you, Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.
- Hebrews 2:18 For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted.
- Romans 12:21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in <u>sin, that grace</u> may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any

## longer therein?

- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- 1 John 3:8 He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

## **More Service Notes:**

- Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?
- Genesis 19:15 And when the morning arose, then the angels hastened Lot, saying, Arise, take thy wife, and thy two daughters, which are here; lest thou be consumed in the iniquity of the city.
- Genesis 19:22 Haste thee, escape thither; for I cannot do any thing till thou be come thither. Therefore the name of the city was called Zoar.
- John 3:16-21 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. 17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. 18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. 19 And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. 20 For every one that doeth evil hateth the light,

- neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. 21 But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.
- Luke 4:6-8 And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it. 7 If thou therefore wilt worship me, all shall be thine. 8 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.
- Daniel 7:14 And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.
- Mark 16:17-18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Psalms 8:4-6 What is man, that thou art mindful of him? and the son of man, that thou visitest him? 5 For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honour. 6 Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all things under his feet:
- Psalms 22:22 I will declare thy name unto my brethren: in the midst of the congregation will I praise thee.
- Psalms 18:2 The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower.
