<u>Jesus Christ - Superior To Moses - Hebrews 3A</u>

- Psalms 110:1 A Psalm of David. The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.
- Jude 1:9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.
- Hebrews 3:1-6 V1 Therefore, holy brethren (Christian Jews), partakers of the heavenly calling (vocation), consider the Apostle (sent forth One) and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus,
- Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?
- Hebrews 2:17,18 Therefore, in all things He had to be made like *His* brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things *pertaining* to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people. 18 For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted.
- Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.
- Romans 11:26 And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, & shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:
- Mark 16:15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.
- 1 Timothy 2:5 For *there is* one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- Hebrews 3:2 Who was <u>faithful</u> to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also was faithful in all His house.
- Luke 18:8 I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall He find faith on the earth?
- Luke 4 Summarized the temptations of Jesus in the wilderness.
- Luke 4:4 And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.
- Hebrews 3:3 For this One has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as He who built the house has more honor than the house.
- Moses is accounted with the most miracles in the Old Testament.
- Hebrews 3:4 For every house is built by someone, but He who <u>built all things</u> <u>is God</u>.
- Luke 9:26 "For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words, of him the Son of Man will be ashamed when He comes in His *own* glory, and *in His* Father's, and of the holy angels.

- Hebrews 3:5 And Moses indeed was <u>faithful</u> in all His house as a <u>servant</u>, for a testimony of those things which would be spoken afterward,
- Numbers 12:3 (Now the man <u>Moses was very meek, above all the men</u> which were upon the face of the earth.)
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.
- Moses interceeded in prayer often for the sins of Israelites. Even for 40 days & nights at Mount Sinai.
- Hebrews 3:6 but Christ as a Son over His own house, whose house we are if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm to the end.
- John 12:27 Now is my soul troubled; and what shall I say? Father, save me from this hour: but for this cause came I unto this hour.
- Luke 23:34 Then said Jesus, <u>Father</u>, <u>forgive</u> them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots.
- Matthew 7:24-29 Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: 25 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock. 26 But everyone who hears these sayings of Mine, and does not do them, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand: 27 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it fell. And great was its fall. 28 And so it was, when Jesus had ended these sayings, that the people were astonished at His teaching, 29 for He taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- Mark 7:13 Making the <u>word</u> of <u>God</u> of none effect through your <u>tradition</u>, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.
- John 4 Summarized of the woman at the well. V 22 Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.
- Jonah Summarized.
- Acts 3:22 For Moses truly said to the fathers, The LORD your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your brethren. Him you shall hear in all things, whatever He says to you.
- Deuteronomy 18:15 The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a <u>Prophet</u> from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken;
- Acts 6:11 Then they secretly induced men to say, We have heard him speak blasphemous words against Moses and God.
- Similar to 1 Kings 21 Summarized of Ahab, Jezebel, & Naboth.
- Deuteronomy 19:18,19 And the judges shall make diligent inquisition: and, behold, *if* the witness *be* a false witness, *and* hath testified falsely against

- his brother; 19 Then shall ye do unto him, as he had thought to have done unto his brother: so shalt thou put the evil away from among you.
- Acts 6:14 for we have heard him say that this Jesus of Nazareth will destroy this place and change the customs which Moses delivered to us.
- Mark 14:56 For many bore false witness against Him, but their testimonies did not agree.
- Acts 15:1 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, *and said*, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. Summarized the whole account.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.
- Exodus 32:6 And they <u>rose up</u> early on the morrow, and offered burnt offerings, and brought peace offerings; and the people sat down to eat and to drink, and rose up to play.
- Summarized the account when Moses returned.
- Acts 7:20 At this time Moses was born, and was well pleasing to God; and he was brought up in his father's house for three months.
- Acts 7:22 And Moses was <u>learned</u> in all the wisdom of the Egyptians, and was <u>mighty in words and deeds</u>.
- Exodus 4:10 And Moses said unto the LORD, O my Lord, I *am* not eloquent, neither heretofore, nor since thou hast spoken unto thy servant: but I *am* slow of speech, and of a slow tongue.
- Acts 7:29 Then, at this saying, Moses fled and became a dweller in the land of Midian, where he had two sons.
- **Exodus 2 Summarized Moses fleeing Egypt.**
- Exodus 12:12 For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD.
- Acts 7:31 When Moses saw *it*, he marveled at the sight; and as he drew near to observe, the voice of the Lord came to him,
- **Exodus 3 Summarized of the burning bush.**
- Acts 7:32 saying, I am the God of your fathers--the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.' And Moses trembled and dared not look.
- Matthew 22:32 I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living.
- Acts 7:35 This Moses whom they rejected, saying, Who made you a ruler and a judge? is the one God sent *to be* a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the Angel who appeared to him in the bush.
- Isaiah 6 Summarized the vision of Heaven.
- Acts 7:37 This is that Moses who said to the children of Israel, The LORD your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your brethren. Him you shall hear.

- Acts 7:55 he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, & saw the glory of God, & Jesus standing on the right hand of God,
- Acts 7:40 saying to Aaron, Make us gods to go before us; *as for* this Moses who brought us out of the land of Egypt, we do not know what has become of him.
- Acts 7:44 Our fathers had the tabernacle of witness in the wilderness, as He appointed, instructing Moses to make it according to the pattern that he had seen,
- Acts 13:39 and by Him (Jesus) everyone who believes is justified from all things from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses.
- John 1:17 For the law was given by Moses, *but* grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.
- Acts 15:1 And certain *men* came down from Judea and taught the brethren, Unless you are circumcised according to the custom of Moses, you cannot be saved.
- Acts 15:5 But some of the sect of the Pharisees who believed rose up, saying, It is necessary to circumcise them, and to command *them* to keep the law of Moses.
- Acts 15:21 For Moses has had throughout many generations those who preach him in every city, being read in the synagogues every Sabbath.
- Acts 21:21 but they have been informed about you that you teach all the Jews who are among the Gentiles to forsake Moses, saying that they ought not to circumcise *their* children nor to walk according to the customs.
- John 6:29 Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on Him whom He hath sent.
- **Exodus 17 Summarized Moses striking the rock at Meribah.**
- Hebrews 7:25 Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.
- Acts 26:22 Therefore, having obtained help from God, to this day I stand, witnessing both to small and great, saying no other things than those which the prophets and Moses said would come--
- Acts 28:23 So when they had appointed him a day, many came to him at *his* lodging, to whom he explained and solemnly testified of the kingdom of God, persuading them concerning Jesus from both the Law of Moses and the Prophets, from morning till evening.
