

Evil Heart Of Unbelief Destroys God's People - Hebrews 3B

Genesis 3 Summarized of doubting God in the Garden of Eden.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

1 Samuel 15:22 And Samuel said, Hath the LORD *as great* delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey *is* better than sacrifice, *and* to hearken than the fat of rams.

Numbers 32:11,12 Surely none of the men that came up out of Egypt, from twenty years old and upward, shall see the land which I swear unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob; because they have not wholly followed me: 12 Save Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenezite, and Joshua the son of Nun: for they have wholly followed the LORD.

Numbers 13 Summarized of the report of the spies returning.

Numbers 14:2 And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron: and the whole congregation said unto them, Would God that we had died in the land of Egypt! or would God we had died in this wilderness!

Hebrews 3:7-19 - V7,8 Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says: Today, if you will hear His voice, 8 Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, In the day of trial in the wilderness, 9 Where your fathers tested Me, tried Me, And saw My works forty years.

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

Mark 16:14 Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.

Genesis 3 Summarized of the 1 law in the Garden of Eden.

Summarized of the murmurings of the Israelites in the wilderness even though God gave them manna & quail in abundance.

Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, *even* those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both

good and evil.

Hebrews 3:10 Therefore I was angry with that generation, And said, They always go astray in their heart, And they have not known My ways.

Exodus 32 Summarized

Judges 6:31 And Joash said unto all that stood against him, Will ye plead for Baal? will ye save him? he that will plead for him, let him be put to death whilst *it is yet* morning: if he *be* a god, let him plead for himself, because *one* hath cast down his altar.

Psalms 7:11 God judgeth the righteous, and God is angry *with the wicked* every day.

Ezekiel 14 Summarized of the idols in the heart.

Hebrews 3:11,12 So I swore in My wrath, They shall not enter My rest. 12 Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God;

Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

1 King 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again.

Acts 8: 21,22 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God. 22 Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee.

Romans 10:17 So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Luke 18:8 I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?

Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Luke 24:45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,

Hebrews 3:13 but exhort one another daily, while it is called Today, lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

Acts 5 & 6 Summarized of the early church meeting daily.

John 13:35 By this shall all *men* know that ye are my disciples, if ye have

love one to another.

Luke 10 Summarized of the parable of the Good Samaritan.

John 9:4 I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.

Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.

Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

Romans 12:21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.

1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

Matthew 6:14 For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:

Matthew 6:11-13 Give us this day our daily bread. 12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. 13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

Ezekiel 18:20A The soul that sinneth, it shall die.

Revelation 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it *shall be* for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err *therein*.

Romans 8: nothing separat for love god

Hebrews 3:14 For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end, 15 while it is said: Today, if you will hear His voice, Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion.

John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against

principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

Daniel 10 Summarized of the fight in the heavenlies.

1 Corinthians 11:28 But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of *that* bread, and drink of *that* cup. **29** For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. **30** For this cause many *are* weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.

Hebrews 3:16,17 For who, having heard, rebelled? Indeed, was it not all who came out of Egypt, led by Moses? **17** Now with whom was He angry forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose corpses fell in the wilderness?

Summarized of the murmurings of Israelites in the wilderness.

Hebrews 3:18 And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who did not obey?

Numbers 14:40,44,45 And they rose up early in the morning, and gat them up into the top of the mountain, saying, Lo, we *be here*, and will go up unto the place which the LORD hath promised: for we have sinned. **44** But they presumed to go up unto the hill top: nevertheless the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and Moses, departed not out of the camp. **45** Then the Amalekites came down, and the Canaanites which dwelt in that hill, and smote them, and discomfited them, *even* unto Hormah.

Hebrews 3:19 So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief.

Acts 8; 16; & 19 have deliverances after Jesus' ascension.

Psalms 95:7-11 (Summarized) For He is our God, And we are the people of His pasture, And the sheep of His hand. Today, if you will hear His voice: **8** Do not harden your hearts, as in the rebellion, As in the day of trial in the wilderness, **9** When your fathers tested Me; They tried Me, though they saw My work. **10** For forty years I was grieved with that generation, And said, It is a people who go astray in their hearts, And they do not know My ways. **11** So I swore in My wrath, `They shall not enter My rest.

Judges 6:36-40 (Summarized) So Gideon said to God, If You will save Israel by my hand as You have said-- **37** look, I shall put a fleece of wool on the threshing floor; if there is dew on the fleece only, and it is dry on all the ground, then I shall know that You will save Israel by my hand, as You have said. **38** And it was so. When he rose early the next morning and squeezed the fleece together, he wrung the dew out of the fleece, a bowlful of water. **39** Then Gideon said to God, Do not be angry with me,

but let me speak just once more: Let me test, I pray, just once more with the fleece; let it now be dry only on the fleece, but on all the ground let there be dew. 40 And God did so that night. It was dry on the fleece only, but there was dew on all the ground.

John 10:37,38 If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not. 38 But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father *is* in me, and I in him.

Summarized of the laws of those healed of leprosy & Jesus healing them.

John 14:11 Believe me that I *am* in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.

Mark 16:14 Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.

Matthew 13:58 And He did not many mighty works there because of their unbelief.

James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; & let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just healing.

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly.
