Jesus Christ Is Living And Powerful - Hebrews 4B

- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- Acts 15:1,5 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved. 5 But there rose up certain of the sect of the Pharisees which believed, saying, That it was needful to circumcise them, and to command them to keep the law of Moses.
- Romans 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, <u>The just shall live by faith</u>.
- Hebrews 4:11-16 V11 Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience (unbelief).
- Hebrews 4:6 Since therefore it remains that some *must* enter it, and those to whom it was first preached did not enter because of disobedience, Genesis 19 Summarized of Lot leaving Sodom.
- Mark 16:14 Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.
- Hebrews 4:12,13 For the Word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. 13 And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.
- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- John 1:1-4 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. 4 In Him was life (eternal life), and the life was the light of men.
- Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.
- God in the Trinity is similar the three phases of H2O water, ice, & water vapour.
- Matthew 22:32 I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living.
- John 14:30 Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in me.

- Matthew 12:15 But when Jesus knew *it*, he withdrew himself from thence: and great multitudes followed him, and <u>He healed them all</u>;
- Mark 10 Summarized of blind Bartimaeus. V51 And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I should do unto thee? The blind man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive my sight.
- Luke 10:27 And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.
- **Exodus 20 Summarized of the 10 Commandments.**
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- Luke 8:12 Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.
- Matthew 23 referred to the 8 woes of Jesus on the religious leaders. V13A But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites!
- Revelation 2 & 3 Summarized the letters to the churches.
- Referred to the parable of the Good Samaritan.
- John 8:48 Then answered the Jews, and said unto him, Say we not well that <u>thou</u> art a <u>Samaritan</u>, and hast a devil?
- John 11:50 Nor consider that it is expedient for us, that <u>one</u> man should <u>die</u> for the people, and that the whole nation perish not.
- Matthew 21:13 And said unto them, It is written, My <u>house</u> shall be called the <u>house</u> of <u>prayer</u>; but ye have made it a den of <u>thieves</u>.
- Matthew 12:36 But I say unto you, That every <u>idle</u> word that men shall speak, they shall give <u>account</u> thereof in the day of judgment.
- Matthew 5:28 But I say unto you, That whosoever <u>looketh</u> on a <u>woman</u> to <u>lust</u> after her hath committed adultery with her already in his <u>heart</u>.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and

- acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden. (Summarized)
- Many Godly men died just before the flood in Noah's day.
- Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now *is* the accepted time; behold, now *is* the day of salvation.)
- 1 Peter 1:15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;
- Hebrews 4:14 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.
- Luke 23:4 Then said Pilate to the chief priests and *to* the people, <u>I find no</u> fault in this man.
- Acts 5 referred to the 2 insurrections mentioned.
- Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.
- Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him, seeing <u>He ever liveth to make intercession for them</u>.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.
- Exodus 32 Referred to the actions of the Israelites & the golden calf.
- Hebrews 4:15 (NKJV) For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.
- Hebrews 4:15 (AV) For we have not an High Priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.
- 2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. 8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. 9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I

rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

1 Corinthians 1:27 But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty;

Romans 12:21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.

Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are <u>sealed</u> unto the day of <u>redemption</u>.

John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.

Acts 2 Holy spirit came in might & Power

1 Corinthians 2:4 And my speech and my preaching *was* not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Genesis 6:8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.

Mark 15:38 And the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom.

Summarized of Esther approaching the King.

Psalms 136 every verse ends with "His mercy endureth forever"

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Matthew 14 Summarized of the storm on the sea.

Matthew 11:28,29 Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

Matthew 12:43 When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he goes through dry places, seeking rest, and finds none.

Mark 6:31 And He said to them, Come aside by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while. For there were many coming and going, and they did not even have time to eat.

Luke 11:24 When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he goes through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he says, I will return to my house from which I came.

- 1. Gr. katapausis, equivalent to the Hebrew word _noah_ #Heb 4:1
- 2. Gr. anapausis, "rest from weariness" #Mt 11:28
- 3. Gr. anesis, "relaxation" #2Th 1:7

4. Gr. sabbatismos, a Sabbath rest, a rest from all work #Heb 4:9 R.V., "sabbath"), a rest like that of God when he had finished the work of creation.

Proverbs 3:24 When thou liest down, thou shalt not be afraid: yea, thou shalt lie down, and thy <u>sleep</u> shall be <u>sweet</u>.

Revelation 19:11-21 Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. 12 His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. 13 He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. 14 And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. 15 Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. 16 And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS. 17 Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather together for the supper of the great God, 18 that you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, both small and great. 19 And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army. 20 Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone. 21 And the rest were killed with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse. And all the birds were filled with their flesh.
