

Jesus Christ - High Priest From God - Hebrews 5A

Hebrews 4:14,15 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast *our* confession. 15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all *points* tempted as *we are*, yet without sin.

John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.

Hebrews 5:1-9 - V1 For every high priest taken from among men is appointed for men in things pertaining to God, that he may offer both gifts and sacrifices for sins.

Jeremiah 3:15 And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.

Numbers 3:12 And I, behold, I have taken the Levites from among the children of Israel instead of all the firstborn that openeth the matrix among the children of Israel: therefore the Levites shall be mine;

Summarized of Aaron as the first High Priest & of his sons.

Leviticus - Explains God's instructions for His priests to be clean & holy.

Summarized of the High Priests in Jesus' time under Roman rule.

Jesus cleaned out the temple twice in His ministry.

Luke 19:46 Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Hebrews 5:2 He can have compassion on those who are ignorant and going astray, since he himself is also subject to weakness.

Matthew 9:36 But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

Matthew 7:13 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide *is* the gate, & broad *is* the way, that leads to destruction, & many there be which go in thereat:

Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

John 4:6 Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied with *his* journey, sat thus on the well: *and* it was about the sixth hour.

Luke 8:23 But as they sailed he fell asleep: & there came down a storm of wind on the lake; and they were filled *with water*, and were in jeopardy.

Hebrews 5:3 Because of this he is required as for the people, so also for

himself, to offer sacrifices for sins.

2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

Romans 6:1 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? **2** God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?

Matthew 6:11,12 Give us this day our daily bread. 12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

James 4:17 Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth *it* not, to him it is sin.

2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Hebrews 5:4 And no man takes this honor to himself, but he who is called by God, just as Aaron was.

Exodus 32 Summarized of Korah & the rebels; of Aarons rod that budded & had almonds; & of Aaron & Miriam; etc.

Hebrews 5:5 So also Christ did not glorify Himself to become High Priest, but it was He who said to Him: You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.

Psalms 2:7 I will declare the decree: The LORD has said to Me, You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.

Acts 5:29 Then Peter and the *other* apostles answered and said, We ought to obey God rather than men.

Hebrews 5:6 As He also says in another place: You are a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek;

Genesis 14 Summarized of Melchizedek.

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

Hebrews 5:7,8 Who, in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications, with vehement cries and tears to Him who was able to save Him from death, and was heard because of His godly fear, 8 though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered.

Luke 6:12,13 And it came to pass in those days, that he went out into a mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God. 13 And when it was day, he called *unto him* his disciples: and of them he chose twelve, whom also he named apostles;

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against

principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

Ephesians 6:18 Praying always with all prayer & supplication in the Spirit, & watching thereunto with all perseverance & supplication for all saints;

Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.

Matthew 26 Summarized of Our Lord Jesus praying in the Garden of Gethsemane.

John 18:37 Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.

Summarized sufferings & afflictions of our Lord.

John 15:20 Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.

Hebrews 5:9 And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him,

Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

John 6:28,29 Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God? 29 Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.

Acts 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Numbers 1:47-51 - 47 But the Levites were not numbered among them by their fathers' tribe; **48** for the LORD had spoken to Moses, saying: **49** Only the tribe of Levi you shall not number, nor take a census of them among the children of Israel; **50** but you shall appoint the Levites over the tabernacle of the Testimony, over all its furnishings, and over all things that belong to it; they shall carry the tabernacle and all its furnishings; they shall attend to it and camp around the tabernacle. **51** And when the tabernacle is to go forward, the Levites shall take it down; and when the tabernacle is to be set up, the Levites shall set it up. The outsider who comes near shall be put to death.

1 Corinthians 14:33 For God is not *the author* of confusion, but of peace, as

in all churches of the saints.

Mark 7:13 Making the word of God of none effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered: and many such like things do ye.

Psalms 110:4 The LORD has sworn And will not relent, You are a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek.

Psalms 110:1 A Psalm of David. The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.

Hebrews 12:2 looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Revelation 1:8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.

Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

Matthew 27:42 He saved others; himself he cannot save. If he be the King of Israel, let him now come down from the cross, & we will believe him.

John 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, He said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

Matthew 11:28 Are you tired? Worn out? Burned out on religion? Come to me. Get away with me and you'll recover your life. I'll show you how to take a real rest.

Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore He is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him, seeing He ever liveth to make intercession for them.

Matthew 14:14 And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick.

In the Gospel of John , Jesus reveals Himself first as a good man, then as a prophet, & finally as the Messiah.

Hebrews 7:27 who does not need daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the people's, for this He did once for all when He offered up Himself.

Romans 3:25 Whom God hath set forth *to be* a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;
