Dull of Hearing Blocks Godly Truths - Hebrews 5B

- Summarized of Paul"s explanations of our Lord Jesus being supreme.
- Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing He ever liveth to make <u>intercession</u> for them.
- 1 Timothy 2:5 For *there is* one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- Hebrews 5:10-14 V 10 Called by God as High Priest according to the order of Melchizedek,
- John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- Revelation 19:13 And he *was* clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.
- Acts 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.
- John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- Psalms 110:4 The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou *art* a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek.
- Jude 1:9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the <u>body</u> of <u>Moses</u>, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.
- John 14:11 Believe me that I *am* in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.
- John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.
- Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.
- 2 Peter 3:16 as also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things, in which are some things hard to understand, which untaught and unstable *people* twist to their own destruction, as *they do* also the rest of the Scriptures.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- 2 Timothy 3:16,17 <u>All scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in</u>

- <u>righteousness</u>: 17 That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.
- **Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.**
- Summarized of Paul's epistles & the instructions there for Christians.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all *ye* that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Isaiah 6:10 Make the heart of this people dull, And their ears heavy, And shut their eyes; Lest they see with their eyes, And hear with their ears, And understand with their heart, And return and be healed.
- Exodus Referred to how Pharoah hardened his heart then later on God hardened it too.
- Matthew 13:15 For the <u>hearts of this people have grown dull</u>. Their <u>ears are hard of hearing</u>, And their <u>eyes they have closed</u>, Lest they should see with *their* eyes and hear with *their* ears, Lest they should understand with *their* hearts and turn, So that I should heal them.
- Mark 8:17 But Jesus, being aware of *it*, said to them, Why do you reason because you have no bread? Do you not yet perceive nor understand? Is your heart still hardened? 18 Having eyes, do you not see? And having ears, do you not hear? And do you not remember?
- Acts 28:27 For the hearts of this people have grown dull. Their ears are hard of hearing, And their eyes they have closed, Lest they should see with *their* eyes and hear with *their* ears, Lest they should understand with *their* hearts and turn, So that I should heal them.
- Matthew 16:15 He saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am?
- Hebrews 5:11 of whom we have much to say, and hard to explain, since you have become dull of hearing.
- Strongs #3576 nothros no-thros' AV-dull 1, slothful 1; 2
- 1) slow, sluggish, indolent, dull, languid
- Hebrews 5:11 Of whom we have many things to say, and hard to be uttered, seeing ye are dull <3576> of hearing.
- Hebrews 6:12 That ye be not slothful <3576>, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 <u>Examine</u> yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- John 6:29 Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.
- Mark 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that

- believeth not shall be damned.
- Hebrews 5:12 For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracles (Word) of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food.
- Revelation 3:16 So then because thou art <u>lukewarm</u>, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.
- Luke 8:12 Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.

reveal truths

- Matthew 4 & Luke 4 Our Lord Jesus often replied to the devil, "it is written..."
- Romans 1:17 For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from <u>faith</u> to <u>faith</u>: as it is written, The <u>just</u> shall <u>live</u> by <u>faith</u>.
- Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
- Romans 10:17 So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
- Hebrews 5:13 For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe.
- **Explained of modern errors taught by religious leaders.**
- Hebrews 5:14 <u>But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil</u>.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which* is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Numbers 33:55 But if ye will not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you; then it shall come to pass, that those which ye let remain of them *shall be* pricks in your eyes, and thorns in your sides, and shall vex you in the land wherein ye dwell.
- Mark 16:17 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Do not be deceived: "Evil company corrupts good habits (manners).

Matthew 11:16-24 But to what shall I liken this generation? It is like children sitting in the marketplaces and calling to their companions, 17 and saying: We played the flute for you, And you did not dance; We mourned to you, And you did not lament, 18 For John (Baptist) came neither eating nor drinking, and they say, He has a demon. 19 The Son of Man came eating and drinking, and they say, Look, a glutton and a winebibber, a friend of tax collectors and sinners! But wisdom is justified by her children. 20 Then He began to rebuke the cities in which most of His mighty works had been done, because they did not repent: 21 Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes. 22 But I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon in the day of judgment than for you. 23 And you, Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to Hades; for if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day. 24 But I say to you that it shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom in the day of judgment than for you.

Galatians 3:1-5 O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you that you should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed among you as crucified? 2 This only I want to learn from you: Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? 3 Are you so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now being made perfect by the flesh? 4 Have you suffered so many things in vain--if indeed it was in vain? 5 Therefore He who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you, does He do it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?

James 1:25 But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.

Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
