

The False Spirit - Micah 2

John 10:10 The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have *it* more abundantly.

Micah 2:11 If a man should walk in a false spirit And speak a lie, *saying*, I will prophesy to you of wine and drink, Even he would be the prattler (prophet) of this people.

John 14:26 But the Comforter, *which is* the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

1 John 4:1 Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world.

Jeremiah & Ezekiel were hard on the false prophets.

2 Timothy 4:3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers;

John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

Acts 17:11 These (Bereans) were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.

Luke 4 Jesus rebuked the devil & replied with "It is written..."

Genesis 21:23 Now therefore, swear to me by God that you will not deal falsely with me, with my offspring, or with my posterity; but that according to the kindness that I have done to you, you will do to me and to the land in which you have dwelt.

Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves.

Therefore be wise as serpents and harmless as doves.

Exodus 5:9 Let more work be laid on the men, that they may labor in it, and let them not regard false words.

Exodus 20:16 You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Proverbs 22:1 A *good* name *is* rather to be chosen than great riches, *and* loving favour rather than silver and gold.

Exodus 23:1 You shall not circulate a false report. Do not put your hand with the wicked to be an unrighteous witness.

Exodus 23:7 Keep yourself far from a false matter; do not kill the innocent and righteous. For I will not justify the wicked.

1 Kings 21 Summarized of Jezebel planning against Naboth.

1 Timothy 5:13 And withal they (younger widows) learn *to be* idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies, speaking things which they ought not.

Leviticus 6:3 or if he has found what was lost & lies concerning it, & swears falsely--in any one of these things that a man may do in which he sins:

Job 21:34 How then can you comfort me with empty words, Since falsehood remains in your answers?

Job 31:5 If I have walked with falsehood, Or if my foot has hastened to deceit,

Romans 12:21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.

2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Job 41:9 Indeed, any hope of overcoming him is false; Shall one not be overwhelmed at the sight of him? (Leviathan)

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Psalms 4:2 How long, O you sons of men, Will you turn my glory to shame? How long will you love worthlessness And seek falsehood? Selah

Psalms 5:6 You shall destroy those who speak falsehood; The LORD abhors the bloodthirsty and deceitful man.

Psalms 7:14 Behold, the wicked brings forth iniquity; Yes, he conceives trouble and brings forth falsehood.

Exodus 22:18 Thou shalt not suffer a witch to live.

John 8:11 She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

Matthew 23 Summarized the 8 Woes our Lord had for the hypocritical religious leaders

Psalms 119:78 Let the proud be ashamed, For they treated me wrongfully with falsehood; But I will meditate on Your precepts.

Psalms 119:104 Through Your precepts I get understanding; Therefore I hate every false way.

Proverbs 1 Solomon on wisdom.

James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all *men* liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

Psalms 120:3 What shall be given to you, Or what shall be done to you, You false tongue?

Psalms 144:8 Whose mouth speaks vain words, And whose right hand is a right hand of falsehood.

Proverbs 17:4 An evildoer gives heed to false lips; A liar listens eagerly to a spiteful tongue.

Proverbs 25:14 Whoever falsely boasts of giving Is like clouds and wind without rain.

Proverbs 30:8 Remove falsehood and lies far from me; Give me neither poverty nor riches--Feed me with the food allotted to me;

Matthew 6:11 Give us this day our daily bread.

Isaiah 28:15 Because you have said, We have made a covenant with death, And with Sheol we are in agreement. When the overflowing scourge passes through, It will not come to us, For we have made lies our refuge, And under falsehood we have hidden ourselves.

Isaiah 43:2 When you pass through the waters, I *will be* with you; And through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, Nor shall the flame scorch you.

Isaiah 57:4 Whom do you ridicule? Against whom do you make a wide mouth And stick out the tongue? Are you not children of transgression, Offspring of falsehood,

Isaiah 59:13 In transgressing and lying against the LORD, And departing from our God, Speaking oppression and revolt, Conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood.

Mark 7:21-23 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, 22 Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: 23 All these evil things come from within, & defile the man.

Jeremiah 5:31 The prophets prophesy falsely, & the priests rule by their own power; & My people love to have it so. But what will you do in the end?

1 Timothy 4:1 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; **2** Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron;

1 Kings 22:22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade *him*, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.

Deuteronomy 13:3 you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams, for the LORD your God is testing you to know whether you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

Jeremiah 8:8 How can you say, We are wise, And the law of the LORD is with us? Look, the false pen of the scribe certainly works falsehood.

Deuteronomy 18:10,11 There shall not be found among you *any one* that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, *or* that useth divination, *or* an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, **11** Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer.

Isaiah 8:19 And when they shall say unto you, Seek unto them that have familiar spirits, and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter: should not a people seek unto their God? for the living to the dead?

Jeremiah 10:14 Everyone is dull-hearted, without knowledge; Every metalsmith is put to shame by an image; For his molded image is falsehood, And there is no breath in them.

Exodus 20:3 Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

Jeremiah 13:25 This is your lot, The portion of your measures from Me, says the LORD, Because you have forgotten Me and trusted in falsehood.

Jeremiah 14:14 And the LORD said to me, The prophets prophesy lies in My name. I have not sent them, commanded them, nor spoken to them; they prophesy to you a false vision, divination, a worthless thing, and the deceit of their heart.

Acts 8 Summarized of Peter & Simon Magus.

Jeremiah 23:32 Behold, I am against those who prophesy false dreams, says the LORD, and tell them, and cause My people to err by their lies and by their recklessness. Yet I did not send them or command them; therefore they shall not profit this people at all, says the LORD.

Hebrews 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, *even* those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

Jeremiah 37:14 Then Jeremiah said, False! I am not defecting to the Chaldeans. But he did not listen to him. So Irijah seized Jeremiah and brought him to the princes.

Ezekiel 12:24 For no more shall there be any false vision or flattering

divination within the house of Israel.

Micah 2:11 If a man should walk in a false spirit And speak a lie, saying, I will prophesy to you of wine and drink, Even he would be the prattler of this people.

Zechariah 8:17 Let none of you think evil in your heart against your neighbor; And do not love a false oath. For all these are things that I hate, Says the LORD.

Matthew 24:24 For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.

Matthew 26:59 Now the chief priests, the elders, and all the council sought false testimony against Jesus to put Him to death,

Luke 3:14 Likewise the soldiers asked him (John the Baptist), saying, And what shall we do? So he said to them, Do not intimidate anyone or accuse falsely, and be content with your wages.

2 Corinthians 11:13 For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into apostles of Christ.

2 Corinthians 11:26 in journeys often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils of my own countrymen, in perils of the Gentiles, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren;

Colossians 2:18 Let no one cheat you of your reward, taking delight in false humility and worship of angels, intruding into those things which he has not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind,

1 Timothy 6:20 O Timothy! Guard what was committed to your trust, avoiding the profane and idle babblings and contradictions of what is falsely called knowledge--

Strong's #5580 pseudochristos *psyoo-dokh'-ris-tos* AV-false Christ 2;

1) a false Christ (or Messiah)

2) one who falsely lays claim to the name and office of the Messiah

Strong's #5578 pseudoprophetes *psyoo-dop-rof-ay'-tace* AV-false prophet 11;

1) one who, acting the part of a divinely inspired prophet, utters falsehoods under the name of divine prophecies 2) a false prophet

Strong's #5570 pseudapostolos *psyoo-dap-os'-tol-os* AV-false apostle 1;

1) a false apostle, one who falsely claims to be an ambassador of Christ

Strong's #5569 pseudadelphos *psyoo-dad'-el-fos* AV-false brother 2;

1) a false brother 2) one who ostentatiously professes to be a Christian, but is destitute of Christian knowledge and piety
