

## **Jesus Christ And The Six Foundational Truths - Hebrews 6A**

**Jude 1:3** Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort *you* that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.

**1 Corinthians 2:4** And my speech and my preaching *was* not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:  
**Mark 16:15** And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

**Hebrews 5:12-14** For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need *someone* to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food. 13 For everyone who partakes *only* of milk *is* unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. 14 But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, *that is*, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

**Hebrews 6:1,2 - V1** Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, (principles of the doctrine of Christ) let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God,

**Revelation 2:4** Nevertheless I have *somewhat* against thee, because thou hast left thy first love.

**Mark 4:19** the cares of this world, & the deceitfulness of riches, & the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful.

**Matthew 7:15** Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

**Hebrews 6:1 (Message)** So come on, let's leave the preschool fingerpainting exercises on Christ and get on with the grand work of art. Grow up in Christ. The basic foundational truths are in place: turning your back on "salvation by self-help" and turning in trust toward God;

**John 15:5** I am the vine, ye *are* the branches: He that abideth in me, & I in him, the same brings forth much fruit: for without Me ye can do nothing.

**Matthew 11:28-30** Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 For My yoke *is* easy and My burden is light.

**Leviticus 26** Summarized God's judgement on sinfulness.

Referred to the Judges of Israelites turning from God & being judged, then repenting & God freeing them, etc.

**John 21:15-17** So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, *son* of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs. 16 He saith to him again the second time, Simon, *son* of Jonas, lovest thou me? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my sheep. 17 He saith unto him the third time, Simon, *son* of Jonas, lovest thou me? Peter was grieved because he said unto him the third time, Lovest thou me? And he said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I love thee. Jesus saith unto him, Feed my sheep.

**Hebrews 12:6** For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth.

**1 King 18:37** Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again.

**1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

**Isaiah 1:18** Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.

**Isaiah 6:9,10** And he said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. 10 Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.

**Luke 8:12** Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.

In the Gospel of John Jesus reveals Himself first as a good man, then as a prophet, then as the Messiah.

**Romans 10:17** So then faith *comes* by hearing, & hearing by the word of God.

**John 15:24** If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.

**Acts 17:11** These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.

**Matthew 4:23,24** And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. 24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatick, and

those that had the palsy; and he healed them.

**Matthew 15:18-20** But those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart; and they defile the man. For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies: 20 These are *the things* which defile a man: but to eat with unwashen hands defileth not a man.

**Mark 16:14** Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.

**2 Chronicles 7:13,14** If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

**Ephesians 4:28** Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with *his* hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.

**Exodus 20** Referred to the 10 Commandments.

**Leviticus 18 & 20** Referred to God's expanded list of immorality.

**Matthew 5:28** But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.

**3 John 1:2** Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

**Matthew 12:45** Then goeth he, and taketh with himself seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter in and dwell there: and the last *state* of that man is worse than the first. Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation.

**Luke 4:13** And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season.

**1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

**Hebrews 5:8** Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered;

**Hebrews 6:2** of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.

**Acts 19:2-5** He said unto them, Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost. 3 And he said unto them, Unto what then were ye baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism. 4 Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after

him, that is, on Christ Jesus. 5 When they heard *this*, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

Mark 16:16,17 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Acts 2 Referred to the Baptism of the Holy Spirit.

James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; & let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

Acts 13:3 And when they had fasted and prayed, and laid *their* hands on them, they sent *them* away.

1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

1 Timothy 3:6 Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil.

Matthew 3:8 Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:

Matthew 25:46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.

Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Acts 3:19 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord;

1 Corinthians 13 Paul writes of the resurrection.

Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

Philippians 4:3 And I intreat thee also, true yokefellow, help those women which laboured with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and *with* other my fellowlabourers, whose names are in the book of life.

John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any *man* pluck them out of my hand. 29 My Father, which gave *them* me, is greater than all; and no *man* is able to pluck *them* out of my Father's hand.

Matthew 25 The Parable of the Talents refers to the rewards for believers.
