Jesus Christ - Superior to Melchizedek - Hebrews 7A

- Paul shows the superiority of Jesus Christ through this book to the Hebrews.
- Deuteronomy 18:10,11 There shall not be found among you *any one* that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, *or* that useth divination, *or* an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer.
- Hebrews 7:1-10 V1 For this Melchizedek, <u>king of Salem, priest of the Most High God</u>, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings and blessed him,
- Strongs #3198 Melchisedek *mel-khis-ed-ek'* AV-Melchisedec 9; 9
 Melchizedek = king of righteousness 1) the king of Salem and priest of the most high God, who lived in the days of Abraham
- Strongs #4532 Salem *sal-ame'* AV-Salem 2; Salem = peace 1) the place where Melchizedek was king and thought to be the ancient name of Jerusalem
- **Genesis 13 Summarized of Abraham & Lot.**
- Genesis 13:13 But the men of Sodom *were* wicked and sinners before the LORD exceedingly.
- Genesis 14 Summarized of Abraham rescuing Lot.
- Genesis 14:17-20 And the king of Sodom went out to meet him at the Valley of Shaveh (that is, the King's Valley), after his return from the defeat of Chedorlaomer and the kings who were with him. 18 Then Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine (food); he was the priest of God Most High. 19 And he blessed him and said: Blessed be Abram of God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth; 20 And blessed be God Most High, Who has delivered your enemies into your hand. And he gave him a tithe of all.
- Psalms 103:1 *A Psalm* of David. Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, *bless* His holy name.
- **Summarized of the High Priests of the Old Testament.**
- Hebrews 4:14 Seeing then that we have a Great High Priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast *our* profession.
- Hebrews 7:2 to whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all, first being translated king of righteousness, and then also king of Salem, meaning king of peace.
- Melchizedek was an arch type of our Lord Jesus.
- Hebrews 7:3 without father, without mother, without genealogy, having

- neither beginning of days nor end of life, but made <u>like the Son of God</u>, remains a priest continually.
- The Israelites were to know their genealogy for 14 generation.
- Jude 1:9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.
- Hebrews 5:6 As *He* also says in another *place*: You *are* a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek;
- Ezra Referred to the priests knowing their genealogy to be a priest & minister.
- Acts 3 Summarized of the lame man asking alms & being healed in the name of Jesus.
- Hebrews 7:4 Now consider how great this man was, to whom even the patriarch Abraham gave a tenth of the spoils.
- Matthew 13:15 For this people's heart is waxed gross, & *their* ears are dull of hearing, & their eyes they have closed; lest at any time they should see with *their* eyes, & hear with *their* ears, & should understand with *their* heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them.
- Hebrews 7:5 And indeed those who are of the sons of Levi, who receive the priesthood, have a commandment to receive tithes from the people according to the law, that is, from their brethren, though they have come from the loins of Abraham;
- Exodus 22:29 Thou shalt not delay *to offer* the first of thy ripe fruits, and of thy liquors (juices): the firstborn of thy sons shalt thou give unto me.
- Mark 7 Summarized of Jesus chastising the priests about Corban instead of helping their elderly.
- Hebrews 7:6-8 but he whose genealogy is not derived from them received tithes from Abraham and blessed him who had the promises. 7 Now beyond all contradiction the lesser is blessed by the better. 8 Here mortal men receive tithes, but there he receives them, of whom it is witnessed that he lives.
- Malachi 3 Referred to Tithes withheld from God.
- Hebrews 7:9,10 Even Levi, who receives tithes, paid tithes through Abraham, so to speak, 10 for he was still in the loins of his father when Melchizedek met him.
- John 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, <u>It is</u> finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.
- God used moses to get the people from bondage, but God used Joshua to bring them into the Promised Land. This was a type or fore runner of our Lord Jesus bringing us into heaven.
- Mark 15:38 And the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom.

- Matthew 11:11 Verily I say unto you, Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.
- Psalms 110:1-4 V1 A Psalm of David. The LORD said to my Lord, Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool.
- John 10:34 Jesus answered them, Is it not written in your law, I said, Ye are gods?
- Romans 12:19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but *rather* give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance *is* mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.
- Revelation 6:10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?
- Psalms 110:2 The LORD shall send the rod of Your strength out of Zion. Rule in the midst of Your enemies!
- Matthew 21:9 And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed *is* he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest.
- Revelation 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him *was* called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.
- Mark 13:32 But of that day and *that* hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels which are in heaven, neither the Son, but the Father.
- Summarized of Jesus coming & the 1000 year rule.
- Romans 5:12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:
- Matthew 10:37 He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me.
- James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- Psalms 110:3,4 Your people *shall be* volunteers In the day of Your power; In the beauties of holiness, from the womb of the morning, You have the dew of Your youth. 4 The LORD has sworn And will not relent, You *are* a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek.
