The Spirit Of Slumber - Romans 11

- Summarized of God going to the Gentiles when the Jews rejected Him.
- Romans 11:8 (According as it is written, God hath given them the <u>spirit of slumber</u>, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear;) unto this day.
- Leviticus 26 Summarized of God trying 7 times to bring His people back.
- 1 King 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Daniel 4:16 Let his <u>heart</u> be changed from man's, and let a <u>beast</u>'s <u>heart</u> be given unto him; and let seven times pass over him.
- 1 Timothy 2:5 For *there is* one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- Romans 11:8 (NKJV) Just as it is written: God has given them a spirit of stupor, Eyes that they should not see And ears that they should not hear, To this very day.
- Romans 11:8 (Message) Moses and Isaiah both commented on this: Fed up with their quarrelsome, self-centered ways, God blurred their eyes and dulled their ears, Shut them in on themselves in a hall of mirrors, and they're there to this day.
- Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.
- Strongs #2659 katanuxis *kat-an'-oox-is* AV-slumber 1; 1) a pricking, piercing 2) severe sorrow, extreme grief 3) insensibility or torpor of mind, such as extreme grief easily produces 3a) hence a spirit of stupor, which renders
- their souls torpid so insensible that they are not affected at all by the offer made them of salvation through the Messiah
- Isaiah 29:10 For the LORD hath poured out upon you the spirit of deep sleep, and hath closed your eyes: the prophets and your rulers, the seers hath he covered.
- Psalm 78 mentions God's 10 punishments in wilderness on Israelites.
- Psalms 121:4 Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep.
- Romans 1:21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified *him* not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.
- Luke 24:45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might

understand the scriptures,

- John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, *they* are spirit, and *they* are life.
- Isaiah 6:10 Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed.
- 2 Kings 21 Summarized of King Mannasseh.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 If My people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Psalms 69:22-29 Let their table become a snare before them (Obesity): and that which should have been for their welfare, let it become a trap. 23 Let their eyes be darkened, that they see not; and make their loins continually to shake (fear). 24 Pour out Thine indignation upon them, and let Thy wrathful anger take hold of them. 25 Let their habitation be desolate; and let none dwell in their tents. 26 For they persecute him whom Thou hast smitten; and they talk to the grief of those whom Thou hast wounded. 27 Add iniquity unto their iniquity: and let them not come into thy righteousness. 28 Let them be blotted out of the book of the living, and not be written with the righteous. 29 But I am poor and sorrowful: let thy salvation, O God, set me up on high.

Similar to Psalms 109. Break off these curse in Jesus' name.

Romans 11:8-12 (According as it is written, God hath given them the spirit of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear;) unto this day. 9 And David saith, Let their table be made a snare, and a trap, and a stumblingblock, and a recompence unto them: 10 Let their eyes be darkened, that they may not see, and bow down their back alway. 11 I say then, Have they stumbled that they should fall? God forbid: but rather through their fall salvation is come unto the Gentiles, for to provoke them to jealousy. 12 Now if the fall of them be the riches of the world, and the diminishing of them the riches of the Gentiles; how much more their fulness?

John 15:25 But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is

written in their law, They hated Me without a cause.

- Mark 15:10 For he knew that the chief priests had delivered Him for envy.
- 1 Corinthians 2:4 And my speech and my preaching *was* not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:
- Acts 19:13-16 Then certain of the vagabond Jews, exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth. 14 And there were seven sons of *one* Sceva, a Jew, *and* chief of the priests, which did so. 15 And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye? 16 And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.
- Deuteronomy 29:4 (Moses) Yet the LORD hath not given you an heart to perceive, and eyes to see, and ears to hear, unto this day.
- Ezekiel 14:3 Son of man, these men have <u>set up their idols in their heart</u>, and put the stumblingblock of their iniquity before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them?
- Hebrews 6:1 Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God,
- Jeremiah 5:21 Hear now this, O foolish people, and without understanding; which have eyes, and see not; which have ears, and hear not:
- Jeremiah 20:6 And thou, Pashur, and all that dwell in thine house shall go into captivity: and thou shalt come to Babylon, and there thou shalt die, and shalt be buried there, thou, and all thy friends, to whom thou hast prophesied lies.
- Psalms 14:1 & 53:1 *A Psalm* of David. The fool hath said in his heart, *There is* no God. Corrupt are they, and have done abominable iniquity: *there is* none that doeth good.
- Jesus & John the Baptist said "Repent"
- Ezekiel 12:2 Son of man, thou dwellest in the midst of a rebellious house, which have eyes to see, and see not; they have ears to hear, and hear not: for they *are* a rebellious house.
- Mark 4:11,12 And he said unto them, Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God: but unto them that are without, all *these* things are done in parables: 12 That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and *their* sins should be forgiven them.

- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with Me.
- Luke 8:10 And he said, Unto you it is given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God: but to others in parables; that seeing they might not see, and hearing they might not understand.
- Acts 28:26 Saying, Go unto this people, and say, Hearing ye shall hear, and shall not understand; and seeing ye shall see, and not perceive:
- Summarized of when the people were set in Israel after God's judgements on His disobedient people.
- 2 Kings 17:34 Unto this day they do after the former manners: they fear not the LORD, neither do they after their statutes, or after their ordinances, or after the law and commandment which the LORD commanded the children of Jacob, whom He named Israel;
- 2 Kings 17:41 So these nations feared the LORD, and served their graven images, both their children, and their children's children: as did their fathers, so do they unto this day.
- 2 Corinthians 3:14 But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which *vail* is done away in Christ. 15 But even unto this day, when Moses is read, the vail is upon their heart.
- Deuteronomy 18:15 The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a <u>Prophet</u> from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, <u>like</u> unto me; unto him ye shall hearken;
- 2 Corinthians 4:4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.
- Luke 18:9-14 V9 And he spake this parable unto certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others:
- Matthew 7:28 And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his doctrine:
- Matthew 13:34 All these things spake Jesus unto the multitude in parables; and without a parable spake he not unto them:
- Luke 18:10,11 Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican. 11 The Pharisee <u>stood (Pride)</u> and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican.
- 1 John 2:23 Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father:

- (but) he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also.
- Matthew 23 Summarized of Jesus' 8 woes "Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites!..."
- Isaiah 58 Referred to God's Chosen fast.
- Luke 18:12,13 I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess. 13 And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, <u>God be merciful to me a sinner</u>.
- Matthew 19:23 Then said Jesus unto his disciples, Verily I say unto you, That a rich man shall hardly enter into the kingdom of heaven.
- Matthew 18:3 And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.
- Psalms 136 every second line is "for His mercy endureth for ever."
- Luke 18:14 I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
- Matthew 16:6 Then Jesus said unto them, Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.
- 2 Kings 5 Summarized of Naaman
- James 4:10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He shall lift you up.
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.
