Jesus Christ - Encompassed In The Tabernacle - Hebrews 9B

- Summarized of Jesus being better than all through Paul's book to the Hebrews.
- Jeremiah 31:31 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah:
- Luke 18 Summarized of the account of the Pharosee & the publican. V14 I tell you, this man went down to his house justified *rather* than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.
- Hebrews 9:2-7 For a tabernacle was prepared: the first part, in which was the lampstand, the table, and the showbread, which is called the sanctuary; 3 and behind the second veil, the part of the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of All, 4 which had the golden censer and the ark of the covenant overlaid on all sides with gold, in which were the golden pot that had the manna, Aaron's rod that budded, and the tablets of the covenant; 5 and above it were the cherubim of glory overshadowing the mercy seat. Of these things we cannot now speak in detail. 6 Now when these things had been thus prepared, the priests always went into the first part of the tabernacle, performing the services. 7 But into the second part the high priest went alone once a year, not without blood, which he offered for himself and for the people's sins committed in ignorance;
- Hebrews 9:2 For a tabernacle was prepared: the first part, in which was the lampstand, the table, and the showbread, which is called the sanctuary;
- Exodus 13:21 And the LORD went before them by <u>day</u> in a pillar of a <u>cloud</u>, to lead them the way; and by <u>night</u> in a pillar of <u>fire</u>, to give them light; to go by <u>day</u> and <u>night</u>:
- Exodus 14:19,20 And the angel of God, which went before the camp of Israel, removed and went behind them; and the pillar of the cloud went from before their face, and stood behind them: 20 And it came between the camp of the Egyptians and the camp of Israel; and it was a cloud and darkness to them, but it gave light by night to these: so that the one came not near the other all the night.
- **Exodus 32 Summarized of the golden calf.**
- Sin causes to run from God. Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his

- wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.
- Exodus 34:35 And the children of Israel saw the face of Moses, that the skin of Moses' face shone: and Moses put the vail upon his face again, until he went in to speak with him.
- Exodus 33:7 And Moses took the tabernacle, and pitched it without the camp, afar off from the camp, and called it the Tabernacle of the congregation. And it came to pass, *that* every one which sought the LORD went out unto the tabernacle of the congregation, which *was* without the camp.
- Exodus 35:4-19 And Moses spoke to all the congregation of the children of Israel, saying, This is the thing which the LORD commanded, saying: 5 Take from among you an offering to the LORD. Whoever is of a willing heart, let him bring it as an offering to the LORD: gold, silver, and bronze; 6 blue, purple, and scarlet thread, fine linen, and goats' hair; 7 ram skins dyed red, badger skins, and acacia wood; 8 oil for the light, and spices for the anointing oil and for the sweet incense; 9 onyx stones, and stones to be set in the ephod and in the breastplate. 10 And every wise hearted among you shall come, and make all that the LORD hath commanded; 11 The tabernacle, his tent, and his covering, his taches, and his boards, his bars, his pillars, and his sockets, 12 The ark, and the staves thereof, with the mercy seat, and the vail of the covering, 13 The table, and his staves, and all his vessels, and the shewbread, 14 The candlestick also for the light, and his furniture, and his lamps, with the oil for the light, 15 And the incense altar, and his staves, and the anointing oil, and the sweet incense, and the hanging for the door at the entering in of the tabernacle, 16 The altar of burnt offering, with his brasen grate, his staves, and all his vessels, the laver and his foot, 17 The hangings of the court, his pillars, and their sockets, and the hanging for the door of the court, 18 The pins of the tabernacle, and the pins of the court, and their cords, 19 The cloths of service, to do service in the holy place, the holy garments for Aaron the priest, and the garments of his sons, to minister in the priest's office.
- Romans 5 Summarized of Paul explaining that there was no sin before the law, but with the law we know sin.
- Matthew 22:37-40 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. 38 This is the first and great commandment. 39 And the second *is* like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. 40 On these two

- commandments hang all the law and the prophets.
- Exodus 30:19 & 21 So they (Aaron & sons) shall <u>wash</u> their <u>hands</u> and their feet, that they die not: and it shall be a statute for ever to them, *even* to him and to his seed throughout their generations.
- Romans 6:9,10 Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him. 10 For in that He died, He died unto sin once: but in that He liveth, He liveth unto God.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 1 Samuel 3:2,3 And it came to pass at that time, when Eli *was* laid down in his place, and his eyes began to wax dim, *that* he could not see; 3 And ere the <u>lamp</u> of God <u>went out</u> in the temple of the LORD, where the ark of God *was*, and Samuel was laid down *to sleep*;
- Romans 12:21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.
- John 8:12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.
- John 9:5 As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.
- 2 Corinthians 11:14,15 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. 15 Therefore *it is* no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly.
- Matthew 5:14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Matthew 7:Matthew 7:14 Because strait *is* the gate, and narrow *is* the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- John 6:26 Jesus answered them and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Ye seek me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the loaves, and were filled.

- Luke 15 Summarized of the Prodigal son.
- John 6:35 And Jesus said to them, I am the <u>bread of life</u>. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.
- Mark 8:2 I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now been with me three days, and have nothing to eat:
- Summarized of the murmurings in the wilderness.
- Hebrews 5:14-6:1 Summarized.
- John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, *they* are spirit, and *they* are life.
- Hebrews 5:12 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which *be* the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:
- John 10:7 Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, <u>I</u> say unto you, <u>I</u> am the door of the sheep.
- John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.

- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- John 6:48 I am that bread of life.
- Matthew 21:13 And said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Hebrews 9:3 and behind the second veil, the part of the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of All,
- Exodus 19:12 And thou shalt set bounds unto the people round about (Mount Sinai), saying, Take heed to yourselves, *that ye* go *not* up into the mount, or touch the border of it: whosoever toucheth the mount shall be

surely put to death:

- Luke 11:1 And it came to pass, that, as he was praying in a certain place, when he ceased, one of his disciples said unto him, Lord, <u>teach</u> us to <u>pray</u>, as <u>John</u> also taught his disciples.

Matthew 6 referred to the Lord's prayer.

- John 17:6-10 I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world. They were Yours, You gave them to Me, and they have kept Your word. 7 Now they have known that all things which You have given Me are from You. 8 For I have given to them the words which You have given Me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came forth from You; and they have believed that You sent Me. 9 I pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours. 10 And all Mine are Yours, and Yours are Mine, and I am glorified in them.
- Matthew 5:45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust.
- Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he <u>ever</u> liveth to make <u>intercession</u> for them.
- Numbers 4:11 Over the <u>golden</u> <u>altar</u> they shall spread a blue cloth, and cover it with a covering of badger skins; and they shall insert its poles.
- 1 Samuel 6:19 And he smote the men of Bethshemesh, because they had <u>looked</u> into the <u>ark</u> of the LORD, even he smote of the people fifty thousand and threescore and ten men: and the people lamented, because the LORD had smitten *many* of the people with a great slaughter.
- Revelation 8:3 Then another angel, having a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense, that he should offer *it* with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar which was before the

throne.

- Revelation 9:13 Then the sixth angel sounded: And I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,
- Luke 22:31,32 And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat: 32 But I have <u>prayed</u> for thee, that thy <u>faith</u> fail not: and when thou art converted, <u>strengthen</u> thy brethren.
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
- 1 Timothy 2:5 For *there is* one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- Hebrews 9:5 and above it were the cherubim of glory overshadowing the mercy seat. Of these things we cannot now speak in detail.
- John 16:23 And in that day ye shall <u>ask</u> me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall <u>ask</u> the Father in <u>my</u> <u>name</u>, he will give *it* you.
