- Galatians 5:3 For I testify again to every man that is circumcised (to fulfil the law), that he is a debtor to do the whole law.
- Summarized of Paul showing how our Lord Jesus is superior to all.
- 2 Corinthians 3:6 who also made us sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.

Hebrews 10:1-6 -

- Hebrews 10:1 (NKJV) For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, *and* not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect.
- 1 (Message) The old plan was only a hint of the good things in the new plan. Since that old "law plan" wasn't complete in itself, it couldn't complete those who followed it. No matter how many sacrifices were offered year after year, they never added up to a complete solution.
- 1 Corinthians 13:12 For now we <u>see</u> through a glass, darkly; but then <u>face</u> to <u>face</u>: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.
- James 4:17 Therefore to him that <u>knoweth</u> to <u>do</u> <u>good</u>, and doeth *it* not, to him it is <u>sin</u>.
- Hebrews 10:2 (NKJV) For then would they not have ceased to be offered? For the worshipers, once purified, would have had no more consciousness of sins.
- 2 (Message) If they had, the worshipers would have gone merrily on their way, no longer dragged down by their sins.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Acts 17:22 Then Paul stood in the midst of the Areopagus and said, Men of Athens, I perceive that in all things you are very religious;
- Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you that you should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed among you as crucified?
- Hebrews 10:3 (NKJV) But in those *sacrifices there is* a reminder of sins every year.
- 3 (Message) But instead of removing awareness of sin, when those animal sacrifices were repeated over and over they actually heightened awareness and guilt.
- Romans 7:7 What shall we say then? *Is* the <u>law</u> <u>sin</u>? God forbid. Nay, I had

- not known <u>sin</u>, but by the <u>law</u>: for I had not known lust, except the <u>law</u> had said, Thou shalt not covet.
- Matthew 11:28 Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- John 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, *there* ye may be also.
- Hebrews 10:4 (NKJV) For *it is* not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins.
- 4 (Message) The plain fact is that bull and goat blood can't get rid of sin.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.
- Luke 8 Summarized of the gadarene demoniac set free by Jesus.
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just healing.
- James 4:7 <u>Submit</u> yourselves therefore to God. <u>Resist</u> the devil, and he will flee from you.
- Hebrews 10:5 (NKJV) Therefore, when He came into the world, He said: "Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, But a body You have prepared for Me.
- 5 (Message) That is what is meant by this prophecy, put in the mouth of Christ: You don't want sacrifices and offerings year after year; you've prepared a body for me for a sacrifice.
- Genesis 3 Summarized of the curses on mankind for sin & God's promise of someday sending a Saviour.
- Matthew's Geneology of Jesus goes through Joseph's side.
- Luke's Geneology of Jesus goes through Mary's side.
- Hebrews 10:6 (NKJV) In burnt offerings and *sacrifices* for sin You had no pleasure.
- 6 (Message) It's not fragrance and smoke from the altar that whet your appetite.
- John 17:12 While I was with them in the world, I kept them in Your name. Those whom You gave Me I have kept; and none of them is lost except the son of perdition, that the Scripture might be fulfilled.
- 1 King 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again.
- 1 Samuel 15:22 Then Samuel said: Has the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, As in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, And to heed than the fat of rams.
- Mark 12:30,31 And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This *is*

- the first commandment. 31 "And the second, like *it, is* this: `You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."
- Deuteronomy 6:5 "You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.
- Leviticus 19:18 You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself: I am the LORD.
- Romans 6:15 What then? shall we <u>sin</u>, because we are not under the law, but under grace? <u>God forbid</u>.
- 1 Samuel 15:23 For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, And stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the LORD, He also has rejected you from being king.
- Isaiah 14 & Ezekiel 28 Summarized of satan's rebellion.
- Exodus 22:18 Thou shalt not suffer a witch (sorceress) to live.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.
- Romans 7:19 (NKJV) For the good that I will *to do*, I do not do; but the evil I will not *to do*, that I practice.
- 19 (Message) I decide to do good, but I don't really do it; I decide not to do bad, but then I do it anyway.
- Matthew 7:13,14 Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide *is* the gate, and broad *is* the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: 14 Because strait *is* the gate, and narrow *is* the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Psalms 40:6-8 Sacrifice and offering You did not desire; My ears You have opened. Burnt offering and sin offering You did not require. 7 Then I said, Behold, I come; In the scroll of the book it is written of me. 8 I delight to do Your will, O my God, And Your law is within my heart.
- John 5:30 I can of mine own self <u>do</u> nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own <u>will</u>, but the <u>will</u> of the Father which hath sent me.
- Psalms 40:9,10 I have proclaimed the good news of righteousness In the great assembly; Indeed, I do not restrain my lips, O LORD, You Yourself know. 10 I have not hidden Your righteousness within my heart; I have declared Your faithfulness and Your salvation; I have not concealed Your lovingkindness and Your truth From the great assembly.
- Matthew 3:2 And (John the Baptist) saying, <u>Repent</u> ye: for the <u>kingdom</u> of <u>heaven</u> is at hand.
- Psalms 40:11-15 Do not withhold Your tender mercies from me, O LORD; Let Your lovingkindness and Your truth continually preserve me. 12 For

innumerable evils have surrounded me; My iniquities have overtaken me, so that I am not able to look up; They are more than the hairs of my head; Therefore my heart fails me. 13 Be pleased, O LORD, to deliver me; O LORD, make haste to help me! 14 Let them be ashamed and brought to mutual confusion Who seek to destroy my life; Let them be driven backward and brought to dishonor who wish me evil. 15 Let them be confounded because of their shame, Who say to me, Aha, aha!

Mark 11:9 And they that went before, and they that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna; <u>Blessed</u> is he that <u>cometh</u> in the <u>name</u> of the <u>Lord</u>:

Warned of miss-using David's Imprekatory Psalms.

Psalms 40:16,17 Let all those who seek You rejoice and be glad in You; Let such as love Your salvation say continually, The LORD be magnified! 17 But I am poor and needy; Yet the Lord thinks upon me. You are my help and my deliverer; Do not delay, O my God.

Many times in the storms on Sea Galalea the disciples called on the Lord for help.

Romans 7:18 For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells; for to will is present with me, but how to perform what is good I do not find.

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Romans 14:12 So then each of us shall give account of himself to God.

Genesis 3:12 Then the man said, The woman whom You gave *to be* with me, she gave me of the tree, and I ate.

Romans 7:19 For the good that I will to do, I do not do; but the evil I will not to do, that I practice. 20 Now if I do what I will not to do, it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells in me.

Hebrews 9 Summarized of how the law can't help man.

Romans 7:24 O <u>wretched</u> <u>man</u> that I <u>am</u>! who shall <u>deliver</u> me from the body of this death?

Romans 7:21 I find then a law, that evil is present with me, the one who wills to do good.

Matthew 10:37 He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.

Romans 7:22,23 For I delight in the law of God according to the inward man. 23 But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

23 (Message) but it's pretty obvious that not all of me joins in that delight. Parts of me covertly rebel, and just when I least expect it, they take charge.

Romans 7:24 O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body

of death?

- 24 (Message) I've tried everything and nothing helps. I'm at the end of my rope. Is there no one who can do anything for me? Isn't that the real question?
- Romans 7:25 I thank God--through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, with the mind I myself serve the law of God, but with the flesh the law of sin.
- 25 (Message) The answer, thank God, is that Jesus Christ can and does. He acted to set things right in this life of contradictions where I want to serve God with all my heart and mind, but am pulled by the influence of sin to do something totally different.
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

More Service Notes:

- Psalms 40:1-6 To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David. I waited patiently for the LORD; And He inclined to me, And heard my cry. 2 He also brought me up out of a horrible pit, Out of the miry clay, And set my feet upon a rock, And established my steps. 3 He has put a new song in my mouth--Praise to our God; Many will see it and fear, And will trust in the LORD. 4 Blessed is that man who makes the LORD his trust, And does not respect the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies. 5 Many, O LORD my God, are Your wonderful works Which You have done; And Your thoughts toward us Cannot be recounted to You in order; If I would declare and speak of them, They are more than can be numbered. 6 Sacrifice and offering You did not desire; My ears You have opened. Burnt offering and sin offering You did not require.
- Romans 7:14-17 For we know that the law is spiritual, but I am carnal, sold under sin. 15 For what I am doing, I do not understand. For what I will to do, that I do not practice; but what I hate, that I do. 16 If, then, I do what I will not to do, I agree with the law that it is good. 17 But now, it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells in me.
