When God Calls Gentiles To Worship His Son - Matthew 2A

- Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
- John 15:26 But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:

- Bethlehem the house of bread John 6:48 I am that bread of life.
- Luke 2 Summarized of the shepherds in the fields when the angels announced Jesus' birth.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what *is* that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Acts 2 At the day of Pentecost, many people from around the world were in Jerusalem.

- Concise Bible Dictionary Magi This is the Greek word in #Matthew 2:1-16 which is translated 'wise men' in the A.V. They had come from the East, and inquired for one who was born King of the Jews, for they had seen His star in the East, and had come with their gifts to do Him homage. Though magicians and magi are often classed together, they are not necessarily the same. Philo describes the magi as men who gave themselves to the

study of nature and contemplation of the divine perfections, worthy of being the counsellors of kings. In this sense Daniel was called master of the 'magicians,' but which others translate as 'scribes.' #Daniel 4:9. How the magi connected the star with 'the King of the Jews' is not known. By the scattering of the Jews they may have heard of the prophecy of Balaam {#Numbers 24:17} or of Daniel's prophecy. God who warned them in a dream not to return to Herod, may have in the same way led them to associate the above prophecies with the appearance of the star. God thus raised up from the Gentiles a testimony as to the 'Holy Child' in the midst of Jerusalem, though all there were troubled at the announcement.

- Daniel 2 Summarized of the magicians not able to interpret the king's dream. V7 They answered again and said, Let the king tell his servants the dream, and we will shew the interpretation of it.
- Matthew 2:2 saying, Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to worship Him.
- Numbers 24:17 (Balaam) I see Him, but not now; I behold Him, but not near; A Star shall come out of Jacob; A Scepter shall rise out of Israel, And batter the brow of Moab, And destroy all the sons of tumult.
- Every time Balaam tried to curse Isrealites, God turned them unto blessings.
- Daniel 4:9 Belteshazzar, chief of the magicians, because I know that the Spirit of the Holy God is in you, and no secret troubles you, explain to me the visions of my dream that I have seen, and its interpretation.
- Summarized of the Queen of Sheba visiting Silomon.
- Matthew 2:3 When Herod the king heard this, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him.
- Matthew 21:9 And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed *is* he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest.
- John 12:19 The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, Perceive ye how ye prevail nothing? behold, the world is gone after him.
- John 11:50 Nor consider that it is expedient for us, that one man should die for the people, and that the whole nation perish not.
