

Jesus Christ - Drawing Near With A True Heart - Hebrews 10C

Hebrews 10:19-39 - V19-22 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, 20 by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, 21 and having a High Priest over the house of God, 22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

Hebrews 10:19 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest (the Holy of Holies) by the blood of Jesus,

Esther 4:16 Go, gather all the Jews who are present in Shushan, and fast for me; neither eat nor drink for three days, night or day. My maids and I will fast likewise. And so I will go to the king, which *is* against the law; and if I perish, I perish!

Leviticus 10:1 And Nadab and Abihu, the sons of Aaron, took either of them his censer, and put fire therein, and put incense thereon, and offered strange fire before the LORD, which he commanded them not. 2 And there went out fire from the LORD, and devoured them, and they died before the LORD.

Hebrews 10:20,21 by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, 21 and having a High Priest over the house of God,

Explained of the priests not breaking bones of the sacrifice.

John 19:36 For these things were done that the Scripture should be fulfilled, Not *one* of His bones shall be broken.

Hebrews 10:22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

Exodus 6:7 And I will take you to me for a people, and I will be to you a God: and ye shall know that I *am* the LORD your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.

Luke 14 Summarized the excuses to not attend the Wedding feast. V23 Then the master said to the servant, Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel *them* to come in, that my house may be filled.

Acts 5 Referred to Annanias & Saphira.

Acts 9:31 Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.

2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity

every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Acts 19:4 Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus.

John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

Hebrews 10:23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.

John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it* more abundantly.

Romans 12:21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

Hebrews 4:15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all *points* tempted as *we are*, yet without sin.

2 Corinthians 12 Referred to Paul given all sufficient grace. **V9** And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

Hebrews 10:24 And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works,

John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. **35** By this shall all *men* know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.

Mark 8:2,3 I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now continued with Me three days and have nothing to eat. **3** And if I send them away hungry to their own houses, they will faint on the way; for some of them have come from afar.

Hebrews 10:25 not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.

Revelation 2 & 3 Referred to the letters to the Churches.

Revelation 2:4 Nevertheless I have *somewhat* against thee, because thou hast left thy first love.

Matthew 24:12 And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any *man* pluck them out of my hand. **29** My Father, which gave *them* me, is greater than all; and no *man* is able to pluck *them* out of my Father's hand.

Hebrews 5:14-6:1 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, *even* those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil. 6:1 Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God,

John 14:30 Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in me.

Hebrews 10:26 For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins,

Matthew 26 Summarized of Peter denying the Lord.

Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and *from* fornication, and *from* things strangled, and *from* blood.

Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?

Hebrews 10:27 but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries.

John 9:3 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.

James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

Hebrews 10:28 Anyone who has rejected Moses' law dies without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses.

John 8:11 She said, "No one, Lord." And Jesus said to her, "Neither do I condemn you; go and sin no more."

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Hebrews 10:29 Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace?

John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Did I not choose you, the twelve, and one of you is a devil? Acts simon magus buy gift HS - P-child devil

Hebrews 10:30 For we know Him who said, Vengeance is Mine, I will repay, says the Lord. And again, The LORD will judge His people.

Referred to:

Deuteronomy 32:35 Vengeance is Mine, and recompense; Their foot shall slip in due time; For the day of their calamity is at hand, And the things to come hasten upon them.

Psalms 94:1 O LORD God, to whom vengeance belongs--O God, to whom vengeance belongs, shine forth!

2 Samuel 13 Summarized of Absalom & Amnon

Hebrews 10:31 It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

Luke 16 Summarized of the Parable of Rich man & Lazarus.

Revelation 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

Hebrews 10:32-39 But recall the former days in which, after you were illuminated, you endured a great struggle with sufferings: 33 partly while you were made a spectacle both by reproaches and tribulations, and partly while you became companions of those who were so treated; 34 for you had compassion on me in my chains, and joyfully accepted the plundering of your goods, knowing that you have a better and an enduring possession for yourselves in heaven. 35 Therefore do not cast away your confidence, which has great reward. 36 For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise: 37 For yet a little while, And He who is coming will come and will not tarry. 38 Now the just shall live by faith; But if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him. 39 But we are not of those who draw back to perdition, but of those who believe to the saving of the soul.

Revelation 19 Referred to Jesus' return.

Referred to:

Habakkuk 2:4 Behold the proud, His soul is not upright in him; But the just shall live by his faith.

Romans 1:17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, The just shall live by faith.

Galatians 3:11 But that no one is justified by the law in the sight of God *is* evident, for the just shall live by faith.

Hebrews 10:38 Now the just shall live by faith; But if *anyone* draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him.

2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.
