Jesus Christ - Examples of Faith - Hebrews 11B

- Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
- Genesis 2:15 Then the LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to tend and keep it.
- Genesis 3:8 And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden.
- Genesis 2:17 but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.
- Hebrews 11:4 By faith Abel offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, through which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts; and through it he being dead still speaks.
- Genesis 4:2 Then she bore again, this time his brother Abel. Now Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground.
- Genesis 4:3-5 And in the process of time it came to pass that Cain brought an offering of the fruit of the ground to the LORD. 4 Abel also brought of the firstborn of his flock and of their fat. And the LORD respected Abel and his offering, 5 but He did not respect Cain and his offering. And Cain was very angry, and his countenance fell.
- Genesis 4:7,8 If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin lies at the door. And its desire *is* for you, but you should rule over it. 8 Now Cain talked with Abel his brother; and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and killed him.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Habakkuk 2:4 Behold the proud, His soul is not upright in him; But the just shall live by his faith.
- Romans 1:17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, The just shall live by faith.
- Strongs 4102 pistiv pistis pis'-tis from 3982; TDNT-6:174,849;
- AV-faith 239, assurance 1, believe + 1537 1, belief 1, them that believe 1, fidelity 1; 244
- conviction of the truth of anything, belief; in the NT of a conviction or belief respecting man's relationship to God and divine things, generally with the included idea of trust and holy fervour born of faith and joined with it

- 1a) relating to God 1a1) the conviction that God exists and is the creator and ruler of all things, the provider and bestower of eternal salvation through Christ
- 1b) relating to Christ 1b1) a strong and welcome conviction or belief that Jesus is the Messiah, through whom we obtain eternal salvation in the kingdom of God
- 1c) the religious beliefs of Christians
- 1d) belief with the predominate idea of trust (or confidence) whether in God or in Christ, springing from faith in the same
- 2) fidelity, faithfulness 2a) the character of one who can be relied on Our Lord Jesus is the best example to follow.
- Acts 5:29 But Peter and the *other* apostles answered and said: We ought to obey God rather than men.
- Hebrews 11:38 of whom the world was not worthy. They wandered in deserts and mountains, *in* dens and caves of the earth.
- Luke 11:33 No man, when he hath lighted a candle, putteth *it* in a secret place, neither under a bushel, but on a candlestick, that they which come in may see the light.
- John 3:19 And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.
- John 11:48-50 If we let Him alone like this, everyone will believe in Him, and the Romans will come and take away both our place and nation. 49 And one of them, Caiaphas, being high priest that year, said to them, You know nothing at all, 50 nor do you consider that it is expedient for us that one man should die for the people, and not that the whole nation should perish it is finished
- 2 Timothy 2:15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
- Hebrews 11:5 <u>By faith</u> Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, and was not found, because God had taken him; for before he was taken he had this testimony, that he pleased God.
- Genesis 5:24 And Enoch walked with God; and he *was* not, for God took him.
- Acts 13:22 And when He had removed him, He raised up for them David as king, to whom also He gave testimony and said, I have found David the *son* of Jesse, a man after My *own* heart, who will do all My will.
- Genesis 6:5 Then the LORD saw that the wickedness of man *was* great in the earth, and *that* every intent of the thoughts of his heart *was* only evil continually.
- 1 Samuel 15 Summarized of Samuel addressing Saul sinning concerning the Amalekites.

- Psalms 51 Referred to David repenting of sin.
- Esther Summarized of the trouble Haman (Saul's descendant) tried to do to the Jews.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. 10 There shall not be found among you...
- Joshua 9 Summarized of the Gibeonites tricking Joshua.
- 1 Peter 3:1,2,4 Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives; 2 While they behold your chaste conversation coupled with fear. 4 But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Hebrews 11:6 But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.
- Mark 8:1,2,6 In those days, the multitude being very great and having nothing to eat, Jesus called His disciples to Him and said to them, 2 I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now continued with Me three days and have nothing to eat. 6 So He commanded the multitude to sit down on the ground. And He took the seven loaves and gave thanks, broke them and gave them to His disciples to set before them; and they set them before the multitude.
- Acts 19 Summarized of the account of the seven sons of Sceva. V15 And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?
- Mark 16:14-18 Later He appeared to the eleven as they sat at the table; and He rebuked their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they did not believe those who had seen Him after He had risen.
- John 16:8 And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Luke 8:12 Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Mark 16:15 And He said to them, Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.

- Luke 23:4 So Pilate said to the chief priests and the crowd, I find no fault in this Man.
- Mark 16:16 He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.
- John 3:17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.
- Acts 15:1 And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, *and said*, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.
- Matthew 12 Summarized of Jesus' views on the sabbath. V8 For the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day.
- John 14:2 In My Father's house are many mansions; if *it were* not *so*, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
- John 10:28,29 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any *man* pluck them out of my hand. 29 My Father, which gave *them* me, is greater than all; and no *man* is able to pluck *them* out of my Father's hand.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.
- In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just healing.
- John 9:2 Jesus answered, Neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.
- James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:
- Exodus 24:8 And Moses took the blood, sprinkled *it* on the people, and said, This is the blood of the covenant which the LORD has made with you according to all these words.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
