Jesus Christ - Abraham Saved By Faith - Hebrews 11E

- Hebrews 11:8-19 V8 By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going.
- Acts 7:1-4 Then the high priest said, Are these things so? 2 And he said, Brethren and fathers, listen: The God of glory (Lord Jesus) appeared to our father Abraham when he was in Mesopotamia, before he dwelt in Haran, 3 and said to him, Get out of your country and from your relatives, and come to a land that I will show you. 4 Then he came out of the land of the Chaldeans and dwelt in Haran. And from there, when his father was dead, He moved him to this land in which you now dwell.
- Hebrews 11:2 And he said, Brethren and fathers, listen: The God of glory (Lord Jesus) appeared to our father Abraham when he was in Mesopotamia, before he dwelt in Haran,
- Mesopotamian key gods were the Moon god & goddess.
- Hebrews 11:3,4 and said to him, Get out of your country and from your relatives, and come to a land that I will show you. 4 Then he came out of the land of the Chaldeans and dwelt in Haran. And from there, when his father was dead, He moved him to this land in which you now dwell.
- Haran was the second place of the Moon god. Plus Abram took his family along.
- Exodus 32:26 then Moses stood in the entrance of the camp, and said, Whoever is on the LORD'S side come to me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together to him.
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- 1 Samuel 15 Summarized of King Saul also only did half of God's commands.
- Esther Summarized of Haman the Agagite Saul's descendant afflicted God's people.
- Acts 9 Summarized of Saul/Paul's Conversion account.
- Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
- Luke 17:5 And the apostles said to the Lord, Increase our faith.
- Mark 9:24 Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears,

- Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!
- Hebrews 5:14-6:1 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil. 6:1 Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God,
- Genesis 12 Summarized of Abram & Sarai going to Egypt.
- Matthew 26 Summarized of Peter denying Jesus
- Hebrews 11:9 By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as in a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise;
- Hebrews 3:13 But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day; lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.
- Revelation 18:4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.
- Exodus 6:7 And I will take you to me for a people, and I will be to you a God: and ye shall know that I am the LORD your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
- Matthew 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- 2 Corinthians 6:17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean *thing*; and I will receive you, 18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you? unless indeed you are disqualified.
- Psalms 19:1 The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.
- Summarized of our Lord Jesus leaving Heaven to live in the world of that day.
- Matthew 10:37 He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
- Hebrews 11:10 for he waited for the city which has foundations, whose builder and maker is God.
- Genesis Summarized of the Jesus & angels visiting Abraham Judging Sodom etc & promising of the son to come.
- Luke 16 Summarized of the Parable of the rich man & Lazarus. "Father Abraham"

- Hebrews 11:11 By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past the age, because she judged Him faithful who had promised.
- Genesis 18:12 Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, After I am waxed old shall I have pleasure, my lord being old also?Summarized of Hagar & Ishmael.
- Matthew 7:14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Galatians 5:22,23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.
- Hebrews 5:14 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.
- Hebrews 11:12,13 Therefore from one man, and him as good as dead, were born as many as the stars of the sky in multitude innumerable as the sand which is by the seashore. 13 These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off were assured of them, embraced them and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.
- Hebrews 4:6 Seeing therefore it remaineth that some must enter therein, and they to whom it was first preached entered not in (Promised Land) because of unbelief:
- Exodus 13:19 And Moses took the bones of Joseph with him: for he had straitly sworn the children of Israel, saying, God will surely visit you; and ye shall carry up my bones away hence with you.
- Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- Hebrews 11:14 For those who say such things declare plainly that they seek a homeland.
- 2 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord.
- Hebrews 11:15 And truly if they had called to mind that country from which they had come out, they would have had opportunity to return.
- Numbers 14:4 And they said one to another, Let us make a captain, and let us return into Egypt.
- Number 13 Summarized of when spys returned the people cried all night. Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the

judgment,

- Hebrews 11:16 But now they desire a better, that is, a heavenly country. Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God, for He has prepared a city for them.
- Revelation 19 Summarized of the final return of Jesus.
- Hebrews 11:17 By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises offered up his only begotten son, Genesis 22 Summarized of Abraham tested by God.
- Hebrews 11:18,19 of whom it was said, In Isaac your seed shall be called, 19 concluding that God was able to raise him up, even from the dead, from which he also received him in a figurative sense.
- Romans 4:9 Does this blessedness then come upon the circumcised only, or upon the uncircumcised also? For we say that faith was accounted to Abraham for righteousness.
- Mark 16:14-18 14 Later He appeared to the eleven as they sat at the table; and He rebuked their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they did not believe those who had seen Him after He had risen. 15 And He said to them, Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. 17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.
- Luke 10:27 So he answered and said, You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself.
- 1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.

- Matthew 4:19 Then He said to them, <u>Follow Me</u>, and I will make you fishers of men.
- Matthew 8:22 But Jesus said to him, <u>Follow Me</u>, and let the dead bury their own dead.
- Matthew 9:9 As Jesus passed on from there, He saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, <u>Follow Me</u>. So he arose and followed Him.

- Mark 10:21 Then Jesus, looking at him, loved him, and said to him, One thing you lack: Go your way, sell whatever you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, take up the cross, and follow Me.
- Luke 5:27 After these things He went out and saw a tax collector named Levi, sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, <u>Follow</u> <u>Me</u>.
- Luke 9:23 Then He said to *them* all, If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and <u>follow</u> <u>Me</u>.
- Luke 9:59 Then He said to another, <u>Follow Me</u>. But he said, Lord, let me first go and bury my father.
- Luke 18:22 So when Jesus heard these things, He said to him, You still lack one thing. Sell all that you have and distribute to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, <u>follow</u> <u>Me</u>.
- John 1:43 The following day Jesus wanted to go to Galilee, and He found Philip and said to him, <u>Follow</u> <u>Me</u>.
- John 10:27 My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.
- John 12:26 If anyone serves Me, let him <u>follow</u> <u>Me</u>; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him *My* Father will honor.
- John 13:36 Simon Peter said to Him, Lord, where are You going? Jesus answered him, Where I am going you cannot <u>follow Me</u> now, but you shall <u>follow Me</u> afterward.
- John 21:19 This He spoke, signifying by what death he would glorify God. And when He had spoken this, He said to him, <u>Follow</u> <u>Me</u>.
- John 21:22 Jesus said to him, If I will that he remain till I come, what *is that* to you? You follow Me.
