Jesus Christ - Moses Sufferings And Afflictions - Hebrews 11G

- John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
- Many times Moses pleaded for the Israelites interceding with God.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; 2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
- Hebrews 11:23-31 V23 By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden three months by his parents, because they saw he was a beautiful child; and they were not afraid of the king's command.
- Isaiah 43:2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; And through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, Nor shall the flame scorch you.
- Exodus 2:1-4 And a man of the house of Levi went and took as wife a daughter of Levi. 2 So the woman conceived and bore a son. And when she saw that he was a beautiful child, she hid him three months. 3 But when she could no longer hide him, she took an ark of bulrushes for him, daubed it with asphalt and pitch, put the child in it, and laid it in the reeds by the river's bank. 4 And his sister stood afar off, to know what would be done to him.
- Summarized of God calling the youngest son David to be king.
- Summarized of the daughter of Pharaoh raising Moses & his own mother nursed him.
- John 19:11 Jesus answered (Pilate), You could have no power at all against Me unless it had been given you from above. Therefore the one who delivered Me to you has the greater sin.
- Hebrews 11:24 By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter,
- **Summarized of Moses life.**
- Exodus 2:14 Then he said, Who made you a prince and a judge over us? Do you intend to kill me as you killed the Egyptian? So Moses feared and said, Surely this thing is known!
- John 15:20 Remember the word that I said to you, A servant is not greater than his master. If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you. If

- they kept My word, they will keep yours also.
- Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment,
- Exodus 7:16 And you shall say to him, The LORD God of the Hebrews has sent me to you, saying, <u>Let My people go, that they may serve Me</u> in the wilderness; but indeed, until now you would not hear!
- Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spoke to Moses, Go to Pharaoh and say to him, Thus says the LORD: <u>Let My people go, that they may serve Me</u>.
- Exodus 8:20 And the LORD said to Moses, Rise early in the morning and stand before Pharaoh as he comes out to the water. Then say to him, Thus says the LORD: Let My people go, that they may serve Me.
- Exodus 9:1 Then the LORD said to Moses, Go in to Pharaoh and tell him, Thus says the LORD God of the Hebrews: <u>Let My people go, that they may serve Me</u>.
- Exodus 9:13 Then the LORD said to Moses, Rise early in the morning and stand before Pharaoh, and say to him, Thus says the LORD God of the Hebrews: Let My people go, that they may serve Me,
- Exodus 10:3 So Moses and Aaron came in to Pharaoh and said to him, Thus says the LORD God of the Hebrews: How long will you refuse to humble yourself before Me? Let My people go, that they may serve Me.
- Hebrews 11:25,26 choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, 26 esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt; for he looked to the reward.
- Summarized of Job's afflictions.
- Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the <u>LORD gave</u>, and the <u>LORD hath taken away</u>; <u>blessed</u> be the name of the LORD.
- Psalms 113:2 Blessed be the name of the LORD from this time forth and for evermore.
- Daniel 9:2,3 In the first year of his reign I Daniel understood by books the number of the years, whereof the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah the prophet, that he would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem. 3 And I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes:
- Colossians 3:17 And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.
- Jonah 2:9 But I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; I will

pay that that I have vowed. Salvation is of the LORD.

- Exodus 4:24-26 And it came to pass on the way, at the encampment, that the LORD met him and sought to kill him. 25 Then Zipporah took a sharp stone and cut off the foreskin of her son and cast it at Moses' feet, and said, Surely you are a husband of blood to me! 26 So He let him go. Then she said, You are a husband of blood! because of the circumcision.
- Ezekiel 22:30 And I sought for a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none.
- Hebrews 11:27 By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured as seeing Him who is invisible.
- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.
- Hebrews 11:28 By faith he kept the Passover and the sprinkling of blood, lest he who destroyed the firstborn should touch them.
- Exodus 12:22 And ye shall take a bunch of hyssop, and dip it in the blood that is in the bason, and strike the lintel and the two side posts with the blood that is in the bason; and none of you shall go out at the door of his house until the morning.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Hebrews 11:29 By faith they passed through the Red Sea as by dry land, whereas the Egyptians, attempting to do so, were drowned.
- Luke 4:9-11 Summarized V12 And Jesus answering said unto him, It is said, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.

Summarized of Pharoah following into the dry sea & died.

Acts 19 Summarized of the 7 sons of Sceva.

Hebrews 11:30 By faith the walls of Jericho fell down after they were encircled for seven days.

Joshua 2:1-7 and Joshua 6:1-5 summarized.

Summarized of mocking Noah & the flood.

Hebrews 11:31 By faith the harlot Rahab did not perish with those who did not believe, when she had received the spies with peace.

- Joshua 2:9 And she (Rahab) said unto the men, I know that the LORD hath given you the land, and that your terror is fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land faint because of you.
- Acts 15:20 but that we write to them to abstain from things polluted by idols, from sexual immorality, from things strangled, and from blood. Ruth Summarized of Ruth in Lineage of Jesus.
- Ruth 1:16 But Ruth said: Entreat me not to leave you, Or to turn back from following after you; For wherever you go, I will go; And wherever you lodge, I will lodge; Your people shall be my people, And your God, my God.
- Psalms 84:10 For a day in Your courts *is* better than a thousand. I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God Than dwell in the tents of wickedness.
- Matthew 5:10-12 Blessed are those who are <u>persecuted for righteousness'</u> <u>sake</u>, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 11 Blessed are you when they <u>revile and persecute you</u>, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for <u>My sake</u>. 12 Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great *is* your reward in heaven, for so they <u>persecuted</u> the prophets who were before you.
- Matthew 13:21 yet he has no root in himself, but endures only for a while. For when tribulation or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he stumbles.
- Matthew 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.
- Acts 7:24,25 And seeing one of *them* suffer wrong, he defended and avenged him who was oppressed, and struck down the Egyptian. 25 For he supposed that his brethren would have understood that God would deliver them by his hand, but they did not understand.
- Acts 20:23 except that the Holy Spirit testifies in every city, saying that chains and tribulations await me.
- 2 Corinthians 12:6-9 For though I would desire to glory, I shall not be a fool; for I will say the truth: but now I forbear, lest any man should think of me above that which he seeth me to be, or that he heareth of me. 7 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. 8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. 9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my

infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

- Deuteronomy 3: 25-27 I pray thee, let me go over, and see the good land that is beyond Jordan, that goodly mountain, and Lebanon. 26 But the LORD was wroth with me for your sakes, and would not hear me: and the LORD said unto me, Let it suffice thee; speak no more unto me of this matter. 27 Get thee up into the top of Pisgah, and lift up thine eyes westward, and northward, and southward, and eastward, and behold it with thine eyes: for thou shalt not go over this Jordan.
- Moses was the Law giver, but Joshua was the saviour to enter the Promised Land.
- Acts 20:24 But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God.
- Esther 4:14 For if thou altogether holdest thy peace at this time, then shall there enlargement and deliverance arise to the Jews from another place; but thou and thy father's house shall be destroyed: and who knoweth whether thou art come to the kingdom for such a time as this?
- Romans 5:3 And not only *that*, but we also <u>glory in tribulations</u>, <u>knowing</u> that tribulation produces perseverance;
- Romans 8:17 and if children, then heirs heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we <u>suffer with *Him*</u>, that we may also be glorified together.

Summarized of David being chased by King Saul.

Romans 8:18 For I consider that the <u>sufferings of this present time</u> are not worthy *to be compared* with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

Referred to 2 Corinthians 11 Paul's In Perils List.

Hebrews 12:4 You have not yet resisted to bloodshed, striving against sin.

Romans 8:35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *Shall* tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

Romans 8:36-39 As it is written: For Your sake we are <u>killed</u> all day long; We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. 37 Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. 38 For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, 39 nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Colossians 1:24 I now <u>rejoice in my sufferings</u> for you, and fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ, for the sake of His body, which is the church,

More Service Notes:

- 2 Thessalonians 1:3-6 We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is fitting, because your faith grows exceedingly, and the love of every one of you all abounds toward each other, 4 so that we ourselves boast of you among the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that you endure, 5 which is manifest evidence of the righteous judgment of God, that you may be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you also suffer; 6 since it is a righteous thing with God to repay with tribulation those who trouble you,
- 2 Timothy 1:8 Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner, but share with me in the sufferings for the gospel according to the power of God,
- 2 Timothy 2:10 Therefore I endure all things for the sake of the elect, that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.
- 2 Timothy 3:11,12 persecutions, afflictions, which happened to me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra what persecutions I endured. And out of *them* all the Lord delivered me.
- 2 Timothy 3:12 Yes, and all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution.
- 1 Peter 1:6,7 In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, 7 that the genuineness of your faith, *being* much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ,
- 1 Peter 4:12-16 Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; 13 but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy. 14 If you are reproached for the name of Christ, blessed *are you*, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. On their part He is blasphemed, but on your part He is glorified. 15 But let none of you suffer as a murderer, a thief, an evildoer, or as a busybody in other people's matters. 16 Yet if *anyone suffers* as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in this matter.

- 1 Peter 2:10 who once *were* not a people but *are* now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.
- Luke 16:25 But Abraham said, Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things; but now he is comforted and you are tormented.
- Joshua 2:1-7 Now Joshua the son of Nun sent out two men from Acacia Grove to spy secretly, saying, Go, view the land, especially Jericho. So they went, and came to the house of a harlot named Rahab, and lodged there. 2 And it was told the king of Jericho, saying, Behold, men have come here tonight from the children of Israel to search out the country. 3 So the king of Jericho sent to Rahab, saying, Bring out the men who have come to you, who have entered your house, for they have come to search out all the country. 4 Then the woman took the two men and hid them. So she said, Yes, the men came to me, but I did not know where they were from. 5 And it happened as the gate was being shut, when it was dark, that the men went out. Where the men went I do not know; pursue them quickly, for you may overtake them. 6 (But she had brought them up to the roof and hidden them with the stalks of flax, which she had laid in order on the roof.) 7 Then the men pursued them by the road to the Jordan, to the fords. And as soon as those who pursued them had gone out, they shut the gate.
- Joshua 6:1-5 Now Jericho was securely shut up because of the children of Israel; none went out, and none came in. 2 And the LORD said to Joshua: See! I have given Jericho into your hand, its king, and the mighty men of valor. 3 You shall march around the city, all you men of war; you shall go all around the city once. This you shall do six days. 4 And seven priests shall bear seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark. But the seventh day you shall march around the city seven times, and the priests shall blow the trumpets. 5 It shall come to pass, when they make a long blast with the ram's horn, and when you hear the sound of the trumpet, that all the people shall shout with a great shout; then the wall of the city will fall down flat. And the people shall go up every man straight before him.
