## <u> Dreams And Visions - Godly Or Not - Matthew 2D</u>

Matthew 1:20 But while he thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit.

Luke 8 referred to the Gadarene Demoniac set free by Jesus.

Matthew 2:19-23 But when Herod was dead, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt, 20 saying, Arise, take the young Child and His mother, and go to the land of Israel, for those who sought the young Child's life are dead. 21 Then he arose, took the young Child and His mother, and came into the land of Israel. 22 But when he heard that Archelaus was reigning over Judea instead of his father Herod, he was afraid to go there. And being warned by God in a dream, he turned aside into the region of Galilee. 23 And he came and dwelt in a city called Nazareth, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophets, He shall be called a Nazarene.

Joel 2:28 And it shall come to pass afterward That I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your old men shall <u>dream dreams</u>, Your young men shall see <u>visions</u>.

Genesis 28:12 Referred to Jacob's Ladder dream.

Acts 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, That I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your young men shall see <u>visions</u>, Your old men shall <u>dream</u> <u>dreams</u>.

Acts 9 Referred to Jesus appearing to Saul/Paul on the road to Damascus. Matthew 2:19 But when Herod was dead, behold, <u>an angel of the Lord appeared in a dream</u> to Joseph in Egypt,

- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.
- Matthew 2:20 saying, Arise, take the young Child and His mother, and go to the land of Israel, for those who sought the young Child's life are dead.
- Romans 12:19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the

Lord.

- Matthew 2:21-23 Then he arose, took the young Child and His mother, and came into the land of Israel. 22 But when he heard that Archelaus was reigning over Judea instead of his father Herod, he was afraid to go there. And being warned by God in a dream, he turned aside into the region of Galilee. 23 And he came and dwelt in a city called Nazareth, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophets, He shall be called a Nazarene.
- Genesis 15:1 After these things the word of the LORD came to Abram in a <u>vision</u>, saying, Do not be afraid, Abram. I *am* your shield, your exceedingly great reward.
- Genesis 20:3 But God came to Abimelech in a <u>dream</u> by night, and said to him, Indeed you *are* a dead man because of the woman whom you have taken, for she *is* a man's wife.
- Genesis 28:12 Then he (Jacob) <u>dreamed</u>, and behold, a ladder *was* set up on the earth, and its top reached to heaven; and there the angels of God were ascending and descending on it.
- Luke 16 Referred to the Parable of the Rich Man and Lazarus.
- Genesis 31:10 And it happened, at the time when the flocks conceived, that I (Jacob) lifted my eyes and saw in a <u>dream</u>, and behold, the rams which leaped upon the flocks *were* streaked, speckled, and gray-spotted.
- Genesis 31:11 Then the <u>Angel of God</u> spoke to me in a <u>dream</u>, saying, Jacob. And I said, Here I am.
- Genesis 31:24 But God had come to Laban the Syrian in a <u>dream</u> by night, and said to him, Be careful that you speak to Jacob neither good nor bad.
- Genesis 37:5 Now Joseph had a <u>dream</u>, and he told *it* to his brothers; and they hated him even more.
- Genesis 40:5 Then the butler and the baker of the king of Egypt, who were confined in the prison, had a <u>dream</u>, both of them, each man's <u>dream</u> in one night *and* each man's <u>dream</u> with its *own* interpretation.
- Acts 8:39 And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.
- Genesis 41:1 Then it came to pass, at the end of two full years, that Pharaoh had a <u>dream</u>; and behold, he stood by the river.
- Genesis 46:2,3 Then God spoke to Israel in the <u>visions of the night</u>, and said, Jacob, Jacob! And he said, Here I am. 3 And he said, I am God, the

- God of thy father: fear not to go down into Egypt; for I will there make of thee a great nation:
- Numbers 12:6 Then He said, Hear now My words: If there is a prophet among you, *I*, the LORD, make Myself known to him in a <u>vision</u>; I speak to him in a dream.
- Deuteronomy 13:1 If there arises among you a prophet or a <u>dreamer</u> of <u>dreams</u>, and he gives you a sign or a wonder,
- Deuteronomy 13:3 you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams, for the LORD your God is testing you to know whether you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.
- Deuteronomy 13:5 But that prophet or that <u>dreamer of dreams</u> shall be put to death, because he has spoken in order to turn *you* away from the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt and redeemed you from the house of bondage, to entice you from the way in which the LORD your God commanded you to walk. So you shall put away the evil from your midst.
- Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- Acts 15:20 But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood.
- Deuteronomy 18:9-14 Summarized V10,11 There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, 11 Or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer.
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 Do not be deceived: Evil company corrupts good habits.
- Judges 7:13 And when Gideon had come, there was a man telling a <u>dream</u> to his companion. He said, I have had a <u>dream</u>: *To my* surprise, a loaf of barley bread tumbled into the camp of Midian; it came to a tent and struck it so that it fell and overturned, and the tent collapsed.
- Judges 7:15 And so it was, when Gideon heard the telling of the <u>dream</u> and its interpretation, that he worshiped. He returned to the camp of Israel, and said, Arise, for the LORD has delivered the camp of Midian into your hand.
- Judges 6 Referred to Gideon testing if God with the fleece.
- 1 Samuel 3:15 So Samuel lay down until morning, and opened the doors of

- the house of the LORD. And Samuel was afraid to tell Eli the vision.
- Prophet told Eli in 1 Samuel 2:29 Wherefore kick ye have commanded in my habitation; and honourest thy sons above me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel my people?
- 1 Samuel 28:6 And when Saul inquired of the LORD, the LORD did not answer him, either by <u>dreams</u> or by Urim or by the prophets.
- 2 Samuel 7:17 According to all these words and according to all this <u>vision</u>, so Nathan spoke to David.
- 1 Kings 3:5 At Gibeon the LORD appeared to Solomon in a <u>dream</u> by night; and God said, Ask! What shall I give you?
- 1 Chronicles 17:15 According to all these words and according to all this <u>vision</u>, so Nathan spoke to David.
- 2 Chronicles 26:5 He sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God; and as long as he sought the LORD, God made him prosper.
- 2 Chronicles 32:32 Now the rest of the acts of Hezekiah, and his goodness, indeed they *are* written in the <u>vision</u> of Isaiah the prophet, the son of Amoz, *and* in the book of the kings of Judah and Israel.
- Isaiah 6 Referred to Isaiah seeing the Throne of God.
- Job 7:14 Then You scare me with dreams and terrify me with visions,
- Ecclesiastes 5:7 For in the multitude of <u>dreams</u> and many words *there is* also vanity. But fear God.
- Isaiah 1:1 The <u>vision of Isaiah</u> the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, *and* Hezekiah, kings of Judah.
- Isaiah 28:7 But they also have erred through wine, And through intoxicating drink are out of the way; The priest and the prophet have erred through intoxicating drink, They are swallowed up by wine, They are out of the way through intoxicating drink; They err in vision, they stumble in judgment.
- Jeremiah 14:14 And the LORD said to me, The <u>prophets prophesy lies in My name</u>. I have not sent them, commanded them, nor spoken to them; they prophesy to you a <u>false vision</u>, <u>divination</u>, <u>a worthless thing</u>, <u>and the deceit of their heart</u>.
- Matthew 17:9 Now as they came down from the mountain, Jesus commanded them, saying, Tell the <u>vision</u> to no one until the Son of Man is risen from the dead. (Similar to Mark 9.)
- Matthew 27:19 While he was sitting on the judgment seat, his wife sent to

- him, saying, Have nothing to do with that just Man, for I have suffered many things today in a <u>dream</u> because of Him.
- Luke 1:22 But when he (Zacharias) came out, he could not speak to them; and they perceived that he had seen a <u>vision</u> in the temple, for he beckoned to them and remained speechless.
- Acts 9:10 Now there was a certain disciple at Damascus named Ananias; and to him the <u>Lord said in a vision</u>, Ananias. And he said, Here I am, Lord.
- Acts 9:12 And in a <u>vision</u> he (Saul/Paul) has seen a man named Ananias coming in and putting *his* hand on him, so that he might receive his sight.
- Acts 10:3 About the ninth hour of the day he saw clearly in a <u>vision</u> an angel of God coming in and saying to him, Cornelius!
- Acts 10:17 Now while Peter wondered within himself what this <u>vision</u> which he had seen meant, behold, the men who had been sent from Cornelius had made inquiry for Simon's house, and stood before the gate.
- Summarized the vision. Acts 10:15 And the voice spake unto him again the second time, What God hath cleansed, that call not thou common.
- Matthew 15:17 Do not ye yet understand, that whatsoever entereth in at the mouth goeth into the belly, and is cast out into the draught?
- Acts 16:9 And a <u>vision</u> appeared to Paul in the night. A man of Macedonia stood and pleaded with him, saying, Come over to Macedonia and help us.
- Acts 18:9 Now the Lord spoke to Paul in the night by a <u>vision</u>, Do not be afraid, but speak, and do not keep silent;
- 2 Corinthians 12:1 It is doubtless not profitable for me to boast. I will come to visions and revelations of the Lord:
- Jude 1:8 Likewise also these <u>dreamers</u> defile the flesh, reject authority, and speak evil of dignitaries.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, 2 for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence.
- Revelation 9:17 And thus I saw the horses in the <u>vision</u>: those who sat on them had breastplates of fiery red, hyacinth blue, and sulfur yellow; and the heads of the horses *were* like the heads of lions; and out of their mouths came fire, smoke, and brimstone.
- Matthew 4:23,24 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their

- synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. 24 Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them.
- Lamentations 2:9 Her gates have sunk into the ground; He has destroyed and broken her bars. Her king and her princes *are* among the nations; The Law *is* no *more*, And her prophets find no vision from the LORD.
- Lamentations 2:14 Your <u>prophets have seen for you False and deceptive visions</u>; They have <u>not uncovered your iniquity</u>, To bring back your captives, But have <u>envisioned for you false prophecies and delusions</u>.
- Ezekiel 1:1 Now it came to pass in the thirtieth year, in the fourth *month*, on the fifth *day* of the month, as I *was* among the captives by the River Chebar, *that* the heavens were opened and I saw <u>visions of God</u>.
- Ezekiel 8 Summarized of the vision through the hole in the wall.
- Daniel 1:17 As for these four young men, <u>God gave them knowledge and skill in all literature and wisdom</u>; and Daniel had <u>understanding in all visions and dreams</u>.
- Daniel 2:2 Then the king gave the command to call the magicians, the astrologers, the sorcerers, and the Chaldeans to tell the king his <u>dreams</u>. So they came and stood before the king.
- Daniel 4:5 I saw a <u>dream</u> which made me afraid, and the thoughts on my bed and the <u>visions</u> of my head troubled me.
- Joel 2:28 And it shall come to pass afterward That I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your old men shall dream dreams, Your young men shall see visions.
- Acts 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, That I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your young men shall see <u>visions</u>, Your old men shall <u>dream</u> dreams.
- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.
