- Hebrews 12:2 looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Revelation 1:8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Matthew 15:22,26,28 And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, thou Son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil. 26 But he answered and said, It is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast it to dogs. 28 Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great is thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour.
- Hebrews 12:4-17 V4 You have not yet resisted to bloodshed, striving against sin.
- Matthew 14 Summarized of John the Baptist killed for confronting sin.
- Isaiah 1:17 Learn to do good; Seek justice, Rebuke the oppressor; Defend the fatherless, Plead for the widow.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.
- Matthew 16:19 And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.
- Acts 26:18 to open their eyes, *in order* to <u>turn them from darkness to light,</u> and <u>from the power of Satan to God</u>, that they may receive forgiveness of <u>sins</u> and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.
- John 8:36 Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed. Isaiah 1:18 Come now, and let us reason together, Says the LORD, Though your sins are like scarlet, They shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They shall be as wool.
- 1 John 3:8 He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the

- beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the <u>devil</u>.
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted.
- Hebrews 12:5 And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to sons: My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD, Nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him;
- Proverbs 3:12 For whom the LORD loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost *which is* in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- Matthew 18 Referred to the parable of the Lost Sheep.
- 1 John 2:1 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
- 1 Corinthians 14:33 For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.
- Hebrews 12:6 For whom the LORD loves He chastens, And scourges every son whom He receives.
- Proverbs 13:24 He that spareth his rod hateth his son: but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Job 38:22,23 Hast thou entered into the treasures of the snow? or hast thou seen the treasures of the hail, 23 Which I have reserved against the time of trouble, against the day of battle and war?

- 2 Corinthians 12:7-9 And lest I should be exalted above measure by the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, a messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I be exalted above measure. 8 Concerning this thing I pleaded with the Lord three times that it might depart from me. 9 And He said to me, My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
- Hebrews 12:7 If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten?
- 1 Kings 18:21 And Elijah came to all the people, and said, How long will you falter between two opinions? If the LORD is God, follow Him; but if Baal, follow him. But the people answered him not a word.
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- 2 Samuel 12:14 Howbeit, because by this deed thou hast given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also that is born unto thee shall surely die.
- Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- John 12:21,22 The same came therefore to Philip, which was of Bethsaida of Galilee, and desired him, saying, Sir, we would see Jesus. 22 Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus.
- John 6:8,9 One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, saith unto him, 9 There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes: but what are they among so many?
- Hebrews 12:8 But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate (bastards) and not sons.
- Deuteronomy 23:2 A bastard shall not enter into the congregation of the LORD; even to his tenth generation shall he not enter into the congregation of the LORD.
- Romans 3:10 As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:
- Acts 8:18-24 (Summarized) And when Simon saw that through the laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Spirit was given, he offered them money, 19 saying, Give me this power also, that anyone on whom I lay hands may receive the Holy Spirit. 20 But Peter said to him, Your money perish

- with you, because you thought that the gift of God could be purchased with money! 21 You have neither part nor portion in this matter, for your heart is not right in the sight of God. 22 Repent therefore of this your wickedness, and pray God if perhaps the thought of your heart may be forgiven you. 23 For I see that you are poisoned by bitterness and bound by iniquity. 24 Then Simon answered and said, Pray to the Lord for me, that none of the things which you have spoken may come upon me.
- Hebrews 12:9,10 Furthermore, we have had human fathers who corrected us, and we paid them respect. Shall we not much more readily be in subjection to the Father of spirits and live? 10 For they indeed for a few days chastened us as seemed best to them, but He for our profit, that we may be partakers of His holiness.
- Ezekiel 36:26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.
- 1 King 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* thou hast turned their heart back again.
- Hebrews 12:11 Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.
- Jeremiah 18 Referred to the potter & the clay.
- Hebrews 12:12 Therefore strengthen the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees, (Spiritual & Physical) 13 and make straight paths for your feet, so that what is lame may not be dislocated, but rather be healed.
- Isaiah 35:8 And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.
- Matthew 15 Summarized of Peter walking on water then seeing storm & sinking.
- Isaiah 59:17 For he put on righteousness as a breastplate, and an helmet of salvation upon his head; and he put on the garments of vengeance for clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloke.
- Our Lord cleaned the temple twice.
- John 2:17 And his disciples remembered that it was written, The zeal of thine house hath eaten me up.
- Luke 19:46 Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Hebrews 12:14,15 Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without

- which no one will see the Lord: 15 looking carefully lest anyone fall short of the grace of God; lest any <u>root of bitterness</u> springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled;
- 2 Timothy 4:7 I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith:
- Hebrews 12:16 lest there be any fornicator or profane person like Esau, who for one morsel of food sold his birthright.
- Genesis 25 Summarized of Esau selling his birthright.
- Hebrews 12:17 For you know that afterward, when he wanted to inherit the blessing, he was rejected, for he found no place for repentance, though he sought it diligently with tears.
- Genesis 27:34 And when Esau heard the words of his father, he cried with a great and exceeding bitter cry, and said unto his father, Bless me, even me also, O my father.
- Summarized of Isaac's final blessing for Esau.
- Deuteronomy 8:5 You should know in your heart that as a man <u>chastens</u> his son, *so* the LORD your <u>God</u> <u>chastens</u> you.
- Deuteronomy 11:2 Know today that *I do* not *speak* with your children, who have not known and who have not seen the <u>chastening</u> of the LORD your <u>God</u>, His greatness and His mighty hand and His outstretched arm —
- Job 5:17 Behold, happy *is* the man whom <u>God</u> corrects; Therefore do not despise the <u>chastening</u> of the Almighty.
- Job 34:31 For has *anyone* said to <u>God</u>, I have borne <u>chastening</u>; I will offend no more;
- Jeremiah 31:18 I have surely heard Ephraim bemoaning himself: You have <u>chastised</u> me, and I was <u>chastised</u>, Like an untrained bull; Restore me, and I will return, For You *are* the LORD my <u>God</u>.
- Hebrews 12:7 If you endure <u>chastening</u>, <u>God</u> deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten?
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
