

Jesus Christ - Pauline Practical Christianity 1 - Hebrews 13A

Isaiah 6 Referred to Isaiah's vision of God in Heaven.

Acts 9 Referred to Paul's Vision of Jesus on the road to Damascus.

Hebrews 13:1-4 V1 Let brotherly love continue.

Matthew 13 Our Lord Jesus put 8 curses on the religious leaders.

Leviticus 19:36 You shall have honest scales, honest weights, an honest ephah, and an honest hin: I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt.

Explained of Godly Vocations from old times versus modern Authority Without Love unionized professions.

John 13:34,35 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. 35 By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.

Exodus 20 Summarized of the 10 Commandments.

Leviticus 19:18 You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself: I am the LORD.

Deuteronomy 6:5 You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.

Luke 10:27 So he answered and said, You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself.

John 11:43,44 Now when He had said these things, He cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth! 44 And he who had died came out bound hand and foot with graveclothes, and his face was wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, Loose him, and let him go.

1 Corinthians 11:21,22 For in eating, each one takes his own supper ahead of others; and one is hungry and another is drunk. 22 What! Do you not have houses to eat and drink in? Or do you despise the church of God and shame those who have nothing? What shall I say to you? Shall I praise you in this? I do not praise you.

Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

James 5:14 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the

church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.

Hebrews 13:2,3 Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some have unwittingly entertained angels. 3 Remember the prisoners as if chained with them — those who are mistreated — since you yourselves are in the body also.

Ruth 1:16 But Ruth said: Entreat me not to leave you, Or to turn back from following after you; For wherever you go, I will go; And wherever you lodge, I will lodge; Your people shall be my people, And your God, my God.

Genesis 18 Referred to Jesus & the angels visiting Abraham.

2 Corinthians 9:7 So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver.

2 Thessalonians 3:10 For even when we were with you, we commanded you this: If anyone will not work, neither shall he eat.

Colossians 3:23 And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men,

Leviticus 19:34 The stranger who dwells among you shall be to you as one born among you, and you shall love him as yourself; for you were strangers in the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God.

Deuteronomy 10:18,19 He administers justice for the fatherless and the widow, and loves the stranger, giving him food and clothing. 19

Therefore love the stranger, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt.

Matthew 25:32 All the nations will be gathered before Him, and He will separate them one from another, as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats.

Matthew 25:35,36 for I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; 36 Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me.

Matthew 25:40 And the King will answer and say to them, Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.

Explained of Christians helping free people in WW2.

Matthew 25:43 I was a stranger and you did not take Me in, naked and you did not clothe Me, sick and in prison and you did not visit Me.

Acts 5:28,29 saying, Did we not strictly command you not to teach in this name? And look, you have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and

intend to bring this Man's blood on us! 29 But Peter and the other apostles answered and said: We ought to obey God rather than men.

John 9:4 I must work the works of Him who sent Me while it is day; the night is coming when no one can work.

Acts 16:15 And when she (Lydia) and her household were baptized, she begged us, saying, If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come to my house and stay. So she persuaded us.

1 Timothy 3:2 A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, temperate, sober-minded, of good behavior, hospitable, able to teach;

Matthew 14:14 And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick.

Matthew 11:28 Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

1 Timothy 5:10 (widows indeed) well reported for good works: if she has brought up children, if she has lodged strangers, if she has washed the saints' feet, if she has relieved the afflicted, if she has diligently followed every good work.

1 Peter 4:9 Be hospitable to one another without grumbling.

Matthew 25:45,46 Then He will answer them, saying, Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to Me. 46 And these will go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.

Matthew 7:20 Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them.

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.
