Which Jesus Is At Your Revival - Matthew 3C

- Setting the scene: This is the spot where Joshua crossed the Jordan on dry ground as the Israelites entered the Promised Land.
- Matthew 3:6 and were baptized by him in the Jordan, confessing their sins.
- Mark 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- Matthew 3:8 Therefore bear fruits worthy of repentance,
- John 16:8 And when He (the Holy Spirit) has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Matthew 3:13-17 Then Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan to be baptized by him. 14 And John tried to prevent Him, saying, I need to be baptized by You, and are You coming to me? 15 But Jesus answered and said to him, Permit it to be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness. Then he allowed Him. 16 When He had been baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him. 17 And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.
- Matthew 3:13 Then Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan to be baptized by him.
- Hebrews 4:14 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.
- Acts 2 Referred to the infilling of the Holy Spirit.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- This baptism of Jesus was like a ritual washing like the high priests did.
- Matthew 3:14-16 And John tried to prevent Him, saying, I need to be baptized by You, and are You coming to me? 15 But Jesus answered and said to him, Permit it to be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to

- fulfill all righteousness. Then he allowed Him. 16 When He had been baptized, <u>Jesus came up immediately from the water</u>; and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him.
- Acts 2:3,4 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.
- Matthew 21 Summarized of Jesus riding on a colt, the foal of a donkey. Genesis 8 Referred to Noah sending a dove to search for dry land. Matthew 3:17 And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, <u>This is</u>
- My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.
- 2 Corinthians 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or *if* ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with *him*.
- Matthew 27:17 Therefore when they were gathered together, Pilate said unto them, Whom will ye that I release unto you? (Jesus) Barabbas, or Jesus which is called Christ?
- Joshua 24:15 And if it seems evil to you to serve the LORD, choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the River, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.
- Numbers 14:2 And all the children of Israel complained against Moses and Aaron, and the whole congregation said to them, If only we had died in the land of Egypt! Or if only we had died in this wilderness!
- 2 Corinthians 11:13-14 For such *are* false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. 14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. Lucifer light bearer.
- 2 Corinthians 11:15 Therefore *it is* no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.
- Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?
- Mark 16:15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach

- the gospel to every creature. ...
- Matthew 24:24 For <u>false christs</u> and <u>false prophets</u> will rise and <u>show</u> <u>great signs and wonders to deceive</u>, if possible, even the elect.

 False Pseudo
- Revelation 13 Referred to the beast & the false prophet.
- Matthew 24:4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.
- 1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- Mark 7:9 He said to them, All too well you reject the commandment of God, that you may keep your tradition.
- Mark 13:22 For <u>false christs</u> and <u>false prophets</u> will rise and show signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.
- Acts 8 & Acts 13 referred to false people exposed.
- John 12:28-30 Father, glorify Your name. Then a voice came from heaven, saying, I have both glorified it and will glorify it again. 29 Therefore the people who stood by and heard it said that it had thundered. Others said, An angel has spoken to Him. 30 Jesus answered and said, This voice did not come because of Me, but for your sake.
- Matthew 17:5 While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them; and suddenly a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!
- Matthew 17:3 there appeared unto them Moses & Elias talking with him.
- Hebrews 12:2 looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Revelation 1:8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

- Acts 28 Referred to Paul bit by viper on Malta.
- Mark 1:11 Then a voice came from heaven, You are My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.
- Mark 9:7 And a cloud came and overshadowed them; and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is My beloved Son. Hear Him!
- Luke 3:22 And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from heaven which said, <u>You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased</u>.
- Luke 9:35 And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, <u>This is My</u> beloved Son. Hear Him!
- 2 Peter 1:17 For He received from God the Father honor and glory when such a voice came to Him from the Excellent Glory: This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.
- Matthew 17:9 Now as they came down from the mountain, Jesus commanded them, saying, Tell the vision to no one until the Son of Man is risen from the dead.
- Acts 10:36-38 The word which God sent to the children of Israel, preaching peace through Jesus Christ He is Lord of all 37 that word you know, which was proclaimed throughout all Judea, and began from Galilee after the baptism which John preached: 38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.
- 1 Corinthians 2:4 And my (Paul) speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:
- Acts 16 Summarized of the girl freed from spirit of divination.
- Acts 13 Summarized of Paul having Elymas go blind for a season.
- 2 Kings 6 Summarized of Elisha causing army to become blind for a while.
- Judges 6 Referred to Gideon testing if God with the fleece.
