Jesus Christ - Pauline Practical Christianity 2 - Hebrews 13B

- Hebrews 13:4 Marriage is honorable among all, and the bed undefiled; but fornicators and adulterers God will judge.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her,
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.
- Matthew 18:19 Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven.
- Acts 15:20 but that we write to them to abstain from things polluted by idols, from sexual immorality, from things strangled, and from blood.
- Job 38:4 Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth (universe)? declare, if thou hast understanding.
- Genesis 1:27 So God <u>created</u> man in His *own* image; in the image of God He <u>created</u> him; <u>male</u> and <u>female</u> He <u>created</u> them.
- Genesis 5:2 He <u>created</u> them <u>male</u> and <u>female</u>, and blessed them and called them Mankind in the day they were created.
- 1 Corinthians 7:33,34 But he who is <u>married</u> cares about the things of the world how he may <u>please</u> his wife. 34 There is a difference between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman cares about the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit. But she who is <u>married</u> cares about the things of the world how she may <u>please</u> her husband.
- 1 Corinthians 9:5 (AV) Have we not power to <u>lead</u> about a <u>sister</u>, a <u>wife</u>, as well as other apostles, and *as* the brethren of the Lord, and Cephas? Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.
- John 10:28,29 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand.
- 1 Corinthians 9:5 (NKJV) Do we have no right to take along a believing wife, as *do* also the other apostles, the brothers of the Lord, and

Cephas?

- Proverbs 18:22 He who finds a wife finds a good thing, And obtains favor from the LORD.
- Genesis 2:24 Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.
- 1 Timothy 5:8 But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.
- Matthew 19:5 and (Jesus) said, For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh?
- Mark 10:7 For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife,
- Ephesians 5:31 For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.
- 1 Corinthians 7:1-16 Now concerning the things of which you wrote to me: It is good for a man not to touch a woman. 2 Nevertheless, because of sexual immorality, let each man have his own wife, and let each woman have her own husband. 3 Let the husband render to his wife the affection due her, and likewise also the wife to her husband. 4 The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does. - if the unbeliever departs, let him depart; a brother or a sister is not under bondage in such cases. But God has called us to peace. 16 For how do you know, O wife, whether you will save your husband? Or how do you know, O husband, whether you will save your wife?
- 1 Corinthians 7:1 Now concerning the things of which you wrote to me: It is good for a man not to touch a woman.
- Romans 13:13 Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying.
- 1 Corinthians 7:2,3 Nevertheless, because of sexual immorality, let each man have <u>his own wife</u>, and let each woman have <u>her own husband</u>. 3 Let the husband render to his wife the affection (benevolence) due her, and likewise also the wife to her husband.
- Ephesians 5:33 Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence (respects) her husband.
- Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her,

- Ezra & Nehemiah Referred to the putting away of ungodly wives being miss-used.
- 1 Corinthians 7:11 But even if she does depart, let her remain unmarried or be reconciled to her husband. And a husband is not to divorce his wife.
- Matthew 4 & Luke 4 Referred to the devil tempting our Lord Jesus.
- 1 Corinthians 7:12 But to the rest I, not the Lord, say: If any brother has a

- wife who does not believe, and she is willing to live with him, let him not divorce her. 13 And a woman who has a husband who does not believe, if he is willing to live with her, let her not divorce him.
- 1 Peter 3:1,2 Wives, likewise, be submissive to your own husbands, that even if some do not obey the word, they, without a word, may be won by the conduct of their wives, 2 when they observe your chaste conduct accompanied by fear.
- 1 Corinthians 7:14-16 For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband; otherwise your children would be unclean, but now they are holy. 15 But if the unbeliever departs, let him depart; a brother or a sister is not under bondage in such cases. But God has called us to peace. 16 For how do you know, 0 wife, whether you will save your husband? Or how do you know, 0 husband, whether you will save your wife?

Leviticus 18 & 20 has God's sex education.

- Leviticus 18:1-30 (AV) V1-3 Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, 2 Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: I am the LORD your God. 3 According to the doings of the land of Egypt, where you dwelt, you shall not do; and according to the doings of the land of Canaan, where I am bringing you, you shall not do; nor shall you walk in their ordinances.
- Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
- Leviticus 18:4,5 (AV) You shall observe My judgments and keep My ordinances, to walk in them: I am the LORD your God. 5 You shall therefore keep My statutes and My judgments, which if a man does, he shall live by them: I am the LORD.
- Leviticus 18:6 (Message) Don't have sex with a close relative. I am GOD. 7 Don't violate your father by having sex with your mother. She is your mother. Don't have sex with her. 8 Don't have sex with your father's wife. That violates your father. 9 Don't have sex with your sister, whether she's your father's daughter or your mother's, whether she was born in the same house or elsewhere. 10 Don't have sex with your son's daughter or your daughter's daughter. That would violate your own body. 11 Don't have sex with the daughter of your father's wife born to your father. She is your sister. 12 Don't have sex with your father's sister; she is your aunt, closely related to your father. 13 Don't have sex with your mother's sister; she is your aunt, closely related to your mother. 14 Don't violate your father's brother, your uncle, by having sex with his wife. She is your aunt. 15 Don't have sex with your daughter-in-law. She is your

son's wife; don't have sex with her. 16 Don't have sex with your brother's wife; that would violate your brother. 17 Don't have sex with both a woman and her daughter. And don't have sex with her granddaughters either. They are her close relatives. That is wicked. 18 Don't marry your wife's sister as a rival wife and have sex with her while your wife is living. 19 Don't have sex with a woman during the time of her menstrual period when she is unclean. 20 Don't have sex with your neighbor's wife and violate yourself by her. 21 Don't give any of your children to be burned in sacrifice to the god Molech—an act of sheer blasphemy of your God. I am GOD. 22 Don't have sex with a man as one does with a woman. That is abhorrent. 23 Don't have sex with an animal and violate yourself by it. A woman must not have sex with an animal. That is perverse. 24 Don't pollute yourself in any of these ways. This is how the nations became polluted, the ones that I am going to drive out of the land before you. 25 Even the land itself became polluted and I punished it for its iniquities—the land vomited up its inhabitants. 26 You must keep my decrees and laws—natives and foreigners both. You must not do any of these abhorrent things. 27 The people who lived in this land before you arrived did all these things and polluted the land. 28 And if you pollute it, the land will vomit you up just as it vomited up the nations that preceded you. 29 Those who do any of these abhorrent things will be cut off from their people. 30 Keep to what I tell you; don't engage in any of the abhorrent acts that were practiced before you came. Don't pollute yourselves with them. I am GOD, your God.

- 1 Timothy 5:22 Do not lay hands on anyone hastily, nor share in other people's sins; keep yourself pure.
- Leviticus 11:45 For I am the LORD who brings you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God. You shall therefore be holy, for I am holy.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

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
