

How Do You React To Temptation - Matthew 4A

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Matthew 4:1-11 - V1 Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.

Matthew 3:16 When He had been baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him.

Ephesians 6:12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.

John 15:20 Remember the word that I said to you, A servant is not greater than his master. If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you. If they kept My word, they will keep yours also.

Hebrews 12:6 For whom the LORD loves He chastens, And scourges every son whom He receives.

Job 1&2 Summarized the glimpse of God & satan in heaven discussing Job.

Job 1:21 And he said: Naked I came from my mother's womb, And naked shall I return there. The LORD gave, and the LORD has taken away; Blessed be the name of the LORD.

2 Corinthians 12:9 And He said to me, My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness. Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

Ephesians 6:11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

Isaiah 59:17 For He put on righteousness as a breastplate, And a helmet of salvation on His head; He put on the garments of vengeance for clothing, And was clad with zeal as a cloak.

Isaiah 64:6 But we are all like an unclean thing, And all our righteousnesses are like filthy rags; We all fade as a leaf, And our iniquities, like the wind, Have taken us away.

John 14:30 I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming, and he has nothing in Me.

Genesis 3:5 For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.

Genesis 3 Summarized of the temptation in the Garden of Eden.

Matthew 4:2 And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterward He was hungry.

Moses & Elijah both fasted for 40 days interceding for the people.

Isaiah 58 Referred to God's passage on fasting.

John 4 Summarized of the woman at the well. V34 Jesus saith unto them, My

meat is to do the will of Him that sent Me, and to finish His work.

2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

Mark 8:33 But when He had turned around and looked at His disciples, He rebuked Peter, saying, Get behind Me, Satan! For you are not mindful of the things of God, but the things of men.

Ephesians 6:16 above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.

Matthew 14:30 But when he saw that the wind was boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, Lord, save me!

Matthew 4:3 Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

Jeremiah 23 & Ezekiel 34 Referred to ungodly pastors fleecing the flock of God.

Hebrews 6:6 if they fall away, to renew them again to repentance, since they crucify again for themselves the Son of God, and put Him to an open shame. (Miss-used for loss of salvation doctrine.)

Summarized of our Lord providing for the Israelites 40 years in the wilderness.

Matthew 4:4 But He answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.

In Jesus' name, ask God to expose & set off the devil's snares, pits, traps & ambushes ahead of time.

1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.

Deuteronomy 8:3 So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every word that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD.

John 6:48 I am the bread of life.

John 6 Summarized of Jesus being all our sustenance.

Ephesians 2:8,9 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, 9 not of works, lest anyone should boast.

John 6:29 Jesus answered and said to them, This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He sent.

James 5:14 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.

In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just healing.

Mark 16:14 Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.

Matthew 4:5,6 Then the devil took Him up into the holy city, set Him on the pinnacle of the temple, 6 and said to Him, If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down. For it is written: He shall give His angels charge over you, and, In their hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone.

These testings were against the body, soul, & spirit.

Acts 8:9,11 But there was a certain man, called Simon (Magus), which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one: 11 And to him they had regard, because that of long time he had bewitched them with sorceries.

Matthew 12:37 Then some of the scribes and Pharisees answered, saying, Teacher, we want to see a sign from You.

Luke 11:29 And when the people were gathered thick together, he began to say, This is an evil generation: they seek a sign; and there shall no sign be given it, but the sign of Jonas the prophet.

Psalms 91:11 For He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you in all your ways. 12 In *their* hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone. (Miss-used by the devil)

1 Corinthians 9:5 (AV) Have we not power to lead about a sister, a wife, as well as other apostles, and as the brethren of the Lord, and Cephas? (Miss-used)

1 Corinthians 9:5 (NKJV) Do we have no right to take along a believing wife, as do also the other apostles, the brothers of the Lord, and Cephas?

Matthew 23 Summarized of the 8 woes against the religious leaders.

Matthew 6:5 And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.

Matthew 23:11 But he who is greatest among you shall be your servant.

John 13:14 If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.

Matthew 4:7 Jesus said to him, It is written again, You shall not tempt the LORD your God.

Deuteronomy 6:16 You shall not tempt the LORD your God as you tempted *Him* in Massah.

Psalms 78 Referred to the 10 times they tempted God in the wilderness. V40

How often they provoked Him in the wilderness, And grieved Him in the desert!

Numbers 14:22 because all these men who have seen My glory and the signs which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have put Me to the test now these ten times, and have not heeded My voice,

Matthew 4:8 Again, the devil took Him up on an exceedingly high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory. 9 And he said to Him, All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me.

Revelation 13 Summarized of taking the mark of the beast.

Genesis 25:34 Then Jacob gave Esau bread and pottage of lentiles; and he did eat and drink, and rose up, and went his way: thus Esau despised his birthright.

Matthew 4:10 Then Jesus said to him, Away with you, Satan! For it is written, You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only you shall serve.

James 4:7 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

Deuteronomy 10:20 You shall fear the LORD your God; you shall serve Him, and to Him you shall hold fast, and take oaths in His name.

Luke 4:8 And Jesus answered and said to him, Get behind Me, Satan! For it is written, You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only you shall serve.

Luke 10:27 So he answered and said, You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself.

Exodus 8:1 And the LORD spoke to Moses, Go to Pharaoh and say to him, Thus says the LORD: Let My people go, that they may serve Me.

Exodus 6:7 I will take you as My people, and I will be your God. Then you shall know that I am the LORD your God who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.

Matthew 4:11 Then the devil left Him, and behold, angels came and ministered to Him.

Mark 16:15-18 And He said to them, Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. 17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.
