Being Blessed By Our Lord Jesus Company - Matthew 4B

- Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.
- Luke 22:19 And He took bread, gave thanks and broke *it*, and gave *it* to them, saying, This is My body which is given for you; <u>do this in</u> remembrance of Me.
- 1 Corinthians 11:24,25 and when He had given thanks, He broke *it* and said, Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; <u>do this in</u> remembrance of Me. 25 In the same manner *He* also *took* the cup after supper, saying, <u>This</u> cup is the new covenant in My blood. <u>This</u> <u>do</u>, as often as you drink *it*, in remembrance of Me.
- John 6:63 It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.
- Summarized of all that Jesus did for Believers.
- Matthew 4:12-17 Now when Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, He departed to Galilee. 13 And leaving Nazareth, He came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the regions of Zebulun and Naphtali, 14 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: 15 The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, By the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles: 16 The people who sat in darkness have seen a great light, And upon those who sat in the region and shadow of death Light has dawned. 17 From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Luke 3&4 Summarized of Jesus' baptism or ritual washing & the temptations in the wilderness.
- Luke 1:36 Now indeed, Elizabeth your relative has also conceived a son in her old age; and this is now the sixth month for her who was called barren.
- Summarized of John the Baptist's 6 months' ministry.
- Matthew 19:5,6 and said, For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh? 6 So then, they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let not man separate.
- Acts 15:20 but that we write to them to abstain from things polluted by idols, from sexual immorality, from things strangled, and from blood.
- 1 Timothy 3 & Titus 1 Referred to God's qualifications for pastors & leaders

- in the church.
- Luke 19:46 saying to them, It is written, My house is a house of prayer,' but you have made it a den of thieves.
- 1 Timothy 2:1,2 Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, 2 for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence.
- Hebrews 12:4 You have not yet resisted to bloodshed, striving against sin. Matthew 4:12 Now when Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, He departed to Galilee.
- Matthew 2 Summarized of when Joseph returned to Nazareth with Mary & young Jesus.
- Matthew 4:13 And leaving Nazareth, He came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the regions of Zebulun and Naphtali,
- Mark 6:3 Is this not the carpenter, the Son of Mary, and brother of James, Joses, Judas, and Simon? And are not His sisters here with us? And they were offended at Him.
- Matthew 4:14 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying:
- Isaiah 9:1,2 Nevertheless the gloom will not be upon her who is distressed, As when at first He lightly esteemed The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, And afterward more heavily oppressed her, By the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, In Galilee of the Gentiles. 2 The people who walked in darkness Have seen a great light; Those who dwelt in the land of the shadow of death, Upon them a light has shined.
- John 14:6 Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.
- John 3:30 He must increase, but I must decrease.
- Matthew 11:10 For this is he of whom it is written: Behold, I send My messenger before Your face, Who will prepare Your way before You.
- 1 Corinthians 7:33,34 But he who is married cares about the things of the world how he may please his wife. 34 There is a difference between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman cares about the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit. But she who is married cares about the things of the world how she may please her husband.
- 1 Timothy 5:8 But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.
- Matthew 4:15,16 The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, By the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles: 16 The people

- who sat in darkness have seen a great light, And upon those who sat in the region and shadow of death Light has dawned.
- Mark 7 Summarized of the Syrophenician woman coming to Jesus.
- Matthew 10:8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.
- Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Matthew 3:2 and (John the Baptist) saying, Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!
- John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
- Genesis 9:11,13 Thus I establish My covenant with you: Never again shall all flesh be cut off by the waters of the flood; never again shall there be a flood to destroy the earth. 13 I set My rainbow in the cloud, and it shall be for the sign of the covenant between Me and the earth.
- John 14:14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.
- Matthew 6:10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.
- Ezekiel 14:3 Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their heart, and put the stumblingblock of their iniquity before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them?
- 1 Corinthians 6:19,20 Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? 20 For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.
- Acts 5 Referred to Ananias & Sapphira died for sin.
- Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth.
- Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- 2 Chorinthians 6:2 For He says: In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you. Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.
- Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
- 1 Kings 8:47 *yet* when they come to themselves in the land where they were carried captive, and <u>repent</u>, and make supplication to You in the land of those who took them captive, saying, We have sinned and done wrong, we have committed wickedness;
- Daniel 4:36,37 At the same time my reason returned to me, and for the

- glory of my kingdom, my honor and splendor returned to me. My counselors and nobles resorted to me, I was restored to my kingdom, and excellent majesty was added to me. 37 Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise and extol and honor the King of heaven, all of whose works are truth, and His ways justice. And those who walk in pride He is able to put down.
- 2 Chronicles 6:37 *yet* when they come to themselves in the land where they were carried captive, and <u>repent</u>, and make supplication to You in the land of their captivity, saying, We have sinned, we have done wrong, and have committed wickedness;

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.

- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Romans 6:15 What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid.
- Job 42:6 Therefore I abhor myself, And repent in dust and ashes.
- Jeremiah 25:5 They said, <u>Repent</u> now everyone of his evil way and his evil doings, and dwell in the land that the LORD has given to you and your fathers forever and ever.
- Ezekiel 14:6 Therefore say to the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord GOD: Repent, turn away from your idols, and turn your faces away from all your abominations.
- Ruth 1:16 But Ruth said: Entreat me not to leave you, Or to turn back from following after you; For wherever you go, I will go; And wherever you lodge, I will lodge; Your people shall be my people, And your God, my God.

Judges 6 Summarized of Rahab.

- Ezekiel 18:30 Therefore I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways, says the Lord GOD. Repent, and turn from all your transgressions, so that iniquity will not be your ruin.
- Hosea 11:5 He shall not return to the land of Egypt; But the Assyrian shall be his king, Because they refused to <u>repent</u>.

Summarized of Jonah preaching to Nineveh & all repenting.

- Luke 9:26 For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words, of him the Son of Man will be ashamed when He comes in His own glory, and in His Father's, and of the holy angels.
- Matthew 3:2 and saying, <u>Repent</u>, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand! Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, <u>Repent</u>, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

- Matthew 11:20 Then He began to rebuke the cities in which most of His mighty works had been done, because they did not <u>repent</u>:
- Mark 6:5 Now He could do no mighty work there, except that He laid His hands on a few sick people and healed them.
- Matthew 12:30 He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters abroad.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 1:15 and saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.
- Mark 6:12 So they went out and preached that people should repent.
- Luke 13:2-5 And Jesus answering said unto them, Suppose ye that these Galilaeans were sinners above all the Galilaeans, because they suffered such things? 3 I tell you, no; but unless you <u>repent</u> you will all likewise perish. 4 Or those eighteen, upon whom the tower in Siloam fell, and slew them, think ye that they were sinners above all men that dwelt in Jerusalem? 5 I tell you, no; but unless you <u>repent</u> you will all likewise perish.
- Luke 16:30 And he said, No, father Abraham; but if one goes to them from the dead, they will <u>repent</u>.
- Summarized of the parable of the rich man & Lazarus.
- 1 Samuel 13 Summarized of Absalom, Amnon & Tamar.
- Luke 17:4 And if he sins against you seven times in a day, and seven times in a day returns to you, saying, I repent, you shall forgive him.
- Acts 2:38 Then Peter said to them, <u>Repent</u>, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- Acts 17:30 Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent,
- Mark 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- Matthew 28:19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:
- Acts 3:19 Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord,
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- Acts 8:22 Repent therefore of this your wickedness, and pray God if perhaps the thought of your heart may be forgiven you.

John 4 Have Holy Spirit flow as living water.

More Service Notes:

- Acts 26:20 but declared first to those in Damascus and in Jerusalem, and throughout all the region of Judea, and *then* to the Gentiles, that they should <u>repent</u>, turn to God, and do works befitting repentance.
- Revelation 2:5 Remember therefore from where you have fallen; <u>repent</u> and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place unless you <u>repent</u>.
- Revelation 2:16 Repent, or else I will come to you quickly and will fight against them with the sword of My mouth.
- Revelation 2:21,22 And I gave her time to <u>repent</u> of her sexual immorality, and she did not <u>repent</u>. 22 Indeed I will cast her into a sickbed, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they <u>repent</u> of their deeds.
- Revelation 3:3 Remember therefore how you have received and heard; hold fast and <u>repent</u>. Therefore if you will not watch, I will come upon you as a thief, and you will not know what hour I will come upon you.
- Revelation 3:19 As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Therefore be zealous and <u>repent</u>.
- Revelation 9:20,21 But the rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not <u>repent</u> of the works of their hands, that they should not worship demons, and idols of gold, silver, brass, stone, and wood, which can neither see nor hear nor walk. 21 And they did not <u>repent</u> of their murders or their sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts.
- Revelation 16:9 And men were scorched with great heat, and they blasphemed the name of God who has power over these plagues; and they did not <u>repent</u> and give Him glory.
- Revelation 16:11 They blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and did not repent of their deeds.
