Paul's Closing Remarks

Summarized of how Paul followed our Lord Jesus Christ showing how more superior He was.

John 19:30 So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, It is finished! And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

Hebrews 13:18-25 V18 <u>Pray for us;</u> for we are confident that we have a good conscience, in all things desiring to live honorably.

Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted.

Summarized of Paul's epistles written while in prison.

Referred to Paul's account of the Lord's Supper used for Communion now.

1 Corinthians 13 Paul fulfilled God's love flowing through him to minister.

Matthew 15:30 Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus' feet, and He healed them.

Referred to Lazarus' grave clothes John 11:44 And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.

Luke 10 Summarized of the Parable of the Good Samaritan.

Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus' 8 woes to the religious hypocrites.

Hebrews 13:19 But I especially urge you to do this, that I may be restored to you the sooner.

Matthew 11:16 But to what shall I liken this generation? It is like children sitting in the marketplaces and calling to their companions,

Luke 8 Summarized of the different seed growth.

Matthew 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

Hebrews 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth

- every son whom he receiveth.
- Hebrews 13:20 Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,
- Summarized of what Jesus did for our salvation.
- Romans 5:1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 1 Kings 18:37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that You are the LORD God, and that You have turned their hearts back to You again.
- Matthew 11:28 Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Ephesians 4:30 And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.
- Romans 8 Nothing can separate us from the Love of God.
- Matthew 27:63-65 saying, Sir, we remember, while He was still alive, how that deceiver said, After three days I will rise. 64 Therefore command that the tomb be made secure until the third day, lest His disciples come by night and steal Him away, and say to the people, He has risen from the dead. So the last deception will be worse than the first. 65 Pilate said to them, You have a guard; go your way, make it as secure as you know how.
- John 10:18 No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 For He says: In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you. Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.
- John 14:2 In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
- John 10 Summarized of The Good Shepherd.
- Acts 17:6 But when they did not find them, they dragged Jason and some brethren to the rulers of the city, crying out, These who have turned the world upside down have come here too.
- Colossians 3:17 And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.
- Matthew 18:4 Therefore whoever humbles himself as this little child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

- 2 Corinthians 10:5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,
- Job 1 & 2 Referred to God allowing him to be tested.
- John 10:28,29 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand.
- Luke 17 Summarized of the servant doing work.
- Hebrews 13:21 make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.
- Galatians 5 Referred to the fruit of the Spirit.
- Galatians 1:17,18 nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me; but I went to Arabia, and returned again to Damascus. 18 Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to see Peter, and remained with him fifteen days.
- Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.
- 2 Samuel 12:14 However, because by this deed you have given great occasion to the enemies of the LORD to blaspheme, the child also who is born to you shall surely die.
- Jonah Summarized 2:9 But I will sacrifice to You With the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay what I have vowed. Salvation is of the LORD.
- John 14:14 "If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.
- James 4:3 Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.
- Matthew 4 & Luke 4 Summarized of our Lord's temptations as Jesus rebuked the devil with the Word of God.
- Hebrews 13:22,23 And I appeal to you, brethren, bear with the word of exhortation, for I have written to you in few words. 23 Know that our brother Timothy has been set free, with whom I shall see you if he comes shortly.
- Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Summarized of Timothy a student of Paul.
- 2 Timothy 1:5 when I call to remembrance the genuine faith that is in you,

- which dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am persuaded is in you also.
- Hebrews 13:24 Greet all those who rule over you, and all the saints. Those from Italy greet you.
- 1 Timothy 3 Summarized of the qualifications of Pastors.
- Hebrews 13:25 Grace be with you all. Amen.
- Hebrews 5:10-6:2 V10,11 (Jesus) called by God as High Priest according to the order of Melchizedek, 11 of whom we have much to say, and hard to explain, since you have become dull of hearing.
- Isaiah 6:9,10 And He said, Go, and tell this people: Keep on hearing, but do not understand; Keep on seeing, but do not perceive. 10 Make the heart of this people dull, And their ears heavy, And shut their eyes; Lest they see with their eyes, And hear with their ears, And understand with their heart, And return and be healed.
- Hebrews 5:12,13 For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food. 13 For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe.
- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world.
- Genesis 3 Summarized of the fall in the Garden of Eden.
- Genesis 3:6 So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate.
- Luke 4:9 Then he brought Him to Jerusalem, set Him on the pinnacle of the temple, and said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down from here. 10 For it is written: He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you, 11 and, In their hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone.
- Psalms 91:11 For He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you in all your ways.
- Luke 4:12 And Jesus answered and said to him, It has been said, You shall not tempt the LORD your God.
- Hebrews 5:14 But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern

both good and evil.

Acts 15:20 but that we write to them to abstain from things polluted by idols, from sexual immorality, from things strangled, and from blood. Leviticus 18 expands God's laws on immorality.

Hebrews 6:1,2 Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, 2 of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment.

Galatians 5 & 6 Referred to Paul explaining of circumcision not a qualifier for salvation.

More Service Notes:

Ephesians 6:10-18 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. 11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. 13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, 15 and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; 18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints —
