- Summarized of the testing of Our Lord Jesus Christ, then He begins His ministry.
- Matthew 4:18-25 V18 And Jesus, walking by the Sea of Galilee, saw two brothers, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen.
- John 9:4 I must work the works of Him who sent Me while it is day; the night is coming when no one can work.
- Romans 12:2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 For He says: In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you. Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.
- Luke 10:2 Then He said to them, The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.
- Isaiah 6:9,10 And He said, Go, and tell this people: Keep on hearing, but do not understand; Keep on seeing, but do not perceive. 10 Make the heart of this people dull, And their ears heavy, And shut their eyes; Lest they see with their eyes, And hear with their ears, And understand with their heart, And return and be healed.
- John 11:49,50 And one of them, Caiaphas, being high priest that year, said to them, You know nothing at all, 50 nor do you consider that it is expedient for us that one man should die for the people, and not that the whole nation should perish.
- Matthew 4:19 Then He said to them, Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.
- Strongs #1205. deute *dyoo'-teh*; from <u>1204</u> and an imperative form of ειμι eimi (to go); come hither!: come, X follow.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 For He says: In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you. Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.
- Matthew 4:20 They immediately left their nets and followed Him.
- Strongs #2112. eutheos *yoo-theh'-oce*; adverb from <u>2117</u>; directly, i.e. at once or soon: anon, as soon as, forthwith, immediately, shortly, straightway.
- Isaiah 29:13 Therefore the Lord said: "Inasmuch as these people draw near with their mouths And honor Me with their lips, But have removed their hearts far from Me, And their fear toward Me is taught by the commandment of men,
- Matthew 23 Summarized the 8 curses Jesus put on the religious leaders.

- "But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites!"...
- Matthew 4:19 Then He said to them, <u>Follow Me</u>, and I will make you fishers of men.
- Matthew 8:22 But Jesus said to him, <u>Follow Me</u>, and let the dead bury their own dead.
- Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.
- Matthew 9:9 As Jesus passed on from there, He saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, <u>Follow Me</u>. So he arose and followed Him.
- Judges 7 Summarized of Gideon testing if it was God.
- Matthew 16:24 Then Jesus said to His disciples, If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and <u>follow Me</u>.
- 1 Samuel 2:29 Why do you kick at My sacrifice and My offering which I have commanded in My dwelling place, and honor your sons more than Me, to make yourselves fat with the best of all the offerings of Israel My people?
- Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.
- Luke 11:2 And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.
- Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.
- Matthew 19:21 Jesus said to him, If you want to be perfect, go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me.
- Exodus 20:17A Thou shalt not covet ...
- Matthew 19:23 Then Jesus said to His disciples, "Assuredly, I say to you that it is hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven.
- John 10:27 My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.
- Matthew 4:21 Going on from there, He saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets. He called them, 22 and immediately they left the boat and their father, and followed Him.
- John 2:14-17 (Summarized) And He found in the temple those who sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the moneychangers doing business. 15 When He had made a whip of cords, He drove them all out of the temple, with the sheep and the oxen, and poured out the changers' money and overturned the tables. 16 And He said to those who sold doves, Take these things away! Do not make My Father's house a house of merchandise! 17 Then

- His disciples remembered that it was written, Zeal for Your house has eaten Me up.
- Matthew 4:23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.
- Mark 2:17 When Jesus heard it, He said to them, Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance.
- John 3 & 4 Summarized of Jesus teaching Nicodemus & preaching to the woman at the well.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- John 4:21,23 Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father. 23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.
- Jesus read Isaiah 61 as recorded in Luke 4.
- Isaiah 61:1-4 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me, Because the LORD has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, And the opening of the prison to those who are bound; 2 To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, And the day of vengeance of our God; To comfort all who mourn, 3 To console those who mourn in Zion, To give them beauty for ashes, The oil of joy for mourning, The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; That they may be called trees of righteousness, The planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified. 4 And they shall rebuild the old ruins, They shall raise up the former desolations, And they shall repair the ruined cities, The desolations of many generations.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; 18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.
- Matthew 4:23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.
- Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Leviticus 18 Referred to God's list of immorality.
- Exodus 32:26 Then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, Who is on the LORD'S side? let him come unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves together unto him.
- **Exodus 32 Summarized Moses finding ungodliness in Israel.**
- 1 Peter 4:17 For the time has come for judgment to begin at the house of

- God; and if it begins with us first, what will be the end of those who do not obey the gospel of God?
- Revelation 2&3 Summarized 2:5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 When I shut up heaven and there is no rain, or command the locusts to devour the land, or send pestilence among My people, 14 if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.
- Romans 6:1,2 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?
- Luke 18 Referred to the persistant widow.
- Mark 8:22-26 Summarized of Jesus healing the blind man by praying twice.
- Mark 10:51 And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I should do unto thee? The blind man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive my sight.
- Mark 10 Summarized of Blind Bartimaeus healed.
- Mark 5 Summarized of the Gadarene demoniac set free from the demons.
- Mark 10:38,39 Now the man out of whom the devils were departed besought him that he might be with him: but Jesus sent him away, saying, 39 Return to thine own house, and shew how great things God hath done unto thee. And he went his way, and published throughout the whole city how great things Jesus had done unto him.Mark 10:34 And, behold, the whole city came out to meet Jesus: and when they saw him, they besought him that he would depart out of their coasts.
- Mark 8:2 I have compassion on the multitude, because they have now continued with Me three days and have nothing to eat.
- Matthew 4:24 Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them.
- Mark 5:25 And a certain woman, which had an issue of blood twelve years, (healed)
- Mark 9 Summarized of epileptic boy healed
- Mark 9:29 So He said to them, This kind can come out by nothing but prayer and fasting.
- Matthew 13:15A For this people's heart is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes they have closed;
- Matthew 4:25 Great multitudes followed Him from Galilee, and from Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and beyond the Jordan.

- 2 Corinthians 6:2 For He says: In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you. Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.
- Luke 9:23 And he said to them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me.
- John 9:4 I must work the works of Him who sent Me while it is day; the night is coming when no one can work.

More Service Notes:

- Mark 1:17 Then Jesus said to them, <u>Follow Me</u>, and I will make you become fishers of men.
- Mark 2:14 As He passed by, He saw Levi the *son* of Alphaeus sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, <u>Follow Me</u>. So he arose and followed Him.
- Mark 8:34 When He had called the people to *Himself*, with His disciples also, He said to them, Whoever desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.
- Mark 10:21 Then Jesus, looking at him, loved him, and said to him, One thing you lack: Go your way, sell whatever you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; & come, take up the cross, & <u>follow Me</u>.
- Luke 5:27 After these things He went out and saw a tax collector named Levi, sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, <u>Follow Me</u>.
- Luke 9:23 Then He said to *them* all, If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and <u>follow</u> <u>Me</u>.
- Luke 9:59 Then He said to another, <u>Follow Me</u>. But he said, Lord, let me first go and bury my father.
- Luke 18:22 So when Jesus heard these things, He said to him, You still lack one thing. Sell all that you have and distribute to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, <u>follow Me</u>.
- John 1:43 The following day Jesus wanted to go to Galilee, and He found Philip and said to him, <u>Follow</u> <u>Me</u>.
- John 12:26 If anyone serves Me, let him <u>follow</u> <u>Me</u>; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him *My* Father will honor.
- John 13:36 Simon Peter said to Him, Lord, where are You going? Jesus answered him, Where I am going you cannot <u>follow</u> <u>Me</u> now, but you shall <u>follow</u> <u>Me</u> afterward.
- John 21:19,22 This He spoke, signifying by what death he would glorify God. And when He had spoken this, He said to him, Follow Me. 22 Jesus said to him, If I will that he remain till I come, what *is that* to you? You follow Me.
