- Matthew 5:1-2 And seeing the multitudes, He went up on a mountain, and when He was seated His disciples came to Him. 2 Then He opened His mouth and taught them, saying:
- Matthew 5-7 chapters are considered the Sermon on the Mount.
- **Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments.**
- Summarized of many deities worshipped on mountains around the world.
- Referred to Hezekiah & Josiah as reformers cleaning off the mountains.
- Matthew 4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
- Luke 5:3 And he entered into one of the ships, which was Simon's, and prayed him that he would thrust out a little from the land. And he sat down, and taught the people out of the ship.
- Matthew 17 Summarized of Jesus Transfigured on the mount.
- Revelation 6:16 and said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us and hide us from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb!
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 For He says: In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you. Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.
- John 1:17 For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.
- Ruth 1:16 But Ruth said: Entreat me not to leave you, Or to turn back from following after you; For wherever you go, I will go; And wherever you lodge, I will lodge; Your people shall be my people, And your God, my God.
- John 14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.
- Ezekiel 14:3 Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their heart, and put the stumblingblock of their iniquity before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them?
- Isaiah 29:13 Therefore the Lord said: "Inasmuch as these people draw near with their mouths And honor Me with their lips, But have removed their hearts far from Me, And their fear toward Me is taught by the commandment of men.
- Mark 7:6 He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me.
- Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus' 8 woes (curses) on the religious leaders.
- John 8:44 You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in

the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it.

- Luke 11:50,51 that the blood of all the prophets which was shed from the foundation of the world may be required of this generation, 51 from the blood of Abel to the blood of Zechariah who perished between the altar and the temple. Yes, I say to you, it shall be required of this generation.
- Exodus 19:1-25 V1-4 In the third month after the children of Israel had gone out of the land of Egypt, on the same day, they came to the Wilderness of Sinai. 2 For they had departed from Rephidim, had come to the Wilderness of Sinai, and camped in the wilderness. So Israel camped there before the mountain. 3 And Moses went up to God, and the LORD called to him from the mountain, saying, Thus you shall say to the house of Jacob, and tell the children of Israel: 4 You have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles' wings and brought you to Myself.
- Exodus 19:12 You shall set bounds for the people all around, saying, Take heed to yourselves that you do not go up to the mountain or touch its base. Whoever touches the mountain shall surely be put to death.
- Matthew 9:21 For she said to herself, If only I may touch His garment, I shall be made well.
- Our Lord Jesus walked among an unclean world ministering to the people.
- Exodus 6:7 I will take you as My people, and I will be your God. Then you shall know that I am the LORD your God who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
- Exodus 19:5 Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth is Mine.

Genesis 3 Summarized of the fall of Adam & Eve.

Exodus 19:6-15 (Summarized) And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. These are the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel. 7 So Moses came and called for the elders of the people, and laid before them all these words which the LORD commanded him. 8 Then all the people answered together and said, All that the LORD has spoken we will do. So Moses brought back the words of the people to the LORD. 9 And the LORD said to Moses, Behold, I come to you in the thick cloud, that the people may hear when I speak with you, and believe you forever. So Moses told the words of the people to the LORD. 10 Then the LORD said to Moses, Go to the people and consecrate them today and tomorrow, and let them wash their clothes. 11 And let them be ready for the third day. For on the third day the LORD will come down upon Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people. 12 You shall set bounds for the people all around, saying, Take heed to yourselves that you do not go up to the mountain or touch its base. Whoever touches the mountain shall surely be put to death. 13 Not a hand shall touch him, but he shall surely be stoned

or shot with an arrow; whether man or beast, he shall not live. When the trumpet sounds long, they shall come near the mountain. 14 So Moses went down from the mountain to the people and sanctified the people, and they washed their clothes. 15 And he said to the people, Be ready for the third day; do not come near your wives.

- 3 Days Referred to Jonah & Our Lord in the grave 3 days.
- Exodus 19:16 Then it came to pass on the third day, in the morning, that there were thunderings and lightnings, and a thick cloud on the mountain; and the sound of the trumpet was very loud, so that all the people who were in the camp trembled.
- 2 Samuel 22:15 And he sent out arrows, and scattered them; lightning, and discomfited them.
- Exodus 19:17 And Moses brought the people out of the camp to meet with God, and they stood at the foot of the mountain. 18 Now Mount Sinai was completely in smoke, because the LORD descended upon it in fire. Its smoke ascended like the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mountain quaked greatly.
- Genesis 19:28 And he looked toward Sodom and Gomorrah, and toward all the land of the plain, and beheld, and, lo, the smoke of the country went up as the smoke of a furnace.
- Exodus 19:19-23 And when the blast of the trumpet sounded long and became louder and louder, Moses spoke, and God answered him by voice. 20 Then the LORD came down upon Mount Sinai, on the top of the mountain. And the LORD called Moses to the top of the mountain, and Moses went up. 21 And the LORD said to Moses, Go down and warn the people, lest they break through to gaze at the LORD, and many of them perish. 22 Also let the priests who come near the LORD consecrate themselves, lest the LORD break out against them. 23 But Moses said to the LORD, The people cannot come up to Mount Sinai; for You warned us, saying, Set bounds around the mountain and consecrate it.
- Matthew 19:13,14 Then were there brought unto him little children, that he should put his hands on them, and pray: and the disciples rebuked them. 14 But Jesus said, Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven.
- Revelation 19:11-16 Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. 12 His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. 13 He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. 14 And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. 15 Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword (the Word of God), that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself

- treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. 16 And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.
- Zechariah 14:4 And in that day His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, Which faces Jerusalem on the east. And the Mount of Olives shall be split in two, From east to west, Making a very large valley; Half of the mountain shall move toward the north And half of it toward the south.
- Mark 9 Referred to Mount Tabor the mount of Transfiguration.
- Mark 9:7 And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him.
- Numbers 12:3 (Now the man Moses was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.)
- Genesis 12:8 And he moved from there to the <u>mountain</u> east of Bethel, and he pitched his tent *with* Bethel on the west and Ai on the east; there he built an <u>altar</u> to the LORD and called on the name of the LORD.
- Exodus 24:4 And Moses wrote all the words of the LORD. And he rose early in the morning, and built an <u>altar</u> at the foot of the <u>mountain</u>, and twelve pillars according to the twelve tribes of Israel.
- Deuteronomy 12:2 You shall utterly destroy all the places where the nations which you shall dispossess served their gods, on the <u>high mountains</u> and on the hills and under every green tree. (under the Old Covenant.)
- John 8:7,11 So when they continued asking Him, He raised Himself up and said to them, He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first. 11 She said, No one, Lord. And Jesus said to her, Neither do I condemn you; go and sin no more.
- Matthew 11:11 Assuredly, I say to you, among those born of women there has not risen one greater than John the Baptist; but he who is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.
- Exodus 32:6 Then they rose early on the next day, offered burnt offerings, and brought peace offerings; and the people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up to play.
- 2 Kings 23:16 As Josiah turned, he saw the tombs that *were* there on the mountain. And he sent and took the bones out of the tombs and burned *them* on the <u>altar</u>, and defiled it according to the word of the LORD which the man of God proclaimed, who proclaimed these words.
- 1 Kings 13 Summarized of the prophesy of Josiah.
- 1 Corinthians 10:14 Therefore, my beloved, flee from idolatry.
- Matthew 16:13 When Jesus came into the region of Caesarea Philippi, He asked His disciples, saying, Who do men say that I, the Son of Man, am?
- Matthew 21:19 And seeing a fig tree by the road, He came to it and found nothing on it but leaves, and said to it, Let no fruit grow on you ever again. Immediately the fig tree withered away.
- 2 Chronicles 15:8 And when Asa heard these words and the prophecy of Oded

- the prophet, he took courage, and <u>removed the abominable idols</u> from all the land of Judah and Benjamin and from the cities which he had taken in the <u>mountains</u> of Ephraim; and he restored the <u>altar</u> of the LORD that <u>was</u> before the vestibule of the LORD.
- John 4:24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.
- 2 Chronicles 21:11 Moreover he made <u>high</u> places in the <u>mountains</u> of Judah, and caused the inhabitants of Jerusalem to commit harlotry, and led Judah astray.
- 1 Kings 12 Summarized of Jeroboam's false religion.
- Isaiah 13:2 Lift up a banner on the <u>high mountain</u>, Raise your voice to them; Wave your hand, that they may enter the gates of the nobles.
- Isaiah 30:25 There will be on every <u>high mountain</u> And on every <u>high</u> hill Rivers *and* streams of waters, In the day of the great slaughter, When the towers fall.
- Isaiah 40:9 O Zion, You who bring good tidings, Get up into the <a href="https://high.ncbi.nlm.ncbi.nl
- Isaiah 56:7 Even them I will bring to My holy <u>mountain</u>, And make them joyful in My house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and their sacrifices *Will be* accepted on My <u>altar</u>; For My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations.
- Isaiah 57:7 On a lofty and <u>high mountain</u> You have set your bed; Even there you went up To offer sacrifice.
- Jeremiah 3:6 The LORD said also to me in the days of Josiah the king: Have you seen what backsliding Israel has done? She has gone up on every <u>high</u> mountain and under every green tree, and there played the harlot.
- Acts 15:20 but that we write to them to abstain from things polluted by idols, from sexual immorality, from things strangled, and from blood.
- Jeremiah 17:3 O My mountain in the field, I will give as plunder your wealth, all your treasures, *And* your <u>high</u> places of sin within all your borders.
- Ezekiel 6:3 and say, O <u>mountains</u> of Israel, hear the word of the Lord GOD!'

 Thus says the Lord GOD to the <u>mountains</u>, to the hills, to the ravines, and to the valleys: Indeed I, *even* I, will bring a sword against you, and I will destroy your <u>high</u> places.
- Ezekiel 6:13 Then you shall know that I *am* the LORD, when their slain are among their idols all around their <u>altars</u>, on every <u>high</u> hill, on all the <u>mountaintops</u>, under every green tree, and under every thick oak, wherever they offered sweet incense to all their idols.
- Hosea 10:8 Also the <u>high</u> places of Aven, the sin of Israel, Shall be destroyed. The thorn and thistle shall grow on their <u>altars</u>; They shall say to the <u>mountains</u>, Cover us! And to the hills, Fall on us!

- Habakkuk 3:10 The <u>mountains</u> saw You *and* trembled; The overflowing of the water passed by. The deep uttered its voice, *And* lifted its hands on <u>high</u>.
- Matthew 4:8-10 Again, the devil took Him up on an exceedingly <u>high</u> <u>mountain</u>, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory. 9 And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me. 10 Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.
- Matthew 17:1 Now after six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, led them up on a <u>high mountain</u> by themselves;
- Mark 9:2 Now after six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John, and led them up on a <u>high mountain</u> apart by themselves; and He was transfigured before them.
- Luke 4:5 Then the devil, taking Him up on a <u>high mountain</u>, showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time.

More Service Notes:

- Ezekiel 17:22 Thus says the Lord GOD: I will take also *one* of the highest branches of the <u>high</u> cedar and set *it* out. I will crop off from the topmost of its young twigs a tender one, and will plant *it* on a <u>high</u> and prominent <u>mountain</u>.
- Ezekiel 34:6 My sheep wandered through all the <u>mountains</u>, and on every <u>high</u> hill; yes, My flock was scattered over the whole face of the earth, and no one was seeking or searching *for them*.
- Ezekiel 34:14 I will feed them in good pasture, and their fold shall be on the high mountains of Israel. There they shall lie down in a good fold and feed in rich pasture on the mountains of Israel.
- Ezekiel 40:2 In the visions of God He took me into the land of Israel and set me on a very <u>high mountain</u>; on it toward the south *was* something like the structure of a city.
- Amos 4:13 For behold, He who forms <u>mountains</u>, And creates the wind, Who declares to man what his thought *is*, And makes the morning darkness, Who treads the <u>high</u> places of the earth The LORD God of hosts *is* His name.
- Revelation 21:10 And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and <u>high</u> mountain, and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,
