## Blesséd Are The Meek - The Spirit Of Meekness - Matthew 5D

- Matthew 28:6 He is not here; for He is risen, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay.
- Matthew 23:12 And whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.
- Exodus 20 Referred to the 10 Commandments vs the Beatitudes the New Commandments.
- Ezekiel 14:3 Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their heart, and put the stumblingblock of their iniquity before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them?
- Ezekiel 8 Summarized of the ungodliness done in the temple then.
- Matthew 5:5 AV Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.
- Luke 9:58 And Jesus said unto him, Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay His head.
- Matthew 10:8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
- Matthew 5:5 Message You're blessed when you're (meek) content with just who you are—no more, no less. That's the moment you find yourselves proud owners of everything that can't be bought. (Off the original meaning.)
- Acts Summarized of Paul's ministry preaching of the Risen Lord.
- Acts 17:6 And when they found them not, they drew Jason and certain brethren unto the rulers of the city, crying, These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also;
- Isaiah 61:1 The <u>Spirit</u> of the Lord GOD *is* upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the <u>meek</u>; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *them that are* bound;
- Luke 4:21 And he began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.
- 1 Corinthians 4:21 What will ye? shall I come unto you with a rod, or in love, and *in* the <u>spirit of meekness</u>?
- 1 Corinthians 5:13 But them that are without God judgeth. Therefore put away from among yourselves that wicked person.
- 2 Corinthians 2:6,7 Sufficient to such a man is this punishment, which was inflicted of many. 7 So that contrariwise ye ought rather to forgive him, and comfort him, lest perhaps such a one should be swallowed up with overmuch sorrow.
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are <u>spiritual</u>, restore such an one in the <u>spirit of meekness</u>; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.

- 1 Peter 3:4 But *let it be* the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, *even the ornament* of a <u>meek and quiet spirit</u>, which is in the sight of God of great price.
- 1 Corinthians 7 Summarized of if unbelieving spouse is content to stay.
- John 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- Luke 3:14 And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse any falsely; and be content with your wages.
- 1 Peter 3:1-7 V1-5 Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation (lifestyle) of the wives; 2 While they behold your chaste conversation (lifestyle) coupled with fear. 3 Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel; 4 But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.

Explained of modern ornaments used for offensive & defensive magic.

- 1 Peter 3:5-7 For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands: 6 Even as Sara obeyed Abraham, calling him lord: whose daughters ye are, as long as ye do well, and are not afraid with any amazement. 7 Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.
- Ephesians 5:33 Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband.
- Strongs #4239. praus *prah-ooce*; apparently a primary word; mild, i.e. (by implication) humble: meek. See also <u>4235</u>.
- Strongs #06035. 'anav aw-nawv'; or by intermixture with <u>06041</u> 'anayv aw-nawv'; from <u>06031</u>; depressed (figuratively), in mind (gentle) or circumstances (needy, especially saintly): humble, lowly, meek, poor. Compare <u>06041</u>.
- Matthew 5:5 Blessed *are* the <u>meek</u>: for they shall inherit the earth.
- Matthew 11:29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am <u>meek</u> and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.
- Luke 12:48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.
- Matthew 21:5 Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, <u>meek</u>, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass.

Revelation 19 Summarized of Jesus' return.

- 1 Corinthians 4:21 What will ye? shall I come unto you with a rod, or in love, and *in* the spirit of meekness?
- 2 Corinthians 10:1 Now I Paul myself beseech you by the <u>meekness and</u> gentleness of Christ, who in presence *am* base among you, but being absent am bold toward you:
- Galatians 5:23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.
- Galatians 6:1 Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the <u>spirit of meekness</u>; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted.
- Ephesians 4:2 With all lowliness and <u>meekness</u>, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;

- John 13:34 A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.
- Ephesians 4:26 Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath:
- Colossians 3:12 <u>Put on</u> therefore, as the elect of God, holy (different, set apart for God) and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, <u>meekness</u>, longsuffering;
- 1 Timothy 6:11 But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and <u>follow after</u> righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, <u>meekness</u>.
- John 18:33,36 Then Pilate entered into the judgment hall again, and called Jesus, and said unto him, Art thou the King of the Jews? 36 Jesus answered, My kingdom is not of this world: if my kingdom were of this world, then would my servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is my kingdom not from hence.

Revelation 13 referred to the mark of the beast to buy.

Joshua 24:15 And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.

Luke 17:5 And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith.

2 Timothy 2:25 <u>In meekness instructing</u> those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; Hebrews 5:14-6:1 Summarized of the immature believers.

Jeremiah 3:15 And I will give you pastors according to mine heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.

Titus 3:10 A man that is an heretick after the first and second admonition reject;

Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

Luke 19:46 Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer:

- but ye have made it a den of thieves.
- Titus 3:2 To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, *but* gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men.
- Revelation 2:5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.
- James 1:21 Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and <u>receive with meekness</u> the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.
- John 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.
- James 3:13 Who *is* a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? let him shew out of a good conversation his works with <u>meekness of wisdom</u>.
- Isaiah 40:11 He shall feed his flock like a shepherd: he shall gather the lambs with his arm, and carry them in his bosom, and shall gently lead those that are with young.
- Luke 5:31 And Jesus answering said unto them, They that are whole need not a physician; but they that are sick.
- 1 Peter 3:4 But *let it be* the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, *even the ornament* of a <u>meek and quiet spirit</u>, which is in the sight of God of great price.
- 1 Peter 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and *be* ready always to *give* an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with <u>meekness</u> and fear:
- Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
- Luke 8 Referred to the Gadarene demoniac freed from demons.
- Numbers 12:3 (Now the man Moses *was* very <u>meek</u>, above all the men which *were* upon the face of the earth.)
- Summarized of God changing Moses to be meek.
- Psalms 22:26 The <u>meek</u> shall eat and be satisfied: they shall praise the LORD that seek Him: your heart shall live for ever.
- Psalms 25:9 The <u>meek</u> will He guide in judgment: and the <u>meek</u> will He teach his way.
- Psalms 37:11 But the <u>meek</u> shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the <u>abundance of peace</u>.
- John 7:39 (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Psalms 45:4 And in thy majesty ride prosperously because of truth and <a href="mailto:meekness">meekness</a> and righteousness; and thy right hand shall teach thee terrible

- things.
- Psalms 76:9 When God arose to judgment, to <u>save all the meek</u> of the earth. Selah.
- Psalms 147:6 The <u>LORD lifteth up the meek</u>: He casteth the wicked down to the ground.
- Psalms 149:4 For the LORD taketh pleasure in His people: He will <u>beautify</u> the meek with salvation.
- Isaiah 11:4 But with righteousness shall He judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the <u>meek</u> of the earth: and He shall smite the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips shall He slay the wicked.
- Isaiah 29:19 The <u>meek</u> also shall <u>increase *their* joy in the LORD</u>, and the poor among men shall rejoice in the Holy One of Israel.
- Nehemiah 8:10 Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is holy unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry; for the <u>joy of the LORD is your strength</u>.
- Isaiah 61:1 The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon Me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the <u>meek</u>; He hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *them that are* bound;
- Amos 2:7 That pant after the dust of the earth on the head of the poor, and <u>turn aside the way of the meek</u>: and a man and his father will go in unto the *same* maid, to profane my holy name:
- Zephaniah 2:3 Seek ye the LORD, all ye <u>meek</u> of the earth, which have wrought His judgment; seek righteousness, seek <u>meekness</u>: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger.
- Matthew 5:5 Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 16:17,18 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- Matthew 12:30 He that is not with me is against me; and he that gathereth not with me scattereth abroad.
- Jonah Referred to what happens to those who run from God's will.
