## **Be Not Wearied - 2 Thessalonians 3**

- Matthew 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.
- Luke 18:5 Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she <u>weary</u> me.
- Strongs #5299 hupopiazo hoop-o-pee-ad'-zo AV-weary 1, keep under 1; 2
- 1) to beat black and blue, to smite so as to cause bruises and livid spots 1a) like a boxer one buffets his body, handle it roughly, discipline by hardships
- 2) metaph. 2a) to give one intolerable annoyance 2a1) beat one out, wear one out 2b) by entreaties 3) that part of the face that is under the eyes
- Galatians 6:9 And let us not be <u>weary</u> in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.
- 2 Thessalonians 3:13 But ye, brethren, be not weary in well doing.
- Daniel 10 Referred to the battle in the heavenlies.
- Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.
- Strongs #1573 ekkakeo *ek-kak-eh'-o* or egkakeo *eng-kak-eh'-o* AV-faint 4, be weary 2; 6 1) to be utterly spiritless, to be wearied out, exhausted
- 2 Corinthians 11 Referred to Paul's In Perils Chapter.
- 2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead:
- 1 Timothy 1:15 This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief. (Paul)
- Luke 18:1 And He spake a parable unto them *to this end*, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint <u>1573</u>;
- Acts 16:30,31 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? 31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.
- John 16:8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- 1 Corinthians 9:27 But I keep under <u>5299</u> my body, and bring *it* into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.
- Galatians 5 Referred to the fruit of the Spirit.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- 2 Corinthians 4:1 Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint 1573 not;

- Acts 9:15 But the Lord said unto him, Go thy way: for he is a chosen vessel unto me, to bear my name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel:
- Mercy is God holding back on the punishments we deserve.
- 2 Corinthians 4:16 For which cause we faint <u>1573</u> not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward *man* is renewed day by day.
- John 7:38 He that believeth on Me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.
- Ephesians 3:13 Wherefore I desire that ye faint <u>1573</u> not at my tribulations for you, which is your glory.
- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Luke 10:18 And He said unto them, I beheld satan as lightning fall from heaven.
- Genesis 19:11 And they smote the men that *were* at the door of the house with blindness, both small and great: so that they <u>wearied</u> themselves to find the door.
- Genesis 18 Summarized of Abraham pleading with God for the righteous in Sodom & area.
- 2 Kings 6 Summarized of Elisha praying to make the army blind.
- Matthew 26:53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to My Father, and He shall presently give Me more than twelve legions of angels?
- Luke 17:5 And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our faith.
- Genesis 27:46 And Rebekah said to Isaac, I am <u>weary</u> of my life because of the daughters of Heth: if Jacob take a wife of the daughters of Heth, such as these *which are* of the daughters of the land, what good shall my life do me?
- Deuteronomy 25:18 How he met thee by the way, and smote the hindmost of thee, even all that were feeble behind thee, when thou wast faint and weary; and he feared not God.
- 1 Timothy 4:8 For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.
- Judges 4:21 Then Jael Heber's wife took a nail of the tent, and took an hammer in her hand, and went softly unto him, and smote the nail into his temples, and fastened it into the ground: for he was <u>fast asleep and weary</u>. So he died.
- Matthew 26:37,38 And He took with him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and began to be <u>sorrowful and very heavy</u>. 38 Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: tarry ye here, and watch with Me.
- Judges 4 Summarized of the battle against Sisera & God fighting for Israel.

- Judges 8:15 And he (Gideon) came unto the men of Succoth, and said, Behold Zebah and Zalmunna, with whom ye did upbraid me, saying, *Are* the hands of Zebah and Zalmunna now in thine hand, that we should give bread unto thy men *that are* weary?
- 1 Samuel 14 Summarized of Jonathan eating the honey & Saul's curse.
- 1 Kings 18 Summarized of Elijah outrunning Ahab's horses.
- 1 Kings 1 Summarized of Elijah calling down fire from heaven on the soldiers.
- 1 Kings 19 Summarized of Elijah being weary & fled from Jezebel's curse.
- 2 Samuel 16:14 And the king, and all the people that *were* with him, came <u>weary</u>, and refreshed themselves there.
- 2 Samuel 17:2 And I will come upon him while he *is* weary and weak handed, and will make him afraid: and all the people that *are* with him shall flee; and I will smite the king only:
- Matthew 8:25 And his disciples came to him, and awoke him, saying, Lord, save us: we perish.
- 2 Samuel 17:29 And honey, and butter, and sheep, and cheese of kine, for David, and for the people that *were* with him, to eat: for they said, The people *is* hungry, and <u>weary</u>, and thirsty, in the wilderness.
- 2 Samuel 23:10 He arose, and smote the Philistines until his hand was <u>weary</u>, and his hand clave unto the sword: and the LORD wrought a great victory that day; and the people returned after him only to spoil.
- Job 3:17 There the wicked cease *from* troubling; and there the <u>weary</u> be at rest.
- Job 7:3 So am I made to possess months of vanity, and <u>wearisome nights</u> are appointed to me.
- Job 10:1 My <u>soul is weary of my life</u>; I will leave my complaint upon myself; I will speak in the <u>bitterness of my soul</u>.
- Job 16:7 But now he hath made me <u>weary</u>: thou hast made desolate all my company.
- Numbers 13 Summarized of the 10 spies giving an evil report.
- Numbers 14:1 And all the congregation lifted up their voice, and cried; and the people wept that night. 2 And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron: and the whole congregation said unto them, Would God that we had died in the land of Egypt! or would God we had died in this wilderness!
- Job 22:7 Thou hast not given water to the <u>weary</u> to drink, and thou hast withholden bread from the hungry.
- Job 37:11 Also by watering he <u>wearieth</u> the thick cloud: he scattereth his bright cloud:
- Psalms 6:6 I am <u>weary with my groaning</u>; all the night make I my bed to swim; I water my couch with my tears.
- 2 Chronicles 7:13,14 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14

- If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.
- Psalms 68:9 Thou, O God, didst send a plentiful rain, whereby thou didst confirm thine inheritance, when it was weary.
- Psalms 69:3 I am <u>weary of my crying</u>: my throat is dried: mine eyes fail while I wait for my God.
- Luke 18:1 And He spake a parable unto them *to this end*, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;
- Proverbs 3:11 My son, despise not the chastening of the LORD; neither be weary of His correction:
- Jonah Referred to the story of Jonah.
- Hebrews 12 Hebrews 12:5 And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him:
- Proverbs 25:17 Withdraw thy foot from thy neighbour's house; lest he be weary of thee, and so hate thee.
- 1 Timothy 5:13 And withal they (young widows) learn to be idle, wandering about from house to house; and not only idle, but tattlers also and busybodies,
- John 4:6 Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied with His journey, sat thus on the well: and it was about the sixth hour.
- John 4:34 Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of Him that sent Me, and to finish His work.

## **More Service Notes:**

- Ecclesiastes 10:15 The labour of the foolish <u>wearieth</u> every one of them, because he knoweth not how to go to the city.
- Ecclesiastes 12:12 And further, by these, my son, be admonished: of making many books *there is* no end; and much study *is* a <u>weariness</u> of the flesh.
- Isaiah 1:14 Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul hateth: they are a trouble unto me; I am <u>weary</u> to bear *them*.
- Isaiah 5:27 None shall be <u>weary</u> nor stumble among them; none shall slumber nor sleep; neither shall the girdle of their loins be loosed, nor the latchet of their shoes be broken:
- Isaiah 7:13 And he said, Hear ye now, O house of David; *Is it* a small thing for you to <u>weary</u> men, but will ye <u>weary</u> my God also?
- Isaiah 16:12 And it shall come to pass, when it is seen that Moab is <u>weary</u> on the high place, that he shall come to his sanctuary to pray; but he shall not prevail.
- Isaiah 28:12 To whom he said, This *is* the rest *wherewith* ye may cause the <u>weary</u> to rest; and this *is* the refreshing: yet they would not hear.
- Isaiah 32:2 And a man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a

- great rock in a weary land.
- Isaiah 40:28 Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, *that* the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is <u>weary</u>? *there is* no searching of his understanding.
- Isaiah 40:30,31 Even the youths shall faint and be <u>weary</u>, and the young men shall utterly fall: 31 But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew *their* strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; *and* they shall walk, and not faint.
- Isaiah 43:22-24 But thou hast not called upon me, O Jacob; but thou hast been weary of me, O Israel. 23 Thou hast not brought me the small cattle of thy burnt offerings; neither hast thou honoured me with thy sacrifices. I have not caused thee to serve with an offering, nor wearied thee with incense. 24 Thou hast bought me no sweet cane with money, neither hast thou filled me with the fat of thy sacrifices: but thou hast made me to serve with thy sins, thou hast wearied me with thine iniquities.
- Isaiah 46:1 Bel boweth down, Nebo stoopeth, their idols were upon the beasts, and upon the cattle: your carriages *were* heavy loaden; *they are* a burden to the weary *beast*.
- Isaiah 47:13 Thou art <u>wearied</u> in the multitude of thy counsels. Let now the astrologers, the stargazers, the monthly prognosticators, stand up, and save thee from *these things* that shall come upon thee.
- Isaiah 50:4 The Lord GOD hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to *him that is* <u>weary</u>: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the learned.
- Isaiah 57:10 Thou art <u>wearied</u> in the greatness of thy way; *yet* saidst thou not, There is no hope: thou hast found the life of thine hand; therefore thou wast not grieved.
- Jeremiah 2:24 A wild ass used to the wilderness, *that* snuffeth up the wind at her pleasure; in her occasion who can turn her away? all they that seek her will not <u>weary</u> themselves; in her month they shall find her.
- Jeremiah 4:31 For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, *and* the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, *that* bewaileth herself, *that* spreadeth her hands, *saying*, Woe *is* me now! for my soul is <u>wearied</u> because of murderers.
- Jeremiah 6:11 Therefore I am full of the fury of the LORD; I am <u>weary</u> with holding in: I will pour it out upon the children abroad, and upon the assembly of young men together: for even the husband with the wife shall be taken, the aged with *him that is* full of days.
- Jeremiah 9:5 And they will deceive every one his neighbour, and will not speak the truth: they have taught their tongue to speak lies, *and* weary themselves to commit iniquity.
- Jeremiah 12:5 If thou hast run with the footmen, and they have wearied thee,

- then how canst thou contend with horses? and *if* in the land of peace, wherein thou trustedst, they <u>wearied</u> thee, then how wilt thou do in the swelling of Jordan?
- Jeremiah 15:6 Thou hast forsaken me, saith the LORD, thou art gone backward: therefore will I stretch out my hand against thee, and destroy thee; I am weary with repenting.
- Jeremiah 20:9 Then I said, I will not make mention of him, nor speak any more in his name. But *his word* was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was <u>weary</u> with forbearing, and I could not *stay*.
- Jeremiah 31:25 For I have satiated the <u>weary</u> soul, and I have replenished every sorrowful soul.
- Jeremiah 51:58 Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The broad walls of Babylon shall be utterly broken, and her high gates shall be burned with fire; and the people shall labour in vain, and the folk in the fire, and they shall be weary.
- Jeremiah 51:64 And thou shalt say, Thus shall Babylon sink, and shall not rise from the evil that I will bring upon her: and they shall be <u>weary</u>. Thus far are the words of Jeremiah.
- Ezekiel 24:12 She hath <u>wearied</u> *herself* with lies, and her great scum went not forth out of her: her scum *shall be* in the fire.
- Micah 6:3 O my people, what have I done unto thee? and wherein have I wearied thee? testify against me.
- Habakkuk 2:13 Behold, *is it* not of the LORD of hosts that the people shall labour in the very fire, and the people shall <u>weary</u> themselves for very vanity?
- Malachi 1:13 Ye said also, Behold, what a <u>weariness</u> is it! and ye have snuffed at it, saith the LORD of hosts; and ye brought that which was torn, and the lame, and the sick; thus ye brought an offering: should I accept this of your hand? saith the LORD.
- Malachi 2:17 Ye have <u>wearied</u> the LORD with your words. Yet ye say, Wherein have we <u>wearied</u> him? When ye say, Every one that doeth evil *is* good in the sight of the LORD, and he delighteth in them; or, Where *is* the God of judgment?
- 2 Corinthians 11:27 In <u>weariness</u> and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness.
- Hebrews 12:3 For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.
