## **Blesséd Are The Pure In Heart - Matthew 5G**

- Matthew 5:8 (AV) Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? 20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
- Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.
- Titus 1:15 Unto the pure all things are pure: but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving is nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled.
- Matthew 5:8 (Message) You're blessed when you get your inside world—your mind and heart—put right. Then you can see God in the outside world.
- Romans 10:9,10 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- Isaiah 29:13 Wherefore the Lord said, Forasmuch as this people draw near me with their mouth, and with their lips do honour me, but have removed their heart far from me, and their fear toward me is taught by the precept of men:

Revelation 2&3 Referred to the letters to the 7 churches.

1 Kings 18:36 And it came to pass at *the time of* the offering of the *evening* sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near, and said, LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be known this day that Thou *art* God in Israel, and *that* I *am* Thy servant, and *that* I have done all these things at Thy word. 37 Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that Thou *art* the LORD God, and *that* Thou hast turned their heart back again. 38 Then the fire of the LORD fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that *was* in the trench.

Summarized of the actions of that day.

- Acts 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:
- Summarized that God sent Jesus to shed His blood to pay for our sins & sent the Holy Spirit to guide us.
- Luke 15:I will arise and go to my father, and will say unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and before thee,
- Matthew 10:8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out

- devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
- Matthew 9:36 But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.
- Matthew 23:25 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye make <u>clean</u> the <u>outside</u> of the cup and of the platter, but within they are full of extortion and excess. 26 *Thou* blind Pharisee, <u>cleanse</u> first that *which* is within the cup and platter, that the outside of them may be clean also.
- Hebrews 5:14-6:1 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil. 6:1 Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God,
- 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- Ephesians 4:30 And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- Luke 11:39 And the Lord said unto him, Now do ye Pharisees make <u>clean</u> the <u>outside</u> of the cup and the platter; but your inward part is full of ravening and wickedness.
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- 1 Samuel 2 Summarized of Eli & his sinful sons.
- Matthew 23:1-12 Then spake Jesus to the multitude, and to his disciples, 2 Saying, The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat: 3 All therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do; but do not ye after their works: for they say, and do not. 4 For they bind heavy burdens and grievous to be borne, and lay them on men's shoulders; but they themselves will not move them with one of their fingers. 5 But all their works they do for to be seen of men: they make broad their phylacteries, and enlarge the borders of their garments, 6 And love the uppermost rooms at feasts, and the chief seats in the synagogues, 7 And greetings in the markets, and to be called of men, Rabbi, Rabbi. 8 But be not ye called Rabbi: for one is your Master, even Christ; and all ye are brethren. 9 And call no man your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven. 10 Neither be ye called masters: for one is your Master, even Christ. 11 But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant. 12 And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.
- John 11:50 Nor consider that it is expedient for us, that one man should die for the people, and that the whole nation perish not.
- John 3 Summarized of Nicodemus V7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye

- must be born again.
- 2 Corinthians 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?
- Matthew 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
- Matthew 18:3 And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.
- John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.
- 1 Corinthians 2:4 And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:
- Acts 8 Summarized of Simon Magus V 21 Thou hast neither part nor lot in this matter: for thy heart is not right in the sight of God.
- John 16:7-15 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send Him unto you. 8 And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: 9 Of sin, because they believe not on me; 10 Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; 11 Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged. 12 I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. 13 Howbeit when He, the Spirit of truth, is come, He will guide you into all truth: for He shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever He shall hear, that shall He speak: and He will shew you things to come. 14 He shall glorify Me: for He shall receive of Mine, and shall shew it unto you. 15 All things that the Father hath are Mine: therefore said I, that He shall take of Mine, and shall shew it unto you.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:19 Quench not the Spirit.
- John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.
- Matthew 6:22 The light of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of light. (Christ's Light in us)
- Mark 16:9-20 Referred to newer translations omitting this Great Commission of our Lord.
- Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:
- 1 John 4:3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have

- heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.
- John 16:8 And when He is come, He will reprove (convicts) the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- Luke 23:4 Then said Pilate to the chief priests and to the people, I find no fault in this man.
- John 15:24 If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.
- John 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, it is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.
- Matthew 23:39 For I say unto you, Ye shall not see me henceforth, till ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord.
- John 16:9 Of sin, because they believe not on me;
- Luke 10:18,19 And He said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. 19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Mark 8:27 And Jesus went out, and His disciples, into the towns of Caesarea Philippi: and by the way He asked His disciples, saying unto them, Whom do men say that I am? 28 And they answered, John the Baptist: but some say, Elias; and others, One of the prophets. 29 And He saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am? And Peter answereth and saith unto Him, Thou art the Christ.
- Matthew 16:17 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but My Father which is in heaven.
- 2 Corinthians 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)
- John 3:16,18 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten <u>Son</u>, that whosoever <u>believeth</u> in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. 18 He that <u>believeth</u> on Him is not condemned: but he that <u>believeth</u> not is condemned already, because he hath not <u>believed</u> in the name of the only begotten <u>Son</u> of God.
- John 3:36 He that <u>believeth</u> on the <u>Son</u> hath everlasting life: and he that <u>believeth</u> not the <u>Son</u> shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.
- John 6:40 And this is the will of Him that sent Me, that every one which seeth the <u>Son</u>, and <u>believeth</u> on Him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise Him up at the last day.
- John 6:69 And we <u>believe</u> and are sure that Thou art that Christ, the <u>Son</u> of the living God.

- John 9:35,38 Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when He had found him, He said unto him, Dost thou <u>believe</u> on the <u>Son</u> of God? 38 And he said, Lord, I believe. And he worshipped Him.
- John 11:27 She saith unto Him, Yea, Lord: I <u>believe</u> that Thou art the Christ, the <u>Son</u> of God, which should come into the world.
- John 20:31 But these are written, that ye might <u>believe</u> that Jesus is the Christ, the <u>Son</u> of God; and that believing ye might have life through His name.
- Matthew 5:8 Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.
- Hebrews 13:15 By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to His name.
- John 20:26-31 And after eight days again His disciples were within, and Thomas with them: then came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, Peace be unto you. 27 Then saith He to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold My hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into My side: and be not faithless, but believing. 28 And Thomas answered and said unto Him, My Lord and my God. 29 Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen Me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed. 30 And many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book: 31 But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through His name.
- Luke 8:12 Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.
- Matthew 24:23,24 Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ, or there; believe it not. 24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.
- Revelation 19 Summarized of our Lord Jesus' return.
- 1 Corinthians 13:12 For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.
