The Spirit Of Deception - Matthew 24

- Luke 10:19 Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
- Genesis 3 Summarized of Adam & Eve falling to deception.
- Genesis 3:13 And the LORD God said unto the woman, What is this that thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat.
- Mark 16:9-20 is removed in some new Bible versions.
- Genesis 3:6 And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.
- Matthew 24:4 And Jesus answered and said to them: Take heed that no one deceives you.
- 2 Timothy 4:3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;
- Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
- Matthew 5:18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.
- 1 Peter 1:25 But the word of the Lord endureth for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.

- Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.
- Mark 16:14 Afterward He appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their <u>unbelief and hardness of heart</u>, because they <u>believed not</u> them which had seen Him after He was risen.
- Matthew 12:40 For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's

- belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.
- John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and <u>one of you is a devil?</u>
- Matthew 7:15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.
- Matthew 7:20 Therefore by their fruits you will know them.
- Revelation 2:5 Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.
- Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave Himself for it;
- Acts 8:9 But there was a certain man, called Simon, which beforetime in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one:
- Acts 8:11 And to him they had regard, because that of long time he had bewitched them with sorceries.
- Acts 9 Referred to the 7 sons of Sceva using the name of Jesus.
- Acts 5:3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?
- Matthew 24:5 For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.
- Mark 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- John the Baptist & our Lord's Disciples baptised believers.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
- Matthew 2:16 Then Herod, when he saw that he was <u>deceived</u> by the wise men, was exceedingly angry; and he sent forth and put to death all the male children who were in Bethlehem and in all its districts, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had determined from the wise men.
- Matthew 24:4,5 And Jesus answered and said to them: Take heed that no one <u>deceives</u> you. 5 For many will come in My name, saying, I am the Christ, and will <u>deceive</u> many.
- Matthew 24:11 Then many false prophets will rise up and <u>deceive</u> many.
- Matthew 24:24 For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to <u>deceive</u>, if possible, even the elect.
- Matthew 27:63 saying, Sir, we remember, while He was still alive, how that <u>deceiver</u> said, After three days I will rise.
- Mark 13:5 And Jesus, answering them, began to say: Take heed that no one <u>deceives</u> you.

- Mark 13:6 For many will come in My name, saying, I am *He*, and will <u>deceive</u> many.
- Mark 13:22 For false christs and false prophets will rise and show signs and wonders to <u>deceive</u>, if possible, even the elect.
- Luke 21:8 And He said: Take heed that you not be <u>deceived</u>. For many will come in My name, saying, I am *He*, and, The time has drawn near. Therefore do not go after them.
- John 7:12 And there was much complaining among the people concerning Him. Some said, He is good; others said, No, on the contrary, He <u>deceives</u> the people.
- John 7:47 Then the Pharisees answered them, Are you also <u>deceived</u>? Romans 7:11 For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, <u>deceived</u> me, and by it killed *me*.
- John 10:28,29 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand.
- Romans 16:18 For those who are such do <u>not serve our Lord Jesus Christ</u>, but their own belly, and by <u>smooth words and flattering speech deceive the</u> hearts of the simple.
- Matthew 10:16 Behold, I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves. Therefore be wise as serpents and harmless as doves.
- 1 Corinthians 3:18 Let no one <u>deceive himself</u>. If anyone among you seems to be wise in this age, let him become a fool that he may become wise.
- Colossians 3:17 And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.
- 1 Corinthians 6:9 Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? <u>Do not be deceived</u>. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites,
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 <u>Do not be deceived</u>: Evil company corrupts good habits.
- Matthew 5:13-15 You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. 14 You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house.
- 2 Corinthians 6:8 by honor and dishonor, by evil report and good report; as <u>deceivers</u>, and *yet* true;
- 2 Corinthians 11:3 But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent <u>deceived</u> Eve by his craftiness (witchcraft), so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.
- 1 John 4:3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in

- the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.
- John 12:46 I have come as a light into the world, that whoever believes in Me should not abide in darkness.
- John 14:6 Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.
- John 3:7 Do not marvel that I said to you, You must be born again.
- Matthew 11:28 Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.
- Matthew 23 Referred to our Lord's 8 woes or curses on the religious leaders Luke 8:12 Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved.
- Matthew 24:4 And Jesus answered and said to them: Take heed that no one deceives you.

- Galatians 6:3 For if anyone thinks himself to be something, when he is nothing, he <u>deceives</u> himself.
- Galatians 6:7 Do not be <u>deceived</u>, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.
- Ephesians 5:6 Let no one <u>deceive</u> you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience.
- Colossians 2:4 Now this I say lest anyone should <u>deceive</u> you with persuasive words.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:3 Let no one <u>deceive</u> you by any means; for *that Day will not come* unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition,
- 1 Timothy 2:14 And Adam was not <u>deceived</u>, but the woman being <u>deceived</u>, fell into transgression.
- 1 Timothy 4:1 Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to <u>deceiving</u> spirits and doctrines of demons.
- 2 Timothy 3:13 But evil men and impostors will grow worse and worse, <u>deceiving</u> and being <u>deceived</u>.
- Titus 1:10 For there are many insubordinate, both idle talkers and <u>deceivers</u>, especially those of the circumcision,
- Titus 3:3 For we ourselves were also once foolish, disobedient, <u>deceived</u>, serving various lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful and hating one another.
- James 1:16 Do not be <u>deceived</u>, my beloved brethren.
- James 1:22 But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, <u>deceiving</u> yourselves.

- James 1:26 If anyone among you thinks he is religious, and does not bridle his tongue but <u>deceives</u> his own heart, this one's religion *is* useless.
- 1 John 1:8 If we say that we have no sin, we <u>deceive</u> ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- 1 John 2:26 These things I have written to you concerning those who *try to* <u>deceive</u> you.
- 1 John 3:7 Little children, let no one <u>deceive</u> you. He who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous.
- 2 John 1:7 For many <u>deceivers</u> have gone out into the world who do not confess Jesus Christ *as* coming in the flesh. This is a <u>deceiver</u> and an antichrist.
- Revelation 12:9 So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who <u>deceives</u> the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.
- Revelation 13:14 And he <u>deceives</u> those who dwell on the earth by those signs which he was granted to do in the sight of the beast, telling those who dwell on the earth to make an image to the beast who was wounded by the sword and lived.
- Revelation 18:23 The light of a lamp shall not shine in you anymore, and the voice of bridegroom and bride shall not be heard in you anymore. For your merchants were the great men of the earth, for by your sorcery all the nations were <u>deceived</u>.
- Revelation 19:20 Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he <u>deceived</u> those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone.
- Revelation 20:3 and he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should <u>deceive</u> the nations no more till the thousand years were finished. But after these things he must be released for a little while.
- Revelation 20:8 and will go out to <u>deceive</u> the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number *is* as the sand of the sea.
- Revelation 20:10 The devil, who <u>deceived</u> them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet *are*. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.
