

## **Jesus Christ Helps With Anger Management - Matthew 5L**

### **Examples of Ungodly Anger Management**

**Genesis 4 Summarized of Cain & Abel V7** If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him.

**Judges 15 Summarized of Samson & his first wife.**

**Matthew 23 Referred to Jesus' reaction to the religious leaders.**

**Exodus 20:13 Thou shalt not kill.**

**Deuteronomy 5:17 Thou shalt not kill.**

**Matthew 5:21** Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment:

**Romans 13:9** For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if *there be* any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

**Matthew 5:21-26 V21,22** Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not kill; and whosoever shall kill shall be in danger of the judgment: **22** But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca (dim witted), shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool (degradation), shall be in danger of hell fire.

**Matthew 23** Referred to Jesus angry with the hypocritical religious leaders.

**1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

**Matthew 5:23,24** Therefore if thou bring thy gift to the altar, and there rememberest that thy brother hath ought against thee; **24** Leave there thy gift before the altar, and go thy way; first be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift.

**Luke 18** Summarized of the Pharisee & the publican

**Mark 12** Referred to the poor widow's mites.

**2 Corinthians 9:7** Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.

**2 Corinthians 5:18** And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;

**Psalms 147:14** He maketh peace in thy borders, and filleth thee with the finest of the wheat.

**Ephesians 4:26 Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath:**

**Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.**

**Matthew 5:25,26 Agree with thine adversary quickly, whiles thou art in the way with him; lest at any time the adversary deliver thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and thou be cast into prison. 26 Verily I say unto thee, Thou shalt by no means come out thence, till thou hast paid the uttermost farthing.**

**Romans 14 Summarized of believers taking each other before judges.**

**Genesis 9:5 And surely your blood of your lives will I require; at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man's brother will I require the life of man. 6 Whoso sheddeth man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed: for in the image of God made He man.**

**Summarized of the right of the avenger of blood & the cities of refuge.**

**Strong's #4469 rhaka *rhak-ah'*; of Aramaic origin compare 07386; O empty one, i.e. thou worthless (as a term of utter vilification): — Raca. (dummy)**

**Romans 14:19 Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may edify another.**

**Ephesians 6:4 And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.**

**Strong's #3474. moros *mo-ros'*; probably from the base of 3466; dull or stupid (as if shut up), i.e. heedless, (morally) blockhead, (apparently) absurd: — fool(-ish, X -ishness). (dehumanization)**

**Summarized of our Lord dealing with the religious people cheating in the temple.**

**Matthew 5:22 But I say unto you, That whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire.**

**Matthew 7:26 And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand: (vs on the Rock)**

**James 1:23 For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: 24 For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.**

**Matthew 23:17 Ye fools and blind: for whether is greater, the gold, or the temple that sanctifieth the gold?**

**Isaiah 61 quoted in Luke 4:18,19 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because**

he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,  
19 To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

Matthew 23:19 Ye fools and blind: for whether *is* greater, the gift, or the altar that sanctifieth the gift?

Matthew 23:23 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

Matthew 25:2,3,8 And five of them were wise, and five *were* foolish. 3 They that *were* foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them: 8 And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out.

Matthew 7:26 And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand:

Mark 7:22 Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness:

1 Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

Proverbs 22:15 Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.

Luke 11:40 Ye fools, did not he that made that which is without make that which is within also?

Matthew 23:27 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are like unto whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead men's bones, and of all uncleanness.

Luke 12:20 But God said unto him, *Thou* fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?

Luke 24:25 Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken:

Mark 16:14 Afterward He appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen Him after he was risen.

1 Corinthians 12:9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;

James 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

In the Gospel of Mark, more people are healed by deliverance than just

healing.

**Romans 1:21,22** Because that, when they knew God, they glorified *him* not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. 22 Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools,

**Matthew 5:9** Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God.

**More Service Notes:**

**Romans 2:20** An instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which hast the form of knowledge and of the truth in the law.

**Romans 10:19** But I say, Did not Israel know? First Moses saith, I will provoke you to jealousy by *them that are no people*, and by a foolish nation I will anger you.

**1 Corinthians 1:18** For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

**1 Corinthians 1:20,21** Where *is* the wise? where *is* the scribe? where *is* the disputer of this world? hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? 21 For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.

**1 Corinthians 1:23** But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness;

**1 Corinthians 1:25** Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

**1 Corinthians 1:27** But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty;

**1 Corinthians 2:14** But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know *them*, because they are spiritually discerned.

**1 Corinthians 3:18,19** Let no man deceive himself. If any man among you seemeth to be wise in this world, let him become a fool, that he may be wise. 19 For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness.

**1 Corinthians 4:10** We *are* fools for Christ's sake, but ye *are* wise in Christ; we *are* weak, but ye *are* strong; ye *are* honourable, but we *are* despised.

**1 Corinthians 15:36** *Thou* fool, that which thou sowest is not quickened, except it die:

**2 Corinthians 11:16** I say again, Let no man think me a fool; if otherwise, yet as a fool receive me, that I may boast myself a little. 17 That which I speak, I speak *it* not after the Lord, but as it were foolishly, in this confidence of boasting.

**2 Corinthians 11:19** For ye suffer fools gladly, seeing ye *yourselves* are wise.

**2 Corinthians 11:21** I speak as concerning reproach, as though we had been weak. Howbeit whereinsoever any is bold, (I speak foolishly,) I am bold also.

**2 Corinthians 11:23** Are they ministers of Christ? (I speak as a fool) I *am* more; in labours more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft.

**2 Corinthians 12:6** For though I would desire to glory, I shall not be a fool; for I will say the truth: but *now* I forbear, lest any man should think of me above that which he seeth me *to be*, or *that* he heareth of me.

**2 Corinthians 12:11** I am become a fool in glorying; ye have compelled me: for I ought to have been commended of you: for in nothing am I behind the very chiefest apostles, though I be nothing.

**Galatians 3:1** O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?

**Galatians 3:3** Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh?

**Ephesians 5:4** Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks.

**Ephesians 5:15** See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise,

**1 Timothy 6:9** But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and *into* many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition.

**2 Timothy 2:23** But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes.

**Titus 3:3** For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, *and* hating one another.

**Titus 3:9** But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain.

**1 Peter 2:15** For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men:
